

"Info CSCAD. Subject copra.

"1. Representatives of DA in Tokyo report large quantities of coconuts are going to waste on Guam instead of being made into copra. This problem was brought to your attention in Sep 47. Subsequent reply was received to the effect that no copra is processed in Guam because labor is not available, and local soap factory is importing coconut oil.

"2. In view of current high price copra (approximately \$300 per ton), and short world supply of fats and oils, it is felt copra should be made where possible in occupied areas.

"3. Export of copra from Guam in pre-war yrs in mtons according to our info amounted to: 1641 in 1935, 2362 in 1936, 2359 in 1937, 1681 in 1938, 2264 in 1939, and 1303 in 1940.

"4. Request latest info possibility of producing copra for local requirements, and for export sale to SCAP."

Island of a colony for segregation and treatment of the lepers of the trust territory. Funds available for this construction lapse Jun 13th. The site selected for the colony is a tract of about 250 acres on the East Coast of Saipan with center at about 15 deg 12 min 30 seconds north latitude. Construction was to begin Apr 1st, but has been temporarily suspended pending clarification of revised Army requirements.

The treatment of the lepers that they be as nearly self-supporting as possible, and that they follow patterns of occupation normal to them. This necessitates that the colony site have tillable land and access to the sea for fishing. No unoccupied site on Saipan meets these requirements except the one selected.

"3. Consideration has been given to establishing the colony on Tinian but this has been rejected because of the continuous increased cost in money and personnel which would be involved in supporting the activity on an island which has no other naval establishment.

"Info is requested at the earliest date possible whether plans now being drawn for the stationing and training of additional Army personnel in Saipan can be developed to permit retention of the laper colony in the site selected."
