The following rad received by this hq is quoted for your information and recommendations upon which to base a reply to CINCFE.

"Info CSCAD. Subject copra.

"1. Representatives of DA in Tokyo report large quantities of coconuts are going to waste on Guam instead of being made into copra. This problem was brought to your attention in Sep 47. Subsequent reply was received to the effect that no copra is processed in Guam because labor is not available, and local soap factory is importing coconut oil.

"2. In view of current high price copra (approximately \$300 per ton), and short world supply of fats and oils, it is felt copra should be made where possible in occupied areas.

"3. Export of copra from Guam in pre-war yrs in mtons according to our info amounted to: 1641 in 1935, 2362 in 1936, 2359 in 1937, 1681 in 1938, 2264 in 1939, and 1303 in 1940.

"4. Request latest info possibility of producing copra for local requirements, and for export sale to SCAP."

Army enlisted man posted as guard on ship refused admittance to visitors on ground their admittance would be violation of orders. Argument followed and guard drew pistol. Tastor attempted to disarm guard and in struggle gun was discharged twice killing Tastor and inflicting minor wounds on 3 others. Return of remains not Dept of Army responsibility, CG SFPE has been requested by radio to contact Sudden and Christenson 310 Sansome St, San Francisco, Calif., employers of Tastor as to disposition of remains.

Fol memo received from COMMAFIANAS:

1. The Navy Dept has authorized construction on Saipan Island of a colony for segregation and treatment of the lepers of the trust territory. Funds available for this construction lapse Jun 13th. The site selected for the colony is a tract of about 250 acres on the East Coast of Saipan with center at about 15 deg 12 min 30 seconds north latitude. Construction was to begin Apr 1st, but has been temporarily suspended pending clarification of revised Army requirements.

2. It is an essential part of the plan for treatment of the lepers that they be as nearly self-supporting as possible, and that they follow patterns of occupation normal to them. This necessitates that the colony site have tillable land and access to the sea for fishing. No unoccupied site on Saipan meets these requirements except the one selected.

3. Consideration has been given to establishing the colony on Tinian but this has been rejected because of the continuous increased cost in money and personnel which would be involved in supporting the activity on an island which has no other naval establishment.

"Info is requested at the earliest date possible whether plans now being drawn for the stationing and training of additional Army personnel in Saipan can be developed to permit retention of the leper colony in the site selected."

Part 2. With respect to transfer vouchers applicable to FY 47 and prior yrs funds currently being received from BUSANDA, supporting papers generally in order. A small percentage of bills however are supported by unsigned invoices lacking original signatures of receiving agents. This condition requires individual verification of receipt of items and a close scrutiny of bills to prevent duplicate payments. Billings by the local NSC against FY 48 funds however are rarely supported by properly authenticated receipted invoices. Conferences with Navy representatives indicate that this situation can be corrected locally but verification of invoices already received may delay payment beyond the 90 day deadline.

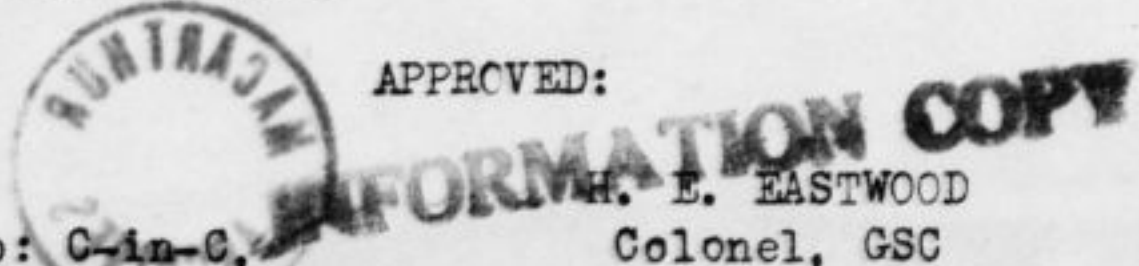

This hq estimates approx 450 families will return to ZI thru Jan 49 which will not provide sufficient quarters for personnel on present waiting list. Therefore the minimum required credits should increase month by month as lists are submitted. Dep Housing Bulletin No. 2 from Guam, dtd 25 Feb 48, indicates that 777 applns are on file at Guam on current list and that personnel currently arriving will of necessity be at the bottom of this list due to current o/s service. That thru Jan 49 MARBO estimates only 444 vacancies will occur due to returns to ZI. This indicates that insufficient quarters will be available for the current established list and that the minimum credits will build up month by month until approximately 20 mos or 40 credits will be required for entrance into Guam.
