



"Reference is made to your letter dated 8 October 1950 concerning clearance for commercial vessels delivering ECA aid cargo to Korea.

"For ships of UN member registry delivering ECA aid cargo to Korea clearance is granted effective this date to enter the ports of Pusan and Masan. To avoid interference with movement of essential military cargo, non-military cargo into Pusan must not exceed 100,000 metric tons per month until further notice. Additional information will be furnished on the use of other Korean ports as they are declared safe for entry of commercial ships.

"Ships sailing from other than Japanese ports direct to Korea will, prior to entry into Japanese waters, submit reports to CINCPAC, CG Army Eighth, COMNAVFE and ports concerned giving nationality of flag, tonnage and type of cargo aboard and ETA port(s) of call. Ships sailing from Japanese ports will submit similar reports giving ETD and ETA of ports concerned." End signed Jane'
