"As you may recall, we have had several conferences with Mr John Williams, Mister Noel Hemmendinger and others of the State Dept regarding Korean claims for vessels which are now in Japan. The conferences have not brought any concrete results, but the ultimate solution is still pending, as these gentlemen will testify. Nevertheless, I have been considerably distrubed by reports from Mister Kim Yong Joo, President of the Korea Steamship Company, who participated in the Wash Conferences, and who is presently in Tokyo. Mr Kim has informed me that the SCAP authorities in Tokyo have told him that I, as Ambassador of Korea, have indicated to US State Dept officials that Korea may forego its claims for vessels which were in Korean waters on or after Aug 9, 1945. Mister Kim adds that this information, according to SCAP officials, has been recd by them from the State Dept."

"This view of my position, as indicated to Mr Kim by SCAP officials, is completely inaccurate. On the contrary, in all these conferences, I have persistently maintained the Korean claim for the return of vessels which were in Korean waters on or after Aug 9, 1945, as the State Dept officials who partici-

New York Herald Tribune Editorial 3 Dec: The decision of the JCS that Formosa is not of vital strategic importance to the United States should end serious debate over any American military commitment on the island. There are reports that Gen MacArthur and some other military leaders doubt the wisdom of the decision, the Joint Chiefs, who are deeply concerned with the dangers caused by the spread of Communism in Asia, are the best judges of the risk involved and of the possible results. It seems reasonable to accept their opinion that a costly adventure in Formosa, which might result in direct involvment in China's Civil War, should be avoided. Whatever strength might have been used on Formosa can well be assigned to bases on Okinawa and in the Philippines. . . .

Washington Post Editorial 3 Dec: Just back from a 6 week tour of the Far East, Senator Alexander Smith has turned up with the rather pat proposal that United States military forces occupy the island of Formosa. . . . Unfortunately the Senator has ignored all the realities of the situation itself and all the implications of so reckless an undertaking. . . . American occupation of Formosa would be precisely the kind of expansionism which of the part of the Soviet Union, has been so menacing to peace. It would run directly counter at once to the international obligations and the real interests of the United States in maintaining a peaceful world.
