Message received as Shanghai's 11 Jan 48 to Seoul is repeated Dept's info, concerning proposed Korean survey group for Mukden:

"Following note received from Dir Shanghai Office Ministry Foreign Affairs Chinese Govt: 'Am directed by Ministry Foreign Affairs to inform you that scheduled repatriation Korean nationals from Manchuria through Chinwangtao, temporarily postponed owing lack transportation facilities from interior to port of embarkation. Appreciate if you inform USAMGIK and request they postpone repatriation arrangements until further notice signed Chen Kuo Lien.'

Chinese Govt has, in spite contra statement this office, that repatriation would not be implemented before survey made, assumed repatriation actually scheduled. Alternate method of survey outlined myrad 8 still possible."
