Part 2. Items (a) thru (i) above purchased new by Fomeroy and returned ECA on liquidation contract. Items (j) thru (m) purchased similarly KTI. Items (n) thru (p) originally purchased ECA China funds.

Part 3. Please advise if foregoing at variance any ECA Wash records also cost figure China vehicles.

Part 4. CINCUNC has indicated an interest in these items in view of anticipated logistical support requirements of UNKRA as well as EUSAK requirements in assumption of the ECA sustaining supply support program. Request authority to transfer Army without reimbursement. This recommendation made on assumption less difficulty transfer property to another US Govt agency than to an international organization. However UNKRA might be interested purchasing at listed prices all items except vehicles (n) thru (p). Hyssong checking with Kingsley to ascertain definite interest purchasing. If UNKRA bought, check would be issued Treasurer US in exchange bill of sale from Travell.

Part 5. In any event all items needed Korea and ECA must close out property accounts. Please convey decision and instructions soonest. End signed Colman

This message in two parts.

Part 1. Contract J-167 textile machinery parts. Subsequent several conferences held by EPS on cancellation or continuance this contract, contractor has submitted statement of damages claimed to have been incurred because previous stop-orders. Expenses for which contractor desires reimbursement total \$21,112.36. Latest stop-order imposed against contract still in effect but contractor asked to submit schedule of deliveries undelivered items totaling approx \$165,000. Contractor states deliveries could be made at prices estimated to be from 70 to 110% higher than contract prices. Deliveries could be made in 6 to 12 months.

Please advise action to be taken. Recommend termination be concluded with stated damages.

Part 2. Contracts GSA-EC-387 and 388 crossties. Letter written by EPS to Alfredo Aquino contractor in Philippines requesting comments and consideration possible cancellation these 2 contracts. Contractor visited EPS office and states considerable expenses already incurred in making arrangements for delivery. Contractor states expenses total approx \$50,000 although this figure not yet substantiated.

Stop-order still effective and contractor feels any further deliveries should be at higher prices.

In view sizable damages claim would it not be cheaper for STEM Taipei to take over contracts even though ties not treated. Please advise.

Part 1. Ref (a) requests Travell plan for liquidation ECA Korea accounts. Before clearing details such plan with CINCPAC here we must have clarification certain aspects ref (b). All following discussion assumes transfer to DA of responsibility and necessary funds for carrying on sustaining import program of ECA-type items.

Part 2. We assume that except for required deposit counterpart by ROK, funds transferred DA under single PA as discussed ref (a) are without strings as to procurement procedures, specific items to be procured, shipping, receipt of goods in Korea and financial accounting in the field. In other words DA procurement and accounting regulations would fully apply and financial accountability to ECA and reporting thereof restricted to Wash level. Army authorities here and Korea would keep accounts in regular manner according Army accounting procedures reporting back to DA. Any reports required by ECA as to dollar expenditure would be furnished by DA to ECA Wash without getting Tokyo and Korea commands involved in any way with ECA procedures. Please confirm.

Part 3. Assume Army expected bill ROK govt for counterpart deposit for all items financed by ECA fund transfer to DA. However also assume this not necessarily confined to existing fund and if found more desirable here deposits subsequent ECA phase-out could be made existing won fund derived sale relief supplies by ROK or new account established. Finally assume ECA legislative requirement met by DA statement to ECA Wash after final termination pipeline next autumn. to effect that ROK govt had deposited X billion won in return X million dollars in goods received ROK. Subject: Accounting responsibilities connection ECA phase-out.

Re (a) ECATO 218; (b) Joint State-ECA msg sent Fusan 742 rptd info Tokyo 1394.

This message in eight parts.

Part 1. Ref (a) requests Travell plan for liquidation ECA Korea accounts. Before clearing details such plan with CINCPAC here we must have clarification certain aspects ref (b). All following discussion assumes transfer to DA of responsibility and necessary funds for carrying on sustaining import program of ECA-type items.

Part 2. We assume that except for required deposit counterpart by ROK, funds transferred DA under single PA as discussed ref (a) are without strings as to procurement procedures, specific items to be procured, shipping, receipt of goods in Korea and financial accounting in the field. In other words DA procurement and accounting regulations would fully apply and financial accountability to ECA and reporting thereof restricted to Wash level. Army authorities here and Korea would keep accounts in regular manner according Army accounting procedures reporting back to DA. Any reports required by ECA as to dollar expenditure would be furnished by DA to ECA Wash without getting Tokyo and Korea commands involved in any way with ECA procedures. Please confirm.

Part 3. Assume Army expected bill ROK govt for counterpart deposit for all items financed by ECA fund transfer to DA. However also assume this not necessarily confined to existing fund and if found more desirable here deposits subsequent ECA phase-out could be made existing won fund derived sale relief supplies by ROK or new account established. Finally assume ECA legislative requirement met by DA statement to ECA Wash after final termination pipeline next autumn. to effect that ROK govt had deposited X billion won in return X million dollars in goods received ROK. Please confirm.

Part 4. With respect final liquidation accounts of ECA-directed procurement two alternatives apparent.

A. Travell and staff functioning as representatives ECA Wash Controller would follow up with Army and ROK authorities Fusan on receipt all goods landed in present pipeline Korea subsequent formal abolition ECA Mission. Discharge reports would be obtained and Travell would bill ROK govt for counterpart deposit. Also as additional payments info or adjustments received from ECA Wash ROK would be billed. This process would be continued for a time in Tokyo then all Controller records transferred to Manila and work continued from there until all transactions and adjustments fully accounted for with respect proof delivery and counterpart deposit. Tag end adjustments probably not washed out before end calendar 1951 since we still receiving adjustments several months after delivery goods. Advantages this alternative: (1) Final and complete accounting obtained directly by ECA representative which would prove all accounts and would insure ECA ability show in final report GAO or other authorities that for every dollar spent goods actually delivered and counterpart deposited. (2) Commodity-wise this alternative represents clean break between present pipeline under ECA aegis and new DA-directed pipeline and avoids possibility getting two pipelines mixed up.

Disadvantages: (1) Dual contact and two channels US govt authority with ROK govt re counterpart continuing for extended period of time. (2) Dual responsibilities Travell after departure Tokyo and arrival Manila.

B. On date abolition ECA Mission Army assume responsibility reporting to ECA receipt remaining items ECA pipeline and billing ROK govt counterpart. Report such receipts and billings would go to Travell for time he remains in Tokyo accounting for all goods landed prior relinquishment ECA responsibility and to DA for passing to ECA Wash Controller subsequent Travell departure. EPS Tokyo would mail all subsequent payments documents to ECA Wash.

Advantages: (1) represents clean transfer operating responsibility in field and maintains single point contact ROK govt.

Disadvantages: (1) For a considerable period involves Army here in reporting to DA on old ECA pipeline (unless rule adopted to disregard all dollar adjustments after certain date or where goods already sold by Off Supply).

(2) From ECA standpoint possible disadvantage relying upon another agency rather than getting accounting info directly from source. Greater chance confusion since Travell already thoroughly familiar remaining contracts in ECA pipeline.

Part 5. Possible compromise foregoing might involve cut-off date for transfer commodity receiving and counterpart billing responsibility to Army such date to be sometime subsequent abolition ECA Mission but allowing time for majority present pipeline be landed Korea. April 30 might be suitable date.

Part 6. Army here favors alternative A. Would go along with alternative B or compromise para 5 above only repeat only if reporting and billing confined present small pipeline and no dealings required with either EPS Tokyo or with Travell after his departure from Tokyo. In other words, Army unwilling get involved in any way with internal ECA or EPS procedures in connection our accounts liquidation but is willing render any needed reports to ECA representative here or thru DA channels for passing to ECA in Wash.

Part 7. Separate cable gives Travell estimates completion various phases accounts closing which can be adapted any of three alternatives above.

Part 8. General policy instructions from ECA and DA on foregoing queries required here before financial aspects transfer arrangements can be consummated. End signed Colman Acting

Unless immediate contrary instructions received Mission will transmit letter to Superintendent Operations Jacona stating Army now assuming responsibility supervising operations and that contractor will take any future operating questions to Army Engineer designated by EUSAK. Further stating any procurement of supplies or spare parts needed future by contractor should be coordinated with Army Engineer designated by EUSAK.

Propose closing out counterpart billing this contract in following fashion:

(a) Bill for use Jacona not including Gilbert contract and fuel and maintenance parts thru 31 Mar on basis previously agreed criteria. Assume it no concern ECA whether Army charges counterpart subsequent 1 Apr since no ECA dollars being expended for use Jacona. If counterpart not charged ROK being given free use vessel. Same true however with respect DE's now supplying power.

(b) Dollar cost Gilbert contract to 15 May plus liquidating expenses estimated closely as possible based prior months and ROK govt billed in advance for such total cost. Such procedure fully justified since ROK govt able collect only part won already due from South Korea Electric Power Company for past services Jacona and Gilbert cost. Subject: Counterpart billing.

Permission requested discontinue billing ROK govt for counterpart deposit for dollar charges and adjustments shown report 13 in those cases where goods already landed Korea and counterpart charged on basis info available at the time. In these cases ROK Off Supply has already priced the goods at prices corresponding to invoiced charges plus handling costs. After sales made won proceeds deposited in Sales Proceeds Account and periodic transfers made from this account to apply against Overdraft for Payment of Aid Goods.

Where ROK govt internal sales transactions already completed, billing for counterpart later dollar adjustment merely means bookkeeping transaction debiting overdraft for payment of aid goods and crediting counterpart fund. Some of these adjustments don't show up for many months. For example ocean freight 1949 liftings on Feb 1951 report just received. In view imminent ECA close-out feel highly impracticable continue counterpart billing such adjustments here with absolutely no effect currency circulation, internal sales of goods or other economic impact. For ECA continue billing such adjustments for as long as two years after termination responsibility Korea operations seems wasteful terms accounting work both US and ROK govts.

Are not legal requirements counterpart deposit fully met by original billings?
