Reference JAAPAR 1-1-10 dtd 14 Feb 49. Effective 1 Jul 49 all US Army personnel assigned to or assigned for duty with Dept of Air Force must be paid from funds budgeted by Dept of Air Force. These personnel are defined as SCARWAF. Effective immediately Army personnel will be assigned for duty with Dept of Air Force or subordinate commands, agencies, or units thereof only with Dept of the Army or Dept of Air Force authority. All Army personnel not SCARWAF, required for duty with Air Force organizations or hq, will be assigned to Dept of Army commands or organizations.

Where the requirement for non-SCARWAF personnel for duty with a Dept of Air Force agency had been approved by the Dept of the Army, personnel will be assigned only as directed by Dept of the Army and attached for duty with the Dept of Air Force with station as directed. Where the requirement is local and temporary in nature, the personnel will remain assigned to their Army organization and may be placed on DS or TDY with the appropriate Air Force agency. Further, under these conditions, departmental and command assignment will remain with Dept of Army.

It is desired that all Army personnel, other than SCARWAF, currently assigned to Air Force organizations be reassigned to appropriate Dept of the Army organizations. Cite this rad as authority for such reassignments. Dept of Air Force issuing confirmatory instructions to their corresponding commands.

Tokyo 6 Mar: An increasing outcry against competition of cheap

Soviet member FEC made fol statement at meeting 3 Mar 49 and immediately released to press:

"The question of labor policy in Japan and that of Gen MacArthur's violation of the Potsdam Declaration and the decision of the FEC in re to the democratization of Japan is already being discussed in the FEC for several months. The discussion of this question began, as is known, in connection with the fact that on July 22, 48, Gen MacArthur issued to the Japanese Govt a directive in which he demanded that workers and employees of govt enterprises and institutions be forbidden to conclude collective agreements and to strikes, and also, in connection with the cabinet order of the Japanese Govt of July 31, 48, issued in compliance with this directive.

"In its statement of Sept 16, 48, the Soviet delegation called the attn of the FEC to the fact that the said actions of Gen MacArthur were in contradiction with the Potsdam Declaration in respect to Japan and that they constituted a violation of the decisions of the FEC in re to the democratization of Japan. At that time the Soviet delegation submitted for the consideration of the comm a draft decision which provided that the above-mentioned dir of Gen MacArthur and the order of the Japanese Govt be revoked since they deprived a major part of the Jap worker's and employee's of their elementary rights to protect their vital interests. The Soviet delegation insisted also that repressions against workers and employees of govt enterprises and institutions should be discontinued. After a lengthy discussion of the proposals of the Soviet delegation, this proposal was rejected in the beginning of Jan by the majority of the comm members. Thus, the majority actually took the position of supporting the policy of the US mil auth in Japan which

is in violation of the Potsdam Declaration in respect to Japan and the decisions of the FEC re the democratization of Japan.

"At the same time the above-mentioned anti-Democratic measures were approved by the Japanese Diet under the pressure of the US occupation auth in Japan, and were reflected in the amendments adopted by the Japanese Diet to the National Public Service Law of Nov 30, 38. In order to prove that the adopted laws are basically in contradiction with the principles, decided upon by the FEC in re to Japanese trade unions set forth in the decision of Dec 6, 46/(principles for Japanese trade unions) it is sufficient to give the fol examples:

"In para 1 of the above-mentioned decision it is stated:

'Japanese workers should be encouraged to form themselves into trade unions for the purpose of preserving and improving conditions of work participating in industrial negotiations to this end, and otherwise assisting the legitimate trade union interests of workers, incl organized participation in building up a peaceful and Democratic Japan.'

The same objective of protecting the Democratic rights of trade unions is pursued by para 2 of this decisions:

'The right of trade unions and their members to organize for these purposes should be assured and protected by law. The freedom of workers to join trade unions should be provided for by law. All laws and regs preventing trade unions achieving those objective should be imaprogated. Employers should be forbidden to refuse employment to, or discriminate against, a worker because he is a member of a trade union.'

"In para 4 it is also stated that:

'Trade unions should be encouraged to negotiate with the employers on behalf of their members re terms and conditions of employment. The Japanese Govt should establish mediation and arbitration machinery for dealing with industrial disputes that cannot be settled by dir and volunteer negotiation between the worker or his representative and the employer. The mediation and arbitration machinery should operate under conditions assuring the protection of the interests of the workers'

"Such are the FEC decisions the purpose of which is to protect the legitimate interests of Japanese workers and trade unions fr the arbitrary actions of employers.

However, the above-mentioned laws deprive the workers and

employees of govt enterprises and institutions of the elementary rights of protecting their interests by means of concluding collective agreements as well as by means of participation in labor conflicts. Severe repressive measures incl imprisonment for a period of 1 to 3 years and a fine of 100,000 yen are imposed for participation in such conflicts.

"As to the workers and employees of other branches of industry and the national economy, these laws give the cabinet ministers the right to define the categories of workers and employees which are allowed to participate in trade unions and also the right to determine a list of questions which according to the opinion of the govt, may be incl in collective agreements for workers.

"13 of the above-mentioned decision of the FEC is also violated. This par reads as fols:

'Japanese Govt and other agencies which were set up or functioned for the purpose of obstructing or in such a way as to obstruct free labor organization and legitimate trade union activities should be abolished or their powers in respect to labor revoked. No police or other govt agencies should be employed in spying on workers, breaking strikes, or suppressing legitimate union activities.'

"In violation of this par the revised national public sv lw establishes a system of police spying and repressive measures in respect to govt workers and employees. Besides, these illegal measures against the workers and employees are being taken on a more and more broad scale.

"Finally, par 6 of the com decisions reads:

'Trade unions should be allowed to take part in political activities and to support political parties'.

"Very often this par is rudely violated. This can be seen even fr a fact that the revised national public sv law permits the national pers auth which is under the prime minister to determine at its discretion the character of political activities of govt employees and also provided for the prohibition of the govt employees to engage in any political activities other than exercising the right to vote. In practice this has led to arbitrary measures of the part of Japanese auth in respect to govt employees and to an offensive against their elementary and inalienable rights.

"The above-mentioned examples refute the US representatives statement at the com meeting on Jan 13, 49 to the effect that the recent Japanese laws, mentioned above, allegedly are not inconsistent with the principles set forth in the FEC desision in respect to Japanese trade unions.

"It is notable that in his statement the US representative could not but recognize the absolutely self-evident fact that the Com decisions do not make any distinctions between the workers and employees engaged in Govt enterprises and institutions and those engaged in private enterprises. Nevertheless, the US mil auth in Japan and the Japanese Govt acting under their patronage, do make such distinctions depriving first of all the workers and employees engaged in govt enterprises and institutions of their legitimate rights.

"The attempt of the US representative to prove that the Suspreme Commander, allegedly, has the right to interpret and implement the Com decisions at his own discretion was dictated by a clear intention to justify illegal action of Gen MacArthur and those of the Japanese Govt. This attempt constitutes an example of ignoring the rights of the FEC which is the only agency formulate allied policy in respect to Japan. Recently such attempts have become more and more numerous.

"In this connection it is impossible not that of aforesaid new laws have led to the increase of police reprisals against Japanese workers, trade union leaders, promoters of Democracy in Japan, and that these reprisals are now being extended not only to the workers and employees of Govt enterprises and institutions to whom new Japanese laws are dir applied, but also to the workers and employees of other branches of industry.

"As examples of arbitrations and repressions against workers and employees during the recent time one may point out the fol:

"In Nov 48 the Mil Tribunal of the 24th US Inf Div in Kokura sentenced 16 trade union offs to hard labor. The beating by the Japanese police on Nov 28, 48 of girl-operators of the Tokyo Central Telephone sta who were on strike may be taken as another example of unlawful practices. The sentencing of 20 railway workers in the city of Asahigawa (Nokkaido) to imprisonment, although they did not commit any crime or offense, also belongs to the same illegal tricks.

"It is also known that there are repeated cases when representatives of the Supreme Comdrs Hq summon trade union leaders and by threats of repressions and a dir pressure upon the representatives of striking workers and employees deprive them of their legitimate rights and interests.

"On Feb 3 the Japanese Labor Ministry issued an order in respect to the activity of trade unions. By this order the prefectural governors are required to examine the 'constitutionality' of trade unions and to dissolve those of them which will not answer the criteria established by the above-mentioned order of the Ministry of Labor. In accordance with these criteria, the trade unions which engage in the organization of mutual aid for their members, engage in cultural activities, and take part in political activities are considered as unconstitutional and subj to dissolution.

"It is not difficult to note that this order of the Japanese Ministry of Labor, approved on Feb 2, 49 by the Labor Div of Gen MacArthur's Hq, once again rudely violated the FEC decision of Dec 6, 46.

"According to the rpts widely published in the Japanese press the Japanese Govt is at the present time preparing itself for the further limitation of the rights of the Japanese working people by means of a new revision of labor legislation and trade union statutes as well. With this purpose there was created a government-aid com which according to Mr Hepner, Chief of Labor Div of the US Occupation Forces Hq, should 'prepare a bill for the revision of labor legislation.'

"On Feb 14 the Japanese Ministry of Labor published new drafts for the revision of the trade union law and the labor relations law.

"The publishing of these drafts created a wave of protests on the part of Japanese Democratic organizations. In particular, the two largest trade union organizations of Japan-the National Congress of Industrial Trade Unions and the All Japanese Federation of Labor were against these drafts. In the statement of the National Congress of Trade Unions it is pointed out that the above mentioned drafts were 'one-sidedly and undemocratically worked out by the govt in an attempt to take advantage of the US program on the stabilization of Japanese economy for the revision of labor legislation to the worse.'

"On Feb 25 a delegation of 11 Japanese trade unions visited the members of the Allied Council for Japan and presented them a petition. In the petition it is stated that the above-mentioned

bills, prepared by the Japanese Govt, are dir towards abolishing labor agreements, that they deprive the workers of elementary human rights, ignore the right of workers to participate in the consideration of the labor relations law and sanction the right of the local govt labor boards to interfere dir in trade union affairs. The delegation justly states that the anti-democratic measures and laws being passed in Japan are in contradiction with the decision of the FEC re the Japanese trade unions.

"The representatives of 11 trade unions appeal to the countries participating in the control over Japan, with the request to prevent these anti-democratic measures of the Japanese Govt.

"Such is the position of the Japanese workers and employees in re to the anti-democratic laws and measures, being passed by the Japanese Govt with the encouragement and on the dir orders of the US mil auth. How can the FEC not listen to the voice of the representatives of the Japanese trade unions? It cannot, of course, do this since not to reckon with these legitimate demands of the workers of Japan means to ignore its own decisions, dir toward the attainment of democratization of Japan.

"In view of the fact that the revised public sv law of Nov 30, 48 and the Public Corporations Labor Relations Law of Dec 11, 48,

by the Japanese Diet on the basis of Gen MacArthur's dir of July 22, 48, as well as the drafts for the revision of the Labor Relations Adjustment Law and the Trade Union Law, published by the Japanese Govt on Feb 14 deprive the Japanese workers and employees of their inalienable right to fight for the protection of their legitimate interests and rights, provided for by the decisions of the FEC, the Soviet delegation submits the fol proposals for the consideration of the com:

"1. The FEC finds that the revised 'National Public sv law' and the 'Public Corporations Labor Relations Law' adopted by the Japanese Diet on Nov 30 and Dec 11, 48, respectively, as well as the draft of the Labor Relations Adjustment Law and the draft of the Trade Union Law, published on Feb 14, dir towards depriving the Japanese workers and employees of the possibility of protecting their legitimate rights, constitute a violation of the decisions of the FEC-'basic post-surrender policy for Japan' of 19 Jun 47 and 'principles for Japanese trade unions' of Dec 6, 46.

"2. The FEC deems it nec that on the part of the Supreme Comdr of the US Occupation Forces in Japan approp measures be taken towards the abrogation of the revised 'National Public Sv Law' and the 'Public Corporations Labor Relations Law'.

"3. The FEC draws the attn of the Supreme Comdr to the nec of taking actions to prevent in the future the adoption by the Japanese Govt and the Japanese Diet of measures which violate the Potsdam Declaration in respect to Japan and the policy decisions of

The mystery lies in why Gen MacArthur should consider it desirable, at this stage of events, to make it sound as though we and the Russians are no longer any threat to each other in the Far East. He did just that, today-twice. Once was by a press interview with a visiting British Journalist...the other time was by unwrapping a...Russian deserter for another gen interview for all the press at the MacArthur Hq...it is newsworthy because it is not the customary point of view of Gen MacArthur's Hq. Only 3 wks ago, the same hq released its much criticized acct of pre-war Russian espionage in Japan. The highlight of that report was an accompanying warning to all of us to beware of the doctrine that Chinese Communists could be disloyal to Moscow. Today's statement that Japanese Communists have no direct connection with Moscow makes strange reading against that recent warning. If Chinese Communists were dangerous 3 wks ago, why are Japanese Communists not dangerous today? Then, we heard today the talk reported fr Gen MacArthur's Hq has been consistently to the effect that our strategic pos in the Far East is dangerously threatened and we should send armies into China....that Japan should be developed as the base for our ops against Russia in the Far East. Today, we're told that the Pacific Ocean is an Anglo Saxon Lake, that Russia is incapable of threatening our pos in it and that in case of war Japan would probably be neutral...It is a total reversal of pos and is bound to be noted as such in every foreign office and every Mil Planning Staff the world around. But why? There you and I can only guess. My own guess is that the day when our mil comdrs in both Japan and Germany made natl policy are nearly over. Gen MacArthur had a policy in Japan...Wash thinking has moved steadily away fr both Clay and MacArthur policies. It is no discredit to either general to say that their policies have not prevailed; it was never a fact that they have not prevailed...Today's news product fr Gen MacArthur's Hq would seem to suggest that he is in the process of adjusting his pos to the Wash belief that the danger-if there is danger-lies principally in Europe and not in the Far East.

1. DA recognizes difficulties inherent to the utilization of low cal enl pers and is making sp efforts to apportion this gp among all comds so that no 1 comd will be forced to bear the brunt of this problem.

2. During expansion phase of the Army during the last half of 48, it was nec to train common spec1 and leaders plus a certain number of sch tnd spec1 in order to prov suitable cadre for the tng divs and other high priority units scd for activation. In order to meet the needs for this cadre program as well as the quotas for the DA pipeline schs, over 30 per cent of the input to the tng divs were selected for further sch tng. This 30 per cent was made up of EM having GCT scores of 90 and above. Although a small portion of the ldrs course grads and an equitable portion of the sch grads had been allocated to the FEC, the bulk of the shpmts were basic trainees who constituted the major source of perquald pers. It is evident, therefore, that the GCT spread of any 1 gp of basics fr the tng divs contained a larger percentage of EM in the lower gps. The hv shpmts to FEC during the last few months had to be met primarily fr the tng div out put. Incd in these shpmts were a proportionate share of the sch out put. For example, the enl pers scd for Dec shpmt to FEC consisted of approx 4218 basics and 2596 SSN (incls both sch and prior sv) or 38 per cent SSN pers. Destinations for the above furn by the FEC incd the fol to Okinawa; approx 967 basics and 893 SSN or 48 per cent SSN pers.

3. As a result of the recent cut back in the planned strength of the Army the present conds have changed materially so that shpmts to the oversea comds will incd a larger percentage of common spec1, ldrs grads, and sch tnd pers. For example, the Feb allocation of approx 7000 to the FEC incls over 2100 sch
