Protesting demobilization slowdown 5000 soldiers demonstrated in Frankfurt evening 9 January; No major disorders reported. Small demonstration in Paris 8 January.

Nationalist-Communist cease firing order issued 10 January. No clear details of agreement available.

Washington telephone operators initiated strike today, but Chief Signal Officer states that arrangements have been made for emergency communications with all Major Army Installations.

Subject is excess troop shipping Manila radio CX 22930 of 8 January.

Information WYQ figures given in this radio imply a reduction of approximately 90000 spaces for January from original January requirements of 180000 spaces or a reduction of 1/2.

Item 1. No action will be taken until receipt of your further revised requirements for January and succeeding months in accordance with WX 91951 of 8 January from Eisenhower or statement that your figures remain unchanged.

Item 2. In accordance with WX 90272 of 26 December, Navy Magic Carpet lift was released and would not be used in January for Army troop lift. Instructions to this effect were also issued by CNO in theirad 272035 to CINCPACPOA. However it is noted in Manila radio that 6 Magic Carpet Ships are listed for January Manila lift.

It must be emphasized that Magic Carpet Ships not be used in accordance with above.

It is requested that any Dutch flag troopships which have not yet been loaded with troops for return to USA be held and information immediately transmitted to COMCENSERV for possible revised instructions.
