1. Ref telecon 23 December, Colonel Hensey G-4 this headquarters and Lt Colonel Sundlof CAS Army Eight.

2. Clearance was given by EUSAK representative for shipment of 75 ECA trucks by chartered LST, the Wanyiu, Chinese registry, to Pusan, Korea ASAP. CG Army Eight requests that vehicles, as shipped, be loaded with direct relief supplies in the following priorities and within the weight limitations of vehicles concerned: Blankets, clothing items, and tentage. The shipment of vehicles should contain above items as vehicle pay load in the ratio of 4, 2, 1 respectively. Quantities to be shipped are not to exceed those contained in CX 51426, 16 December 1950.

3. Vessel due to berth and to begin loading in Yokohama at 260800 December 1950 provided definite berth assignment is received by that time.

4. Notify CG Army Eight and 2nd Log Comd of ETA when known.

5. Necessary coordination is to be effected through Captain Meschter, ECA/Tokyo, telephone 57-8171.

MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD:

SUBJECT: Shipment of ECA Vehicles by LST to Korea

1. ECAFO in letter to SCAP, dated 22 December 1950, requested concurrence of the military for shipment of 214 trucks to Korea by chartered LST, the Wanyiu, a Chinese registry vessel, owned by the China Merchant Steam Navigation Co.
2. In telecon, Colonel Hensey (G-4 KEAD) and Lt Colonel Sundlof (EUSAK CAS), clearance was given for movement of one shipload of approximately 75 trucks with the further request that vehicles be loaded with direct relief supplies in the following priority: Blankets, clothing items, and tentage, and in a ratio of 4, 2, 1 respectively for above items.
3. Instant msg directs JICOM to load vessels with above relief supplies.
4. In clearing vessel for acceptance, G-2 CI Director (Major Tobin) stated that there was no record on vessel and no derogatory info on the company itself on 22 June 1950; however, Major Tobin stated that PMD had derogatory info on the company. Lt Colonel Kemp (PMO) stated that derogatory info on the company is not sufficient to doubt reliability and refusal to use vessel concerned.
5. Coordination: ECA (Capt. Meschter, Mr. Jane' and Mr. Coleman)  
G-4 P & O (Lt Colonel Ruhlen)
6. This action is within established policy.

MEMO FOR RECORD:

1. JLCOM msg EX 32839 JM DTG 161735Z advised that JLCOM must be allocated an average of 6000 net M/T ship capacity daily to Korea. Msg indicates that priorities expressed by official Army Eight rep are: POL, vehs, and rations, respectively. In addition, high priority must be assigned to mvmt of Marine material from Kobe.. Msg rqstd that MSTS-WESPAC berth at least 1 ship at Yoko on 17 Dec, and additional vessel as required in order to meet Army Eights minimum requirements.
2. JLCOM msg EX 32853 JM DTG 180523Z stated that JLCOM is controlling closely the bookings of supplies for shipment to Korea, in order that shipping will be the minimum essential. Msg rqstd that as a basis for essential near term planning, CG JLCOM be furnished the best possible projection of shipping that is to be allocated for movement of cargo from Japan to Korea.
3. In addition to the vessels listed in outgoing action, the Valdosta lifted 5776 M/T mogas from Sasebo to Pusan 16 Dec, the Herkimer 1312 M/T from Sasebo to Pusan 17 Dec and the Norcuba lifted 910 M/T from Yoko to Hungnam 15 Dec.
4. COMNAVFE msg 170430Z stated it is expected shipping will be available about 27 Dec for all routine lifts.
5. The availability dates of the vessels listed in outgoing action were extracted from JLCOM's port operations report, TC 58, for the period ending 2400 hours 19 Dec 50. The allocation of these vessels was coordinated with MSTSWEPEAC (Cdr Flachsenhar).



1. For additional background see G-4 16113.
2. In brief the above action indicated G-4 concurrence in moving the 10th Station Hospital to Pusan to replace 8054th Evacuation Hospital. This action resulted in the dispatch of CINCFE message 68039, 2 Nov 50, which ordered the move.
3. In conversation with G-4 (Maj Tilton) on 2 Nov 50, Medical Section (Maj Caito) stated that the 10th Station Hospital would be used to replace the 8054th Evacuation Hospital now in Pusan. The 8054th Evacuation Hospital has been acting as a Station Hospital but upon its relief by the 10th Station Hospital it will be moved forward in the Eighth Army Zone and resume its activities as an Evacuation hospital. The 10th Station Hospital will take over the location and equipment of the 8054th which means that its organizational equipment enroute from the ZI will not be required. Field equipment for an Evacuation hospital is available in Korea for the 8054th.
4. Recommend approval of proposed message to CG JLCOM which informs him that the 10th Station Hospital will move to Pusan less equipment.

1. Radio, CG Army Eight, GX 26943 KTR, 30 Oct 50, to CINCFE (info CG JLCOM, CG 2d LOG CMD, and CG 3d LOG CMD) requested that 40 Japanese powered barges of 100 tons capacity, 10 Japanese tow boats, 1 ship to act as mother ship and 1 repair ship be furnished for lightering cargo.

2. The foregoing powered lighters are urgently required for stream discharge and cargo handling while beached on mud flats. At present there are no Army vessels capable of performing the required functions. Because broad beamed, flat bottomed craft are the only type of powered vessel which can be successfully worked in this type of operation, vessels of the class of LST's, LSU or LC would be required. vessels of this type were transferred to the Navy for tactical operations. Flat topped cargo barges, non-propelled have also been committed during the present hostilities. Further, it was planned, that due to the tide and anticipated destruction of port facilities in Korea, that stream discharge and over the beach cargo handling could best be met by charter of indigenous craft, for relatively short periods of time. Also by including a mother ship, refueling tanker and repair ship, together with a water barge, the contractor would have a self-sustaining unit complete with living quarters, ration storage, water, lighter repair and bunkers. This type of cargo handling is presently in operation at Pusan, Inchon and Mongsan and appears to be workable; Accordingly, this request for craft to operate other ports in North Korea in a like manner can be expected to produce like results. Also the utilization of locally procured craft and services, reduces the drain of floating equipment from the ZI stock pile or requiring local new construction to supply the military requirements during the period of hostility. Accordingly, it is recommended that the vessels requested by CG Army Eight be chartered and delivered as expeditiously as possible.

1. Operational immediate radio, CG Army Eight, EX 26443 KIR, 20 Oct 50, advises as follows: "Fol msg rec from CG 2D Log Comd. CG 3D Log Comd req 100 Jap cargo checkers to be utilized in checking cargo from ships to lighters. Also req mother ship be furn to quarter, feed, etc. as pers cannot go ashore. This Hq concurs. Req passed to you for net action and or coord. Req advice of action taken."

2. The procurement of Japanese stevedores to assist in the discharge of cargo from vessels during and subsequent to amphibious operations at Korea was approved by the Chief of Staff on 30 Aug. These personnel were "for use in base operations only" (Reference, Memorandum for Chief of Staff, subj: Procurement of Japanese Stevedores, 30 Aug 50, submitted by Brig Gen G.V. Keyser, Office of Deputy Chief of Staff (Trans Sec, File TS (A) 232)).

3. G-4, GHQ, FEC, approved the dispatch of radio CINCFE CX67157, 22 Oct 50, to CG Army Eight and CG JLCOM which directed CG JLCOM to obtain the 100 checkers end the mother ship, and requested information as to time and place for the recruits to report so that CINCFE can assist by handling recruitment arrangements with Central Government authorities. CG Army Eight was advised that the recruitment of Japanese checkers is considered an expedient only and that their release is desired as soon as practical.

4.4. Radio CG JLCOM, EX 31687, 27 Oct 50, to CINCFE (in part) and CG 2d Trans Major Port (in part) requests that the Central Government be advised to have applicants report to the Japanese Labor Office, 2d TMP, Yokohama. Mr Richers, CTS has coordinated with Mr L. C. McVoy, Labor Div, ESS, SCAP, to have the Central Government coordinate recruitment with the 2d T.P. Mr McVoy recommends that a minimum employment of 60 days be guaranteed to assist in recruitment. Radio EX 31687 requests scale of wages and allowance authorized. To preclude dissents, the checkers will be paid in a direct proportion to that paid the stevedores.

5. Radio EX 31687 states "It is assumed that the provisions of letters, GHQ, AG 400 GD, subj, 'Supply for Japanese Stevedores,' dated 11 and 20 Oct 50, which authorizes issue of Army clothing and rations to Japanese labor apply to this project." This project is allied to the supply of stevedores for Korea. Major E.J. McMen, G-4 Supply, has coordinated the authorization of supply with Major W. L. Snapp, Quartermaster Section, GHQ, FEC. The GHQ, FEC letters referred to have certain limitations regarding types of stock for issue.

6. EX 31687 requests 2d TMP to procure the 100 checkers by direct hire. They will be quartered aboard the USAT FS270 which has a target date of 31 Oct for departure. The radio authorizes issuance of subsistence to passengers and crew for 90 days. The 2d T.P. will direct the FS 270 to proceed to Inchon, where it will remain as a mother ship for the checkers, until released by USA port authorities.


ADDENDUM TO MEMO FOR RECORD:

  - a. Part 1 confirms telephone conversations between Trans GHQ (Maj Parr) and Trans JLCOM (Mr. Post) booking following cargo to be loaded between 18 and 25 Oct destined Pusan for onward routing:
    - (1) 19,380 M/T including 8,408 M/T vehicles from Yoko.
    - (2) 4,242 M/T including 1,820 M/T vehicles from Kobe.
    - (3) 765 M/T including 6 each M-4 A-3 tanks from Maji.

Mso states Meridian Victory, States Yanaphas, Afruniria and American Attorney have been committed for this lift.

b. Part 2 requests shipping be assigned for shipment of pers and equipment of Embarkation Div E from Yoko to Pusan for onward routing. Mso states loading is to be in 18 Oct and complete on or before 25 Oct, and it is estimated entire lift will require 3 Victory type vessels or equivalent and a passenger carrier. Presently booked are 27 officers, 556 EM and 12,869 M/T including 204 vehicles and 24 tanks, with 10 units remaining to be booked. Included in this lift is 2d Engr Special Brigade which has been assigned Priority 1, and which has 31 LCUs to move.

c. Part 3 requests that routing of Arcadia Victory be changed to make Inchon first port of call.
  2. Re part 1 above msg: Verbal bookings received from JLCOM (Mr. Post) total as indicated in outset ms. Vessels listed were nominated by MST3 and JLCOM informed verbally by Trans GHQ (Maj Parr).

1. Part II JICOM msg 31335 PFL to CINCFE requests that action be taken to assure arrival Korea items in reference radio scheduled for October arrivals.

2. Instant message invites the attention of JICOM and CG Army Eight to the fact that DA has furnished what information they have had available at that time as to the shipment of these products to Korea. If the petroleum is not shipped from the States, there is nothing that CINCFE can do, outside of the follow-up, which is being done constantly.
