1. Ref Eighth Army msg GX 26774 KGO. X Corps is making every effort to adv rapidly to Korean Northern border along Tumen River, 175 miles from present adv elms, I ROK Corps, via Tanchon and about 100 miles in zone of 7th and 1st Mar Div (DV 9080). All combt elms are fully employed in this mission of advancing to other portions of the northern border except 2 bns, Mar Div engaging en forces Kojo area.

2. Numerous appeals by Civil leaders S of Kojo have been made to this hq for protection. They state following: Very large nbr of en trps continue to ravage towns and villages Yongyang N to Kojo; they continue to rob, loot, rape, murder and burn houses selecting as particular targets those buildings flying the SK flag. Condition has forced mass evacuation civilians northward. Approx 20000 evacuees now camped Toughon awaiting relief and protection.

3. The present N-3 depth of the X Corps zone is 400 road miles, 100-145 miles of which still remains in en possession. If consideration is being given to approving rqst contained in ref msg, rqst 1 additional ROK Div be assigned to X Corps for purposes outlined in Part 2, ref msg.

Civil assistance in the Wonsan area has been initiated by X Corps.

Today senior members of local governments established this vicinity met in Wonsan for coordination and orientation by X Corps Civil Affairs Officer thru ROK I Corps Civil Affairs personnel. Our intentions to alleviate the hardships of the populace by carrying out UN policies were outlined and representatives were informed that such military occupation as was necessary would continue no longer than required to assist in establishing a united Korea and permit an early return to peace and production; and that their cooperation will assist us in shortening this required length of stay. Translations of the statement and photo coverage is being disseminated to civilian populace and the local press.

During the conference of approximately 1 hour ensuing, the Korean representatives raised questions of fiscal policy, land rights, employment of indigents, fisheries, security, housing and public health. Satisfactory answers in broad terms were given. Some problems require detailed recommendations to be submitted singly and separately to CINCPAC. A similar conference will be held in 1 week at Hamhung for local officials in that area.

Civilian attitude is good and improves daily with ample evidence of appreciation of liberation by vast majority. Exemplifying this was UN-Day celebration today in Wonsan attended by estimated 12000 with appropriate flags, banners and speeches. This event was organized by local populace without guidance of US, UN or ROK officials.

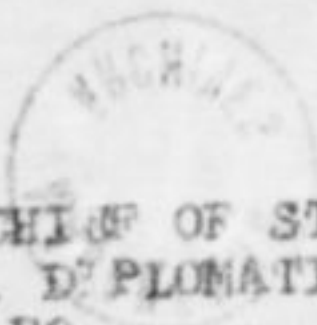
X Corps Zone embraces generally the ante-1945 Hamgyong-Nambo and the Hamgyong-Pukto provinces. Advances to date include approximately southern half of the former province as constituted prior to 1945. Of the total 16 counties in this province, temporary governments have been established in the 7 southern counties and in the cities of Wonsan and Hamhung. All North Korean former officials have fled or disappeared necessitating designation of temporary officials and subordinates. Provisional provincial government now being organized at Capital City Hamhung. As progress is continued northward, similar organization will follow troops to include eventually all counties, principal cities and both provinces in X Corps Zone.

ROK Government officials previously in this area have been recalled to Seoul by President Rhee in conformance with UN instructions.

Ref is CINC UNC Civil Affairs Annex urgent need exists for est of sound currency system among North Koreans in this area. North Korean currency for legal tender is practically nonexistent this area. Those who had large amounts of currency were ranking Communist and have fled. Other Red currency available was gathered up by Communists so that little remains to carry on a monetary system. Danger exists Reds may counterfeit. ROK Army Forces entering this area have carried in ROK currency which is being used throughout the area. General desire of the populace here is to use ROK currency. Recommend:

(1) That a short interim period be established whereby both types of currency may be used and during which the North Korean currency can be exchanged for ROK currency as legal tender or a transitional currency as authorized.

(2) That Civil Govts be authorized to open limited banking facilities in the immediate future.

Part 1. Reference FEAR VC-0381-OP Chief of Staff, X Corps, accompanied by Colonel Eareckson, FEAR Liaison Officer, landed at Suwon 0900 I the day airfield was recaptured. At that time northern half of taxiway was in badly damaged condition and southern half was in poor condition. Since X Corps responsibility was capture this field, C/S immediately directed Task Force Commander Lieutenant Colonel Hammerun 7th Div, to keep track vehicles off hard surfaces. In addition, X Corps directed 7th div to repair runway soonest to insure maximum all weather day-light air operations minimum delay and so informed Kimpo Task Force Commander and Combat Cargo Command.

The damage referred to in FEAR msg could have been due to enemy action as occurred on runway. X Corps units were engaged in combat on and in vicinity of Suwon Airport and inferred "uncontrolled damage" to field by 7th Div forces is denied. So far as known, no 5th AF personnel was present during capture of Suwon Airfield by X Corps troops.

Part 2. Reference C 66707 steps have already been initiated for the protection of Wonsan Airbase by personal instructions of CG, X Corps, to CG, 1st Mar Air Wg, at time of visit to Wonsan on 14 October. These instructions will be carried out.
