Para 1 General. Pending revision of Army Regulations 700-105, 30 Jun 48, the following is published for the immediate compliance of all concerned.

Para 2 Assignment of official passenger vehicles. Official passenger vehicles will not be assigned on a full-time basis to officers and employees of the DA on duty at the seat of the government or in the field, within or without the continental limits of the US, other than to the holders of the following offices, who have been authorized by law to utilize such services, whose work has been determined to require their active participation in diplomatic matters pertaining to military liaison with representatives of foreign nations:

- A. The Sec of the Army,
- B. The Under Sec of the Army,
- C. The Asst secretaries of the Army,
- D. The Chief of Staff, USA,
- E. The Vice Chief of Staff, USA,
- F. Generals of the Army,
- G. Such additional persons as may, from time to time, be designated by the Sec of Defense.

Para 3 Use of official passenger vehicles. 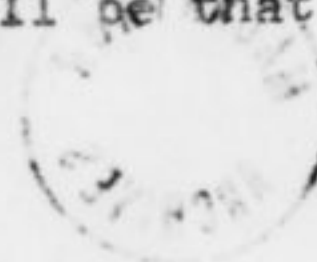

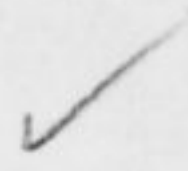

Check made with G-2 Section revealed that G-2 Section had retired their copy of the message to their Historical Branch as a restricted document.
