Navy will be delegated disposal authority for Army real prop by SA. Part 3: ADMSG list of Army installations for which disposal is contemplated and est date each will become excess your needs and ready for rept to Navy for disposal."

Subject: Close-Out of Army Forces on Guam

1. CG MARBO msg S 9908 requests in part 2 confirmation of the fact that MARBO strategic reserve of technical service supplies required by FEOP 1-50, 1 Feb 50, is inconsistent with closeout activities directed by CINCFE directive of 13 June to prepare Army closeout plan, and is therefore no longer a requirement. This is correct and is confirmed, as decision to eliminate any theater reserve stocks in the Marianas was reached by GHQ in Sept 1949 and formalized with approval by C/S on 2 Mar 50 of Staff Study - Requirements for Army Forces on Guam. Part 3 of MARBO msg requests extension to 1 Aug 50 of submittal date for Annex E, Logistics to MARBO Op. Plan No. 4. This extension is granted with JSPOG concurrence (Col. Galloway for EKW). B. Experience this hq Guamanians employed only satisfactory due to high absentee rate. Labor Relations Office COMARIANAS advise unable to employ Guamanians sufficient to meet needs also experience high absentee rate with those employed.

C. Upon informal advice from Govt Guam that 60 to 80 Guamanians were avail for employment this hq on 4 Mar 50 attempted employment 10 laborers and 30 bus drivers urgently needed without success after 30 days placed on recruitment in PI.

D. Unable furnish estimate nbr Guamanians unemployed and reluctant to accept employment. Labor Dept Guam Govt advises they have some applicants listed however mostly unskilled laborers. Replacement employment for MARBO Laundry does not keep pace with labor losses with 8 vacancies on recruitment and unfilled this date.

E. Army experience negative as Guamanian female domestics practically non-existent. Reliably informed Govt Guam employs 2 domestics from Rota Citizens Trust Territory.

MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD:

1. Basic msg from MARBO points out that closeout of Saipan "May be possible" by 1 Dec 50 if requested explosives received.
2. MARBO Msg C-23578, 10 Jun 50, requested 300 tons of block demolitions and 20 feet of prima cord. CINCEN Msg ZX-48133, 14 Jun 50, advised that 50 tons of demolition blocks and 20 feet of prima cord were shipped 31 May. Msg pointed out that additional quantities of demolitions requested not available within FSC and suggested MARBO requisition from ZI via telecon to STPL. It appears that CINCEN Msg ZX-48133 was not received by MARBO prior to the dispatch of their message S-9900. STPL by Msg TCSEP-7162-GO (S) ORD, referred to CINCEN Msg ZX-48133 and advised that USARPAC forecast shows excess demolitions on hand that command approximately 311 short tons, and suggests that MARBO contact USARPAC directly reference transfer of this stock to Guam.
3. Until CG, MARBO, investigates the possibility of getting required demolitions from USARPAC, no action is required by CINCEN. It is felt, however, that CG, MARBO, should be reminded that closeout by 1 Dec 50 as directed in CINCEN Msg C-56667, 10 Jun 50, is necessary.

1. G-4 checknote to C/S, 8 Jun 50, referred to MARBO msg S 9844, 24 Apr 50, which advised that evacuation of Saipan would be completed by 15 May 50. From a visit to Saipan on 15 May 50 by the Ord O, FEC and a representative of G-4 GHQ FEC, it was concluded that the Saipan ammunition area would not be cleared of all visible duds for several months. Since previous CINCFE msg CX 56001, 26 Apr 50, had advised DA that MARBO plans were to evacuate Saipan 15 May 50, G-4 recommended to the CofS that:

a. Msg be dispatched to DA advising that clearance of Saipan will be completed by 31 Dec 1950.

b. Msg be dispatched to CG MARBO directing clearance of Saipan by 1 December 1950 in order to provide time for an inspection of the area by representatives of GHQ and subsequent clean-up if found necessary prior to 31 Dec 1950.

2. The Chief of Staff approved the recommendations stated in 1a and 1b above on 9 Jun 50.

3. G-4 action is to finalize and forward to CG for dispatch the two msgs referred to in 1a and b above which were approved by the CofS.



Reply from Dept of Army follows:

"Only restriction upon size of lots of excess prop offered for sale is contained in Para 27 C (2), (A) SR 755-60-5. This restriction does not preclude action to increase size of indiv lots in order to secure adequate bidding.

"The rept procedure for sales of prop with an acquisition value in excess \$50,000 required by Para 27 C (4) SR 755-60-5 is not a restriction on size of lots to be offered and necessity of rendering such repts will not materially delay sales. Repts of anticipated sales of prop in the \$50,000 to \$250,000 cat can be cleared by this hq within 3 days and sales of prop over \$250,000 can be cleared within 15 days."

M/R: In telecon held between G-1 this Hq and representatives of CG Marbo on 18 Mar 50, CG Marbo reported difficulty which had developed in connection with the shipment of negro troops to RYCOM. Radio C-55275, 8 Mar 50 advised CG Marbo that it was desirable to reduce negro auth str ceiling to zero, and provided that certain negro units be inactivated. In rad 59776 MBGCT, 9 Mar 50, CG Marbo concurred. In rad CX-55317, 10 Mar 50, CG Marbo was directed to move to Rycom, all negro pers with rotation dates subsequent to 30 June 50. Local discretion as to transfer was auth where depts or other factors mitigated against such transfer. As a result of this action, negro soldiers on Guam, who were effected, were disturbed because they considered the shipment as being discriminatory. In the telecon CG Marbo was directed to phase out negro units as planned, and to transfer pers with rotation dates subsequent to 30 June, to Rycom prior to 30 June at his discretion.

Instructions were issued that the purpose of the shipment be explained to the troops involved. In addition, in rad CX 55468, 18 Mar 50, CG Marbo was directed to transfer 10 negro EM, possessing MOS needed in Eighth Army, to that command. Finally, in the telecon request was made by G-1, GHQ that a report of the results of the above actions be submitted to this hq by classified rad soonest. Report has not been received. Inst rad calls attn to request for report, and requests that report be expedited.
