Chicago Tribune, Wash 29 Aug:

"The Army will withdraw its 19,000 troops from Korea by next March, except for a military mission to train the Korean Constabulary and Coast Guard as a defense force against Soviet occupied North Korean Communists, Pentagon sources disclosed today. Last March, the Army had an estimated 30,000 troops in Korea, but this strength has declined.

"Withdrawal of the American troops is expected to be gradual and will conform with recommendations of the UN, under whose auspices the new republic was created. Enough American troops will be maintained in Southern Korea to provide security against possible attacks from the Soviet Zone to the North, military officials said. . . . President Syngman Rhee of the Korean Republic has declared that his govt wants the American troops to remain until it feels it is capable of defending itself. . . ."

will be to throw all of Korea into the expanding Soviet empire. Under the circumstances, this remarkable decision, taken without any public discussion of the grave issues involved and only now disclosed, deserves rather careful study. . . . The conclusion that Korea was not worth holding was reached on 2 grounds. The occupation costs in the American Zone of Korea amount to between 200 and 300 million dollars a year. The Army can ill afford the 24,000 troops now on garrison duty in Korea. And from the standpoint of straight mil strategy, Okinawa and the Japanese islands are positions of equal, if not greater value. . . .

"Before the final evacuation, for example, the American garrison will recruit and train a South Korean Constabulary of 40,000 men or more. When the American garrison departs, it will leave its arms behind. And the South Koreans may perhaps be assisted by an American mil mission. . . . The main objection to the Korea decision is simply that the issue, whether palsy, is our only possible Asiatic policy, is doing something about Asia. . . ."

Radio Commentator George Thomas Foster, NBC News Roundup from Tokyo 27 Aug:

Both here and back home there in the States, there is the further question that perhaps Gen MacArthur's actions directing the Japanese Civil Service does not agree with what the Far Eastern Commission would like to have done. I know that Gen MacArthur's hq has received at least 2 lists of questions from Wash, questions that Wash wants answered, questions pertaining to Gen MacArthur's labor policies in occupied Japan. . . .

NY Times correspondent Henry R Lieberman, Urumchi, Sinkiang. 19 Aug: Sinkiang, whose northwest corner already has been shaved off by rebel Turki forces, is the lower flank of a prospective pro-Soviet border belt extending northeastward through outer Mongolia and Communist held Manchuria to the Sea of Okhotsk. ...

Sino Russian relations throughout the Far East have affected and been affected by the larger world pattern of Russo-American relations. Russian policy in Sinkiang seems to have been shaped recently more in terms of US air power than in terms of China's comparatively weak military potentialities. Soviet concern over the landing of American planes here points up apparent fear based on the proximity of Urumchi to industrial areas in Soviet Central Asia. ...

Everything the government has done on Hokkaido has been done with the knowledge and support of the US Army authorities, and the press is giving great prominence to a speech by Maj Gen William M Miley, Commander of the 11th Abn Div, in which he made the Army's position plain in no uncertain terms. . . .

Dept Justice will reimburse Army for all expense involved transporting D'Aquino, guards and witnesses.

Mrs D'Aquino who is residing at an unknown address in Tokyo, Japan, should be apprehended and transported to the US to arrive at San Francisco aboard the SS Gen H Frank Hodges on 28 Sep 45 under such guard as deemed necessary to insure her safe return. Justice Dept indicated G-2 your command may have info relative her whereabouts. Guard detail should contain sufficient female pers so that D'Aquino may be in continuous custody. Dept Justice desires seek indictment at San Francisco which is located in the Northern Dist of Calif. Since this crime was committed outside of the US, jurisdiction lies in the district in which the port of entry is located. Therefore, it is imperative that in returning D'Aquino she be transported aboard a vessel which will not touch the territories of Hawaii, Alaska, or the Federal Judicial Districts comprising the same, since such a call even though temporary, might be held to vest the Federal Courts of those territories with jurisdiction to try this important criminal



C. For the purposes of these rules and regs, the "fund", means the aggregate at any time existing of all monies and tangible and intangible property of every character derived from operations under the act, so long as such monies or property shall not have been consumed or disposed of pursuant to the act.

D. Other words used herein have the same meaning as that contained for the same words in the act.

2. Purpose these rules and regs are made for the efficient implementation of the provisions of the act.

3. Policy.

A. Pvt channels of trade shall be utilized to the maximum extent feasible.

B. To the above end, it is considered desirable that operations hereunder shall be conducted as nearly as may be in the manner and form substantially similar to the methods and practices prevailing in comparable pvt business enterprises.

C. Every reasonable effort will be made to coordinate and harmonize performance of the functions hereunder with the other trade and commerce of occupied areas.

D. The fund shall be employed in such ways as to provide the maximum possible assistance in accomplishment of US objectives in occupied areas, but always with a view to the safeguarding of the fund and repayment of the principal and interest of loans made by the Secretary of the Treasury.

E. In order to carry out US objectives, it is considered necessary and desirable, and is hereby determined that, (I) Japan, and (II) Bizonal Germany, occupied jointly with the United Kingdom, each shall constitute an, "occupied area", within the meaning of the act, and then as soon as, "Trizonal Germany", occupied jointly with France and the United Kingdom, shall have been established, it shall constitute and is hereby declared to be an, "occupied area", within the meaning of the act.

4. Administration.

A. To minimize delays and promote efficiency in opr the Secretary of the Army hereby designates the Chief, Civil Affairs Divison, DA, or the Acting Chief, Civil Affairs Div, as the case may be, as his special representative. It will be the responsibility of the special representative to coordinate and supervise the performance of all functions under the act, to harmonize and reconcile differences of opinion

to take appropriate action for the Secretary, and to keep the Secretary informed. He will from time to time supplement these rules and regs by his rulings and instructions which will be binding on all persons performing any function under the act, and will control their actions in all cases, including those cases in which it is stated in these regs that action will be taken by or under the auth of a particular officer or by auth of an occupied area. He will have direct access to the Secretary of the Army at all times.

B. Functions under the act will be performed by such pers of the DA, of MG for occupied areas and of govt departments and agencies, and by such other persons, firms, corporations and organizations as may be necessary or convenient.

C. Such persons as may be so auth by proper auth within the DA or by proper auth of the US within an occupied area may act for and in the name of the Secretary of the Army in the making, performance, amendment and modification of contract and arrangements for purchasing, transporting, storing, insuring, processing and selling under Sec 1 of the act; in disbursing, collecting and depositing monies of the fund, in inspecting, accepting or rejecting commodities, and generally in the doing of all acts that may be incident to performance of the functions described in Sec 1 of the act.

## 5. Allocation of the fund.

A. Monies borrowed from the Treasury Department under the act will be allocated for use by the various occupied areas in such amounts and proportions as may be apd by the sp representative upon the basis of requests for such funds made by proper MG auth for an occupied area.

B. Portions of the fund allocated to an occupied area will be under the control of appropriate MG auth for that occupied area, but subj to such directions or instructions as may be issued by the sp representative.

## 6. Contracts, expenditures and deposits.

A. Contracts will be made, apd, performed, amended and modified in such form and manner as may be found appropriate and convenient by proper auth of the US for each occupied area.

B. Whenever a part of the fund is delivered into the custody of anyone other than the DA or US auth for an occupied area, arrangements shall be effected in each case fully to protect and preserve the full and exclusive ownership of the Secretary of the Army in and with respect to such part of the fund. These arrangements may be in the form of appropriate warehouse receipts, custody and safe keeping contracts, bills of lading, other sp contracts of bailment, trust receipts, sp deposit contracts, sp markings and notices posted on tangible parts of the fund, or any other contracts or arrangements adequate to protect the exclusive right and title of the Secretary of the Army.

C. Deposits of money included in the fund will be made in separate accounts in banking institutions, or established on the books of govt agencies or departments, wherever located, as may be considered safe and convenient and on terms and conditions deemed appropriate by the COFFIN, DA, or by proper MG auth for an occupied area actg pursuant to such auth or instructions as may be issued by the COFFIN .

D. Subj to such procedural instructions as may be issued by the COFFIN, DA, expenditures will be made in such form and manner and at such times as may be considered appropriate by proper MG auth for an occupied area. No expenditure will be made except for the purposes described in the act, as determined by proper auth of the US for the occupied area.

E. Subj to procedural instructions that may be issued by the COFFIN, DA, establishment and use of letters of credit, letters of commitment, other commercial financing arrangements, and issuance or acceptance of bills, drafts, notes and other instruments incident to commercial financing arrangements, all may be done in such manner and to such extent as may be found appropriate and convenient by proper MG auth for each occupied area.

7. Acctng and reports.

A. Under the supervision of the COFFIN, acctng for the fund will fol fiscal, property and fund acctng procedures in use for the adm of the DA, to the extent practicable for adm under the act, deviations, therefore will conform as nearly as reasonably may be to good acctng practice employed in pvt business.

B. Within each occupied area in which any part of the fund may be, separate records shall be maintained, adequate to show at all times the status of the fund.

C. Materials and commodities purchased under the act will be separately marked in such ways as may be practicable to indicate that they are part of the fund. They may be used or

consumed in processing, and may be mingled with other materials and commodities in transit, storage, and processing. When they are combined or used jointly with other materials and commodities, not part of the fund, in processing, appropriate steps will be taken by occupation auth reasonably to assure fair apportionment of products and proceeds between the fund and the other materials and commodities, not part of the fund, with which parts of the fund have been used, mingled or combined.

D. All persons performing functions under the act will make reports in such form, quantity and manner and at such times as may be required by the sp representatives. In any event reports showing the status of the fund for ea occupied area having any portion of the fund will be submitted at monthly intervals by proper auth for such occupied area to the sp representative for appropriate distribution.

## 8. Procurement, trans and insurance.

A. Procurement, trans and insurance for the fund will be by such methods and on such terms and conditions as may be desired by proper auth of the US for ea occupied area. Except as herein otherwise specified, procurement for the fund may be conducted without regard to provisions of any law other than the act and without regard to other regs relating to the making, performance, amendment or modification of contracts, purchases, or expenditure or obligations of funds. However, in any event, marine cargo insurance and war risk insurance, in form and amt substantially similar to such insurance customarily used in pvt export trade, payable in US dollars, will be obtained for commodities by the fund while in transit.

B. While pvt channels of trade must be utilized to the maximum extent feasible, it is contemplated that procurement, transportation and insurance may be effected as fol:

(1). By pvt industry or business, acting as agent for the Secretary of the Army, under designation by US auth of the interested occupied area, and under arrangements epd by the sp representative, under which arrangements the exclusive property interest of the Secretary of the Army must be fully protected and preserved, and pursuant to which all action of said pvt industry or business, in relation to the fund will be under the continuous supervision of US auth of an occupied area with a view to assuring the protection, preservation and

By trade, industry or commercial orgns, either pvt or governmental, in an occupied area, either directly or in combination with pvt industry, under designation by US auth of the interested occupied area, subj to arrangements and supervision of the same character and for the same purposes as those required under Sub Para (1) of this Sub Sec (B);

(3). By appropriate MG auth of an occupied area, with procedures and under safeguards prescribed by US auth for the occupied area to protect and preserve the property interests of the Secretary of the Army and to assure the protection, preservation and efficient use of the fund. If this method of procurement, trans and insurance includes action by a purchasing and contracting off of the DA, stationed in the interested occupied area, methods then prevailing for such action of a purchasing and contracting off within the DA will be followed so far as may be practical;

(4). By procurement and trans of the DA stationed in the US, in which case the Armed Svs Procurement Regulations will be applicable insofar as they may apply.

9. Selling notwithstanding the provisions of any law other than the act, selling for the fund will be in such manner and by such methods, on such terms and conditions, including reasonable extension of credit, and for such consideration in any currency as may be considered acceptable by proper auth of the US for each occupied area, having in mind the repayment provisions of the act.

10. Disposition of the fund in occupied areas.

A. Arrangements for processing within occupied areas will be made on such terms and conditions as may be found appropriate by proper MG auth for each occupied area.

B. Determination as to the amt of the fund that may be used and disposed of for the benefit of the economy of each occupied area, and the time and manner of such use of disposition, will be made by proper authority of the US for such occupied area, but so long as there shall be any indebtedness under the act to the Secretary of the Treasury no such use of disposition of more than 25% of commodities, purchased, whether used or disposed of in the form of commodities, products or proceeds, shall be made without the prior apl of the sp representative.

C. Acts pursuant to the above Sub Sect A and B with respect to any commodity, product or proceeds shall never be permitted to reduce the applicable part of the fund below the amounts specified in Clauses (1) and (2) of Sec 2 of this act. Commodities in the fund shall be valued at cost, and currencies

other than US dollars shall be valued at ofl or other rates of exchange at which rates they may be converted into US dollars.

D. Except as required for repayments to the Secretary of the Treasury, monetary proceeds of sales from the fund may be retained under the control of MG auth for the interested occupied area, subj to such procedural direction and instructions as may be issued by the COFFIN, for use as a working fund for the making of expenditures auth by Sec 1 of the act, but the amount of each working fund shall at all times be subj to the apl of the sp representative. No disbursements shall be made from such working funds if the particular disbursement will impair repayment of indebtedness to the Secretary of the Treasury. The working fund will be used for purchase of commodities only after (I) submission of a certificate and justification substantially similar to the certificate and justification required under Sec 11 (C) hereof, and (II) apl of such proposed expenditure by the sp representative. Subj to obligations and commitments of the fund, monies of the fund may at any time be withdrawn from the control of the occupied area, whenever it is determined by the sp representative that such withdrawal is necessary or desirable for the purpose of paying principal or interest on any borrowings from the Secretary of the Treasury.

11. Borrowing from and repayments to the Treasury Dept

A. Requests that money be borrowed from the Secretary of the Treasury, under the act, will be initiated by proper MG auth for an occupied area, and forwarded to the sp representative, who will prepare recommendations and supporting data for decision by the Secretary of the Army. The latter, in his discretion may request loans from the Secretary of the Treasury to be evidenced by notes signed by the Secretary of the Army, in such form and on such terms as to interest rates and pmt of principal and interest as from time to time may be agreed.

B. Monies borrowed from the Treasury will be made available for the interested occupied area, and from time to time repaid, in such manner and by such means as may be apd. or determined by the COFFIN, DA.

C. Each request from an occupied area that money be borrowed under the act shall include a certificate (which may be by cable) of proper auth of the US for the interested

News item by Walter Simmons date line Guam 26 Jul 48 has received wide publicity and has been brought to the attn of members of the Congress and is of concern to the Secretary of the Army.

"Skippers claim 'incompetence' at Guam Harbor by Walter Simmons (Chicago Tribune Press Service) Guam, Jul 26—Masters of small Army vessels tied up in Apra Harbor are indignant at what they call 'smug incompetence' of NPNTM Medium Port officials ashore. They complain especially of long waits in harbor for repairs parts.

"Investigation by the Tribune disclosed that 1 vessel, the large tug Orote Point (LT 352) has been tied up in the harbor since last Oct 5 with a full crew aboard. The tug is awaiting repair parts for its main engine and generators. Prospects are, said William M Leeds, of Los Angeles, her skipper, the Orote Point will lie motionless for several more months.

"Combined wages of the skipper and 22 crew members are \$4,500 monthly. An additional \$870 is allowed for food. Others await repairs.

"If this ship belonged to a private owner, he would have flown the necessary parts out here inside of a week, commented the master of a tug tied up alongside. Leeds said 5 cases of generator parts arrived a month ago, but had been lost on the dock. An island-wide search failed to locate them.

"Other ships in the harbor included the LST 246, which had beached at Iwo several weeks ago and was towed to Guam for repairs; the ST 839, which had been waiting engine and generator parts for 6 weeks; the LSM 429, which had bent her propellers on a reef at Rota, and the FS 400.

At conference on 11 Aug 48 with representatives of the Veterans Administration and DA the following agreements were reached with respect to furnishing the Veterans Administration info of Philippine Commonwealth Army and PS Pers:

A. The furnishing of service history data to the Manila Veterans Administration Regional Office is a responsibility of the CG PHILCOM.

B. In developing service history data, field investigations will be made only on those cases where actual determinations of service cannot be established by review of existing files and by mail communication as to the necessity for field investigations rests with CG PHILCOM.

C. On individual request, CG PHILCOM will furnish all medical records in the custody of PHILCOM and any medical records that may be obtained from the Philippine Govt.

D. On each Veterans Administration case a thorough analysis will be made by PHILCOM of files in its custody as well as files in the custody of the Philippine Govt that are accessible in the Manila area to determine if derogatory info is on file. Where derogatory info is on file for a number of individuals with the same name as the veteran claimant, effort will be made to determine whether any of this info pertains to the claimant in question.

In the event that this cannot be determined conclusively, the Manila Veterans Administration Regional Office will be informed of info that possible relates to the claimant, and that agency will make final determination of the applicability of such info. Representatives of PHILCOM present at above mentioned conference stated that additional personnel and funds
