Wash Star Editorial 11 Apr: In his address to the National Assembly at Nanking, Generalissimo Chiang Kai Shek has made the depressing, but not surprising, confession that 7 of his best divisions have been destroyed by the Communists in Manchuria. The destruction has taken place in piecemeal fashion over a period of time. It does not mean that Chiang's forces have suffered a sudden maj defeat or that they are much worse off than they have been for months past. What it does mean, however, is that unless their fortunes change for the better China will have nothing to look forward to but indefinitely prolonged instability and warfare.

Numerically at least, Generalissimo Chiang has had enough force for victory, but he has frankly admitted at Nanking that his Nationalist Govt has made "serious mil mistakes." One of these mistakes, as Secy Marshall has testified, has been that Chiang's Commanders have "continually and emphatically ignored" counsel offered by our American Mission. But the Generalissimo indicates that such past errors will be avoided from now on. If they are, and if the best possible use is made of our aid for economic rehabilitation and mil purposes, the Chinese picture may brighten....

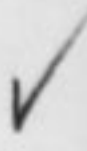

News commentator Bill Costello, CBS News of The World from Tokyo: . . . Among the Japanese, of course, the MacArthur setback is almost universally deplored. The Japanese would like nothing better than to have the Supreme Comdr in the White House.

New York Times correspondent Richard J H Johnston, Seoul 8 Apr: Shortwave American rad broadcasts beamed to this area of the Far East are being effectively jammed by a powerful unidentified transmitter near here. News and commentary in the Russian language reaching here via the Columbia and National Broadcasting Systems shortwave from New York have been unintelligible for the last 3 weeks. . . . Since last week all broadcasts dealing with criticism of the Soviet Union from western capitals or in the UN have been drowned out. The source of the jamming is not known. . . . This week the story of the British - Soviet air collision in Berlin was so effectively jammed that few listeners in this area know of the incident. Much of the English language news broadcasts are permitted to come through, but the nightly Russian language broadcast is now being jammed out regardless of the context. . . . No attempt has been made to jam the armed forces shortwave radio originating in Los Angeles.

The jamming first became evident here in mid-winter, when the shortwave voice of America broadcasts were affected. Mil authorities in South Korea ordered the Sig Corps to

investigate. It was thought the South Korean Police might be misusing low power transmitters recently put into operation. The location and operation of these transmitters were checked, and they were found to be operating in the prescribed manner. Rad experts state that the jamming transmitter affecting this area is powerful. All transmitters in Japan are under US mil control. It is said to be possible that the jamming station is situated northward of this city either in North Korea or in Siberia. The Siberian border is 400 miles from Seoul.

AP Seoul 8 Apr: 4 Korean Police and 12 civilians were killed in a series of 10 attacks on police boxes and conservative homes in Cheju Island, the US Army reported today. Officers here blamed Communists. . . . The Army said communications with the island, 50 miles off Korea's southern tip, are poor and no further details have been learned.

AP Nanking 8 Apr: The Communists rolled toward the key central China railway junction of Chungshien today in an unexpected new offensive.... Gen Teng Wen Yi, government spokesman, confirmed that the government had almost no reserves in the area, where the Nationalists have been claiming complete superiority. Bad news for the government also came from Manchuria, where Communist divisions were reported attacking southwest of Mukden.

NY Herald Tribune editorial 9 Apr: The change of strategy of the Chinese government in the civil war seems to indicate that all hope of recovering Manchuria from the Reds has been abandoned for the present. The statement of a mil spokesman for the government that crushing the Communists in Central China would have priority over "the question of Manchuria" is a clear sign that the loss of Manchuria is now conceded in Nanking... The mil spokesman asserted that the Yellow River would not be China's main line of defense and thus was more realistic that some Chinese have been in recent comments on the war.... Some American observers fear that govt troops may be compelled to give up most China north of the Yangtze within the next year unless there is a marked improvement in their fighting efficiency and in the attitude of the Chinese people toward the Nanking Govt. The mil news fr China, in fact, is extremely bad and there is grave danger that it may become worse.

Christian Science Monitor editorial 6 Apr: If President Chiang become Premier Chiang, the chief effect in China may be to alter the relative importance of the presidency and the premiership. His announcement that the next president should be a scholar rather than a soldier does not herald a basic change in policy. . . .

The difficulties are illustrated by a recent news item. The 4 United States Marines who were freed after being held by the Chinese Communists for 3 months, reported that they found their captors well supplied with American arms. Such arms are known to have reached the Reds in large quantities. When not sold to them by corrupt Nationalist officials, they have been abandoned to them on the battlefield by raw Nationalist troops, impressed into a war for which they have little taste or training. This is one more evidence that even on the level of straight mil realism, political and social changes are fully as important as arms in making Chinese resistance to Communism effective.

NY Herald Tribune correspondent Christopher Rand, Shanghai 7 Apr: Milton Reynolds, by his actions in connection with an abortive aerial expedition to search for a mountain higher than Everest, has left a bad name behind him in China reflecting on American men of science and business. Widespread criticism and bitter charges of bad faith have been directed at the Chicago manufacturer of ball point fountain pens. Two leading Chinese scientists, Dr Sah Pen Tung, head of the Academia Sinica, which was associated with the expedition, and Dr Pei

NY Times correspondent Henry R Lieberman, Nanking, 7 Apr:

Lt Gen Teng Wen Yi, govt mil spokesman, said today that the Nationalists would not make an effort to recapture Loyang in the near future. He ascribed the decision to a "new policy" of disregarding points that "have no strategic value." He indicated however that the government's "new policy" was partly the result of a shortage of troops to combat large Red striking forces on widely separated fronts. . . .

AP Nanking 7 Apr. Lt Gen Teng Wen Yi, mil spokesman, said operation in Central China would get priority over "the question of Manchuria." He asserted the Yellow River was the government's main line of defense.

Radio commentator George Thomas Folster, NBC World News Night Special, Tokyo 7 Apr: . . . and that's what's really important about MacArthur's entry into politics, how will MacArthur's experiment with American politics affect the occupation. After all MacArthur's job is the occupation of Japan and, as nothing succeeds like success, especially with the Japanese, the reverse could also be true. MacArthur could lose plenty of "face" if he doesn't make this grade and whether you like it or not, "face" is very important out here in the Orient, and from Gen MacArthur's Hq across the street from the Emperor's palace, comes not a word. nothing but silence.

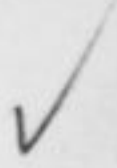

The House Armed Services Committee has reported favorably an amended form of the "Women's Armed Services Integration Act of 1948" (S 1641) providing for the enlistment and appointment of women in the ERC and in the ORC, and extending the WAC, AUS for a period of 12 months from the passage of the bill. As amended, the bill does not provide for women in the RA but does authorize the retention of volunteers in the WAC, AUS for a period of 1 yr, and the utilization on active duty of WAC reserve officers and enlisted women.

Inasmuch as S 1641 provided for women in the RA as well as in the reserve when it passed the Senate, it will be necessary for a joint committee of both houses to resolve the differences if the bill is passed by the House in its amended form.

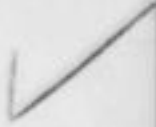

Under the Constitution of the US a corporation is considered to be a citizen of the US. The same provisions with respect to citizenship of a corporation is covered by respective state constitutions. What ever opposition to foreign aid existed in the Senate has long since evaporated and Sen Arthur H Vandenberg, Chairman of the Foreign Relations Commdttee, was able to get the bill through after a single days debate and without even a roll call. The Senator or rather Chiang Kai Shek did get a little rough handling from Sen Wayne Morse....

"How much freedom of choice is there in China today under the Nationalist Govt?" asked Morse, adding: "I think that the State Dept ought to make it clear that we aren't going to support Fascist Govt or Communist Govt either, and I am satisfied that China today is more Fascist than Democratic."

Vandenberg replied that while things weren't perfect in China they held out a hope of improvement. He said that democracy was relative and that while there was a chance for democracy under the Nationalists, there wouldn't be any under the Communists.

Phila Evening Bulletin Editorial, 30 Mar: Sen Vandenberg's wise editing saved the Senate Foreign Relations Committee from going on record as denouncing the Nationalist Govt in China as inefficient and corrupt. Had the staff report stood as written it would have been insulting to a friendly govt which is still our ally and served as ammunition to the Communists who would like nothing better than to hear Chiang Kai Shek's regime called names by the Senate Committee....Americans looking abroad have a tendency to demand near perfection in foreign govts. It is an irritating quality that alienates many who are associated with

NY Times correspondent Henry R Lieberman, Nanking, 30 Mar: Gen Li Tsung Jen, head of Generalissimo Chiang Kai Shek's North China Hq, said today that the Nanking regime would fail in its attempt to defeat the Communists unless it sought to raise the peasants standard of living. "It is my sincere conviction that the most pressing problem confronting the North China and Manchuria is that of the peoples livelihood," he said. "Without solving that problem all military measures are doomed to failure."....

NY Herald Tribune correspondent Christopher Rand, Shanghai 30 Mar: The ... confusion in which China's National Assembly opened yesterday in Nanking arose from a conflict between 2 efforts at reform by the Nanking Govt. The assembly adjourned temporarily for lack of a quorum soon after it opened. Neither of the Govts reform efforts was aimed realistically at the needs of China. The Act provides that the authority conferred upon the Sec of State and the Attorney Gen under the provisions of the Act approved 29 Jun 46 (60 Stat 339), shall be extended to 31 Dec 48, midnight. Clause (B) of the proviso of the first section of the Act approved 29 Jun 46 (60 Stat 339), is hereby repealed. The Act shall be regarded as having become effective from and after 31 Dec 47.
