Following communication to CG MARBO of DA radio WCL 39219, 19 Aug 50, which stated that authority of Guam Government to tax agencies, activities, and personnel on Armed Forces Reservations is limited to taxes enumerated and consented to by Congress in the Buck Act (4 USC 105-110), CG MARBO by radio C 25229 MBACS, 25 Aug 50, advised that COMNAVMARIANAS was continuing to collect 4¢ per gallon gasoline tax levied by Guam Government pending decision whether Section 104, Title 4, United States Code applies to Guam, and requested instructions.

Such taxes, so levied, shall be paid to the proper taxing authorities of the State, Territory, or the District of Columbia, within whose borders the reservation affected may be located. "(b) The officer in charge of such reservation shall, on or before the fifteenth day of each month, submit a written statement to the proper taxing authorities of the State, Territory, or the District of Columbia within whose borders the reservation is located, showing the amount of such motor fuel with respect to which taxes are payable under subsection (a) for the preceding month." Title 4 of the U.S. Code was enacted in entirety by Act of 30 Jul 47 (PL 279, Chap. 389, 80th Congress, 1st Session), and embodied in a single statute the Buck Act (Act 9 Oct 40, 54 Stat. 1059) which became Sections 105-110 of Title 4, and Section 10 of the Act of 16 Jun 36 (49 Stat. 1521), which became Section 104 of Title 4, while repealing both the former statutes. Despite the specific reference to the Buck Act in DA radio WCL 39219 and to 4 USC, Sections 105-110, no such reference appears in the organic Act of Guam (PL 630, Chap. 512, 81st Congress, 2d Session, 1 Aug 50). The organic Act of Guam declares, by Section 3, that Guam is "an unincorporated Territory of the United States"; by Section 6 (b), that the Governor of Guam "shall faithfully execute the laws of the United States applicable to Guam, and the laws of Guam"; by Section 11, that: "The legislative power of Guam shall extent to all subjects of legislation of local application not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act and the laws of the United States applicable to Guam. Taxes and assessments on property, internal revenues, sales, license fees, and royalties for franchises, privileges, and concessions may be imposed for purposes of the government of Guam as may be uniformly provided by the Legislature of Guam, * * *"; and by Section 25 (b), it is provided: Page 2 of 3 pages

"(b) The officer in charge of such reservation shall, on or before the fifteenth day of each month, submit a written statement to the proper taxing authorities of the State, Territory, or the District of Columbia within whose borders the reservation is located, showing the amount of such motor fuel with respect to which taxes are payable under subsection (a) for the preceding month." Title 4 of the U.S. Code was enacted in entirety by Act of 30 Jul 47 (PL 279, Chap. 389, 80th Congress, 1st Session), and embodied in a single statute the Buck Act (Act 9 Oct 40, 54 Stat. 1059) which became Sections 105-110 of Title 4, and Section 10 of the Act of 16 Jun 36 (49 Stat. 1521), which became Section 104 of Title 4, while repealing both the former statutes. Despite the specific reference to the Buck Act in DA radio WCL 39219 and to 4 USC, Sections 105-110, no such reference appears in the organic Act of Guam (PL 630, Chap. 512, 81st Congress, 2d Session, 1 Aug 50). The organic Act of Guam declares, by Section 3, that Guam is "an unincorporated Territory of the United States"; by Section 6 (b), that the Governor of Guam "shall faithfully execute the laws of the United States applicable to Guam, and the laws of Guam"; by Section 11, that: "The legislative power of Guam shall extent to all subjects of legislation of local application not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act and the laws of the United States applicable to Guam. Taxes and assessments on property, internal revenues, sales, license fees, and royalties for franchises, privileges, and concessions may be imposed for purposes of the government of Guam as may be uniformly provided by the Legislature of Guam, * * *"; and by Section 25 (b), it is provided: Page 2 of 3 pages

The President of the United States shall appoint a commission of seven persons, at least three of whom shall be residents of Guam, to survey the field of Federal statutes and to make recommendations to the Congress of the United States within twelve months after the date of enactment of this Act as to which statutes of the United States not applicable to Guam on such date shall be made applicable to Guam, and as to which statutes of the United States applicable

In view of the foregoing, it is the opinion of this office:

to Guam on such date shall be declared inapplicable."

- a. That all laws of the United States applicable to Guam are effectively applicable on and after 1 Aug 50;
- b. That Section 104, Title 4 (Act of 30 Jul 47), applicable to taxes levied by a "Territory" of the United States is applicable to taxes levied by an "unincorporated" Territory (NLRB v. Gongalez Padin Co., CCA 1, 1947, 161 Fed. 2d 353; In re Lane 135 US 443, 34 L. Ed. 219, 221, 1890; Hooven and Allison Co. v. Evatt, 324 US 652, 89 L. Ed. 1252, 1945); and
- c. That the consent of Congress has been given to the collection of the gasoline tax levied by the Guam Government upon fuel sold by or through post exchanges, ships stores, commissaries, etc., on military or other reservations, when such fuels are not for the exclusive use of the United States (4 USC, Section 104, supra; 38 Op Atty Gen 519, 1936).

On 8 Jul 50, C-4 procured from the AG an MRU status report of the personnel and units within M.RBO in a break-down by unit, by MOS, by grade spread. This status report indicated that on 31 May 1950 there were 336 officers and 3707 EM within MARBO. Placing MARBO on an austerity status would release a large number of these units and personnel for re-assignment elsewhere within the FEC. 2. CG FEAF (Col R. C. Heflebower) and Chiefs of all Technical Services GHQ concur in the opinion of G-4. (Meeting held 14 Jul 50) G-1 and G-3 and the above concur in instant msg. 3. TO: Taxing authority exercised by the Naval Governor of 7-49824 Guam will terminate upon transfer of the administration of Guam to the Secretary of the Interior. Unconfirmed press dispatch indicates transfer postponed from 1 July until 1 August 1950. On and after date of such transfer taxing authority is not, repeat not, considered to be vested in the local civil government until or unless meanwhile delegated by Congress. Accordingly, you are authorized to inform the Civil Governor of Guam that effective upon the date of such transfer presently imposed local taxes will not be paid by military personnel and agencies in Guam. In view of the fact that certain Guam taxes such as manufacturer's excise tax have been heretofore passed on by local manufacturer to purchasers, you are authorized to instruct purchasing officers and agencies that they may decline to buy where the selling price includes locally imposed taxes.




