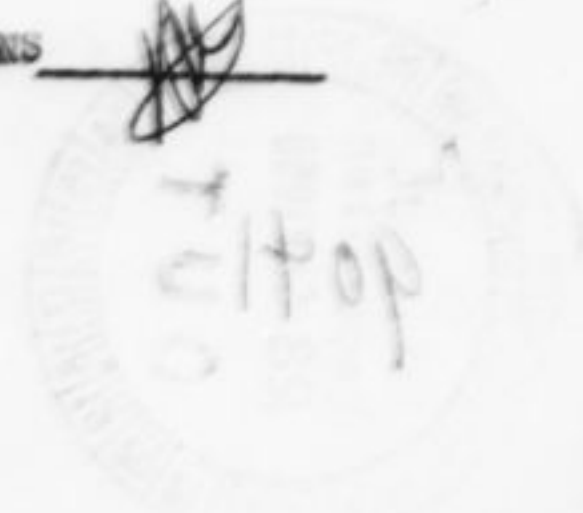

MEMO FOR RECORD:

1. D/A radio W 92313, 24 Sep 50, stated that Department of Navy had requested reimbursement for stevedoring on MARBO in connection with the movement of Army and Air Force supplies, personnel and equipment. MARBO was being advanced \$40,000 TSA money as an interim measure. D/A has no objection and requests CINCPAC approval.
2. MARBO Operation No. 6, 19 July, indicated certain changes in the MARBO set-up, but did not specify a transfer of funds at Washington level to pay for Navy transportation facilities.
3. Transportation Section (Mr. Lendry) states that they know of no program of this nature, nor does S-4 (Lt Col Rihlen).
4. Instant radio quotes the D/A radio in part and requests info from MARBO as to why they are not using the PDGA already provided their command in the amount of \$2,000,000 to pay the Navy for this transportation.

b. That Section 104, Title 4 (Act of 30 Jul 47), applicable to taxes levied by a "Territory" of the United States is applicable to taxes levied by an "unincorporated" Territory (NLRB v. Gonzalez Padin Co., CCA 1, 1947, 161 Fed. 2d 353; In re Lane 135 US 443, 34 L. Ed. 219, 221, 1890; Hooven and Allison Co. v. Evatt, 324 US 652, 89 L. Ed. 1252, 1945); and

c. That the consent of Congress has been given to the collection of the gasoline tax levied by the Guam Government upon fuel sold by or through post exchanges, ships stores, commissaries, etc., on military or other reservations, when such fuels are not for the exclusive use of the United States (4 USC, Section 104, supra; 38 Op Atty Gen 519, 1936).



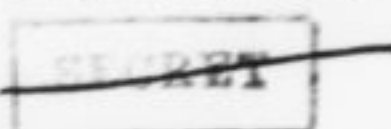

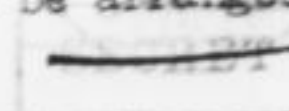

Subject: Placing MARBO on an Austerity Basis

1. On 12 Jul 50 CINCFE dispatched to Washington msg CX 57693 which requested units required from the ZI to support the activities of CINCFE. On 13 Jul 50 a supplemental list was sent in msg CX 57741. In the development of these lists it became apparent that within MARBO there were units and individuals that were in urgent demand elsewhere within the FEC. On 8 Jul 50, C-4 procured from the LG an MRU status report of the personnel and units within MARBO in a break-down by unit, by MOS, by grade spread. This status report indicated that on 31 May 1950 there were 336 officers and 3707 EM within MARBO. Placing MARBO on an austerity status would release a large number of these units and personnel for re-assignment elsewhere within the FEC.

2. CG FEAF (Col R. C. Heflebower) and Chiefs of all Technical Services GHQ concur in the opinion of G-4. (Meeting held 14 Jul 50) G-1 and G-3 and the above concur in instant msg.

3. It was felt that successive steps in procuring the use of these personnel should be followed:

a. CG MARBO to plan for his command on an austerity status.

b. CINCFE to review his plan and concurrently with review make determination as to the disposition of equipment, stocks, supplies, personnel, and units.

c. CINCFE upon achieving a firm plan to ask DA for approval of the action.

d. Upon receipt of DA approval, CINCFE to direct CG MARBO to place his command on an austerity status as approved by DA. This message is the first step required, that is, to require CG MARBO to prepare a plan for placing his command on an austerity status.

4. Instant msg is self-explanatory.

5. Within established policy and is acceleration of concurrent directive.

6. Initiated action completed.

Taxing authority exercised by the Naval Governor of Guam will terminate upon transfer of the administration of Guam to the Secretary of the Interior. Unconfirmed press dispatch indicates transfer postponed from 1 July until 1 August 1950. On and after date of such transfer taxing authority is not, repeat not, considered to be vested in the local civil government until or unless meanwhile delegated by Congress. Accordingly, you are authorized to inform the Civil Governor of Guam that effective upon the date of such transfer presently imposed local taxes will not be paid by military personnel and agencies in Guam. In view of the fact that certain Guam taxes such as manufacturer's excise tax have been heretofore passed on by local manufacturer to purchasers, you are authorized to instruct purchasing officers and agencies that they may decline to buy where the selling price includes locally imposed taxes.
