Gen Douglas MacArthur was asked about effectiveness of the Red indoctrinated Japanese prisoners by the Russians. The Gen, in explaining how it was possible to indoctrinate the fervent Japanese, said that when men are in captivity strange things happen to them; that not 1 in 10 emerges normal. When these prisoners first returned they refused to see their families and

were spartan like in their disdain. But when MacArthur ordered that they be led straight home, the warmth of the homecoming pierced the veneer of Party dictated aloofness. The case histories of 4,000 indoctrinated prisoners were recorded and checked and of these 4,000 only 42 were still Red Party members.

Following released to press Friday 14 Oct, 7 PM by Defense Dept: Acting Sec of the Army Tracy S Voorhees today issued the following statement: "Because of hearings before Congress vitally affecting unification of the Armed Services, I have requested the Army Chief of Staff Gen J Lawton Collins, now in Japan, to return immediately." Announcement concerning Gen Collins expected arrival time in Washington will be made to the press here and in Tokyo as soon as it is determined. Gen Collins left Washington by PSVT 7 for a scheduled 3 week inspection trip of Army installations in the Pacific and Far East, ACF to confer with Army Field Commanders.

New York Times Correspondent Lindsay Parrott, Tokyo 11 Oct: The United States Occupation Forces in Japan constitute a "stabilizing force for the entire Far East and we intend to keep them here as long as it is necessary to do so" Gen Lawton Collins, Chief of Staff of the Army asserted today.... Gen Collins told correspondents that despite the Communist victories in China and Russian possession of the Atomic Bomb, "We contemplate no changes in the level of our garrison out here."... While the Chief of Staff ducked a question regarding the possibility of maintaining permanent bases in Japan, he added that "Certainly for the present we believe it is necessary to maintain troops here" with the garrison level unchanged. . . . "I think we will hold on to Okinawa, the General said. Certainly we are not going to pull troops out now." Gen Collins remarks aroused considerable interest since the Air Force had been the heaviest sufferer from the Okinawa weather and it was known that a certain section of Air Force opinion favored holding Okinawa permanently as the main base off the Asiatic Coast. . . . The General declared he intended to survey surplus Army materials in the Pacific with reference to their availability under the North Atlantic Military Aid Program. Since it is the policy to move such material only short distances it possible that some of this may be supplied to Korea should Korea be included in the program, he added. The only stockpiling of military material in Japan the Chief of Staff said, is in amounts necessary for current occupation purposes.

While the State Dept plans to lower tariffs, a New England manufacturer is getting ready to put the blast on Gen Douglas MacArthur for encouraging Japanese production of cheap, competitive goods for the American market. Reilly will demand a Congressional investigation of MacArthur on the ground that he is using United States taxpayers money to build up Jap industries at the expense of American business and labor.

Japan is of tremendous importance to the United States and the story of what is happening there should be told as well as possible. . . .

They could tell it still better if the Public Relations Program of the occupation were as fine as some of its programs in other fields.

Lt Col Allison ind this hqs states 'for 1 week following the outbreak of war, I was associated in the Public Relations Div of Hqs USAFFE with the then Maj and later Col Diller as my immediate Chief. During that time I had some contact with the matter included in the allegations set forth in the reference radio. To the best of my knowledge and memory but without reference to a single written note, since my existing records contain no such references, rigid controls were placed on all commercial broadcasting stations by PIO, Hq USAFFE at the outbreak of war. Regular programs were permitted subj to revisions without notice. Most equipment earmarked for destruction, while other equipment was designated for requisition for setup on Corregidor and Bataan. Prior to the retreat commercial stations often were utilized for jamming short-waves from enemy stations or for propaganda.

"Upon retreat extensive demolitions of equipment (civil as well as military) was entered upon by order of USAFFE. Included, to my knowledge, was some broadcasting equipment. I knew that the Manila studio of KZRM and the transmitter at Polo, Bulacan

were ransacked for useful equipment, but that 1 small transmitter was left operating in order to permit announcers to broadcast coded phrases to the forces on Bataan indicating the extent of enemy penetration. I cannot be certain but I firmly believe some of the equipment I saw both on Corregidor and Bataan to have come from KZRM. On one occasion I was told by a member of Public Relations that KZRM equipment was utilized on Corregidor for 'voice of freedom' broadcasts. I cannot state from my knowledge that this was true.

"It is my opinion that the allegations essentially are true. I do not believe that the corporation lost all of its equipment in consequence of USAFFE action, but I believe that major damage resulted therefrom".

1. Pending revision of WD Cir 124, 1946 "Utilization of Negro Manpower in the Post War Army Policy" the following additional policies on this subject are hereby announced for information and guidance of all concerned.

a. Military occupational specialities (MOS) will be open to qualified pers without regard to race or color.

b. The present negro quotas for selection to attend Army schools will be abolished and selection will be made from the best qualified pers without regard to race or color.

c. The promotion system of the enlisted career guidance program will be administered on an equal merit basis so that all promotions will be obtained by open competition non Army wide exams against a single standard without regard to race or color.

d. ROTC students attending summer training camps as members of school units to which they are regularly assigned will remain together and be trained together without regard to race or color.

e. A board of senior Army officers will be convened from time to time to determine current progress under the program presented in Par a to d above and to reexamine and review the fundamental policies of the utilization of negro manpower in the light of changing conditions and experiences of this day and time.

2. The following implementing directives are issued at this time. Further nec implementing directives will be issued as may appropriate. 21 major commanders will pass to subordinate training division commanders the instructions set forth in Par 3 below. "Sec Defense Louis Johnson today approved a program proposed by Dept Army to give greater assurance of equality of treatment and opportunity to all Army personnel without regard to race or color.

"In submitting the new program to the Sec Defense, Sec Army Gordon Gray pointed out that he had discussed with Mr Charles Fahy, Chairman Presidents Committees suggestions and the Army's proposed program.

"Sec Gray said that in order to insure a progressively more efficient utilization of manpower, including utilization of negroes in each of the Armys career field, the Army is taking these specific steps:

1. Mil occupational specialities (MOS) will be open to qualified personnel without regard to race or color.
2. The present negro quotas for selection to attend Army schools will be abolished and selection will be made from the best qualified personnel without regard to race or color.
3. The promotion system of the enlisted career guidance program will be administered on an equal merit basis so that all promotions will be obtained without regard to race or color.
4. ROTC students attending summer training camps as members

of school units to which they are regularly assigned will be trained with those units without regard to race or color.

5. A bd of senior Army officers will be convened from time to time to determine current progress under the program and to re examine and review the fundamental policies for the utilization of negro manpower in the light of changing conditions and experiences. The 1st board will be convened in the near future. "This program," Mr Gray said, "does not mean that existing negro units will be broken up or that negro personnel of these units will be scattered throughout the Army. It does mean that qualified negroes including members of existing units will have the opportunity to learn those skills previously unavailable to them. Hereafter, negroes who acquire skills will be assigned to positions where their specialties may be applied in the manner most useful to the Army."

Under a new reenlistment policy, the Army has limited reenlistments to those who, during the 1st regular enlistment, qualify for promotion to Pfc if unmarried, and to Cpl, if married. Since promotions to these grades may be made without regard to vacancies, all Army members are eligible to win these promotions. Mr Gray said this policy is expected to produce greater economy and efficiency by gradually eliminating from Army service those who fail to demonstrate the capacity to advance. It's progressive application will also assure continuing opportunities to highly qualified individuals, both negroes and others, to enlist in the Army.

Under the Army's new program mil occupational specialties will be open to all qualified personnel. No individual who qualifies for a mil occupational specialty will be denied the opportunity to follow it because of race or color. This will give greater significance and provide further implementation to the Army's policy and practice of using qualified persons without regard to race in filling the operating or so called overhead positions at Army installations.

Formerly, negroes were excluded from acquiring certain mil occupational specialties. Also, they were selected to attend schools on the basis of negro distribution in the Army. They competed for promotion only among themselves. Now all non-commissioned officers will compete for promotion on an Army wide equal merit basis, against a single standard, without regard to race or color.

Under the old policy, negro ROTC students attending summer camps were placed in negro units for their training. Now all personnel regularly assigned to an ROTC unit will remain together and

Mr Gray declared that the Army was continuing its study of the present policy of regulating negro original enlistments in the Army, which is now based on the population ratio of negroes to the total population currently about 10%.

He pointed out that present policies concerning the utilization of negro manpower in the Army are based on the recommendations of a bd, headed by Lt Gen A C Gillem, which made its report in 1946 and which itself recommended a periodic review of Army policies.

"Changing conditions and attitudes require and permit constant re examining and testing of our policies and our practices," Mr Gray said. "The new bd, which I intend to appoint promptly, will help us in the performance of this duty." Implementing instructions for these policies will be issued in the "near future.

Following released to the press this date by Office of Public Information, Dept of Defense: "The Dept of the Army has directed all commands and services to initiate a special safe driving program for military personnel who operate privately owned civilian vehicles. The Army pointed out that military drivers operating Army vehicles have a safety record comparable with the best in the nation. The Army motor vehicle accident rate of 2 accidents per 100,000 miles is lower than the national average of 2.6 accidents for the same distance of travel, and is a reduction of 13% over the 47 rate.

"Army commanders, recognizing the safety record their military drivers have made, will ascertain that soldiers who drive civilian automobiles, both on and off posts, have knowledge of driving laws and rules of the road. Civilian vehicles owned by soldiers will be either state registered and inspected or registered and inspected by post officials. All major Army posts have now modern driver testing equipment, and no soldier is permitted to drive an Army vehicle without passing a test equal to or more rigid than the most difficult state examination.

"The Army has directed its commanders, world wide, to use all facilities to insure that soldiers ride only in safe civilian vehicles which have passed recent mechanical inspections, and are operated only by persons capable of driving safely. E V Parker, Director of Army Safety, said, 'The program of safe driving education, safe driving testing and inspection of vehicles will be a continuing Army program to reduce automobile accidents-the peacetime enemy of the soldier and the civilian.'"
