For AMM-1, Refmsg WCL 30703, General Council of Cooperating Baptist Missions of North America, Inc., not represented in Japan. Present missionary policy provides that Mission Board not represented in Japan may designate as representative one individual who will be recognized by SCAP as representative missionary of requesting organization. Functions of such representative are to find housing and provide other assurances upon which clearance for additional missionaries of his organization may be based. Inlet to red is authority for clearance on one individual listed in reference radio as representative missionary if so desired by General Council of Cooperating Baptist Missions in North America, Inc. Individual will be provided logistic support on reverse basis by U.S. Army for period of not more than sixty days, during which time he must become self-sustaining. Dependents of representative or operating missionaries may be cleared for entrance into Japan when adequate shelter and under regulations by Occupation Forces is secured by missionaries.



The last member of our Mission is expected to arrive 20 June. On 20 June we start a ten day trip through Southern Japan. After our return we shall begin to formulate tentative conclusions. We do not expect to reach any final decisions on any points before the middle or end of July. Decision on any one point usually depends on possible decisions on several other points within the system. Our work has been greatly facilitated by splendid cooperation of SCAP authorities and Japanese officials. One of chief problems is degree to which tax enforcement and taxpayer cooperation can be obtained through revision of taxes. Expect to have much clearer idea on this within next few weeks.

2. Ref 1a states that a 3 weeks' course in factory construction, operation, installation, and maintenance of SG type An/SPN-5 radar will be established in NY and requests advice as to CINCFE interest and number of personnel desired to send to this course.

3. Ref 1b lists reasons for desiring to send personnel to NY to participate in radar training, recommends that one qualified representative either military or civilian, from the Trans. Sect., GHO; 8th Army; RYCOM; and MARBO be authorized to attend this course and that a draft radio to the DA attached thereto be approved for dispatch. Both the C/N and the draft were concurred in by G-1 and G-3 and approved by the C/S.

Employees affected are those recruited in PHILCOM for duty RYCOM. Regulations are not sufficiently explicit to cover this type of case. Inst rad to DA transmits GHQ opinion that post differential not necessary as recruitment incentive (as outlined in EC 10,000) to American citizens referred to, since they have been living and working as Filipinos and are accustomed to Filipino conditions and standard of living. Base pay considered adequate to recruit. Further, differentials paid in PHILCOM and RYCOM are generally comparable and indicative of similarity in living and working conditions so that US citizens living as Filipinos cannot be said to be undergoing undue hardship or subject to extremely difficult living conditions. Rad requests decision of DA in this matter.

Subject is Department of Army Special Regulations 210-150-50, 21 December 1948, Sale of Commissary Supplies Overseas to Government Employees and Other Individuals.

1. SR 210-150-50 imposes 10% additional commissary charges on the individual members of government departments and agencies who are not otherwise repeat not otherwise listed in para 4, AR 30-2290, 18 April 1946.

2. Certain categories here are in effect an integral part of FTC and SCAP headquarters and are working with the Army in a work status identical with DAC personnel and military personnel and solely in support of Army mission. These individuals are:

a. State Department personnel. They are an integral part of SCAP headquarters functioning as the Diplomatic Section of GHQ, subject to its rules and regulations, with responsibilities through the normal chain of command to the C/S and SCAP and devoting time and effort to work directly connected with or for GHQ SCAP.

b. Petroleum Advisory Group. Personnel are regularly assigned to full time duty as employees with the G-4 General Staff Section, working solely for the Occupation in all petroleum matters. Services of personnel are donated by parent commercial companies concerned.

c. Teachers at technical schools. This category of personnel is on a similar status with employees of Petroleum Advisory Group, in that the services of the teaching personnel are donated by the parent companies concerned, and are engaged solely in teaching personnel of Army units attending Army technical schools in the FEC.

d. Japan Oil Storage Company. Under the terms of DA contract W 216-004-QM-2, contractor's personnel are afforded without discrimination all privileges subject to all restrictions established by law and policy governing U.S. civilian personnel in Japan on an invitational basis. Contractor's personnel are assigned housing from among housing made available for such purpose to military and DAC personnel of equivalent status and seniority reimbursing the government for this housing on the same basis as do DAC personnel of equivalent status and seniority.

e. International Dairy Supply Company. DA contract for recombined milk in the FEC, makes provisions for logistic support of milk company personnel required to manage and operate milk plants, on the same basis as Department of the Army civilian employees. Currently the entire output of the milk company is tendered to the armed forces and/or their agencies or instrumentalities. Recombined milk is part of the daily ration issued to troops, is available for purchase in the QM Sales Commissaries by authorized Commissary card holders, and is sold in PXs, clubs, and snack bars.

f. International Business Machines Corporation. The representative of this company is attached to Adjutant General's Section of this headquarters and under terms of present DA contract works solely for the Occupation Forces servicing IBM machines in use by Occupation Forces.

g. Army Airways Communications Service technical advisors on loan from commercial firms. Personnel are engaged solely in work for the Occupation Forces and are in the same category as personnel of paragraphs b and c above in that such personnel are on loan from the commercial companies and are paid by the parent companies.

3. It is not feasible for the categories referenced above to purchase subsistence supplies in bulk nor are there any other government sources of supply for obtaining subsistence other than the Army Sales Commissaries. Considering that the full effort of this personnel is devoted to the interests and objectives of the

Part 1. It is desired to establish additional letters of credit for approximately \$7,000,000 covering purchase of 40,400 bales of cotton. This purchase will be within the approved limits of \$30,000,000 and 165,000 bales.

Part 2. Request authority amend letter of credit applications as follows which includes certain changes already approved by you:

a. Purchases to be for account of Ministry of International Trade and Industry instead of Boeki Cho (Japanese Board of Trade.) Ministry indicated are legal successors to Boeki Cho.

b. Number of bales required to be for 10% more or less and specifying grade Good Ordinary to Strict Middling, inclusive, staple 3/4 inches to 1-1/8 inches, inclusive, and all shades of gray or spotted or white or extra white, inclusive.

c. Insurance to permit Institute Clauses of London or American underwriters also instead of reading damage due to salt water fresh and/or rain water to read merely damage due to fresh water and/or salt water as rain water covered by fresh water clause.

Part 3. Order directing Ministry of International trade and Industry to take over functions and assume all obligations of Boeki Cho on behalf of the Japanese Government is being forwarded to you by mail with copy of Japanese Government ordinance establishing that agency. Inasmuch as Boeki Cho signed blanket \$30,000,000 note on behalf of the Japanese Government, it is not believed legally necessary for a substitute \$30,000,000 note to be executed by the Ministry of International Trade and Industry. However, if you so desire that can be done, Substitute notes, which will be furnished in accordance with NFRF procedures, will be executed by MITI on behalf of the Japanese Government.

"Part 1. 40 PS shipped to ZI on Par 4, SO 93, Hq Processing and Tng Cen, 8149th SU, dated 5 May 49 were all US citizens. Error in order in using CINCFC rad ZX 43976 as auth for disch. Auth for ret to ZI should have been DA Cir 47, dated 17 Nov 47, Sec 1, Par 3, instead of DA Cir 147, 47.

"Part 2. This hq intrps 3d fr last sentence Part 1 urmsg that DA has authd Cp Stoneman to enl these PS in RA by waiving mental rqmts. It is believed here that auth should not be granted to enl these EM in RA since no exceptions to mental rqmts have been made in this cmd. Considerable repercussions would result if mental rqmts were waived for onlmt of these pers in RA. Pers with over 19 yrs sv were dischd fr PS in this comd and refused onlmt in RA due to not meeting mental rqmts. The waiving of mental rqmts on any gp would result in gross discrimination on other pers where mental rqmts were not waived. Believed here that if mental rqmts are waived on any PS pers for onlmt in RA that they must be waived for all such pers."

CINCFC strongly supports foregoing views of CG PHILCOM and urges that auth granted Cp Stoneman to enl the 40 PS in RA in gr, who do not meet minimum mental quals, be revoked; and, in those cases where onlmt has already been accomplished, that immediate sep be directed for conv of govt.

M/R: 1. DA rad WCL 47024 dtd 8 Jun 49 pointed out that 40 PS arrived Cp Stoneman 26 May with orders for im sep fr sv UP AR 615-365 and CINCFE rad ZX 43976 dtd 20 Mar 49. EM not elig for enl in RA because of failure to meet min mental rqmts. DA granted CO, Cp Stoneman auth to enl these 40 PS EM in RA despite low GCT scores. DA stated belief that EM were erroneously shipped to ZI.

2. CINCFE rad Z 13141 dtd 10 Jun quoted DA rad and rqstd if the 40 EM were US or non-US citizens and pointed out that CINCFE rad ZX 43976 pertained to non-US citizens.

3. PHILCOM rad G 10421 GSA dtd 14 Jun 49 states all 40 were US citizens and admits error in using CINCFE rad ZX 43976 as auth for disch. Rad further corrects auth cited for ret of EM to ZI to DA Cir 47 dtd 17 Nov 47 instead of DA Cir 147, 1947.

4. Inst rad to DA quotes PHILCOM rad and is self-explanatory. AG concurs in part only, recmg that folg be added to inst rad "In the event foregoing is impracticable, rqst auth to grant waivers of mental rqmts for all PS pers who are US citizens and who desire onl in RA."

G-1 considers this recommendation inadvisable.

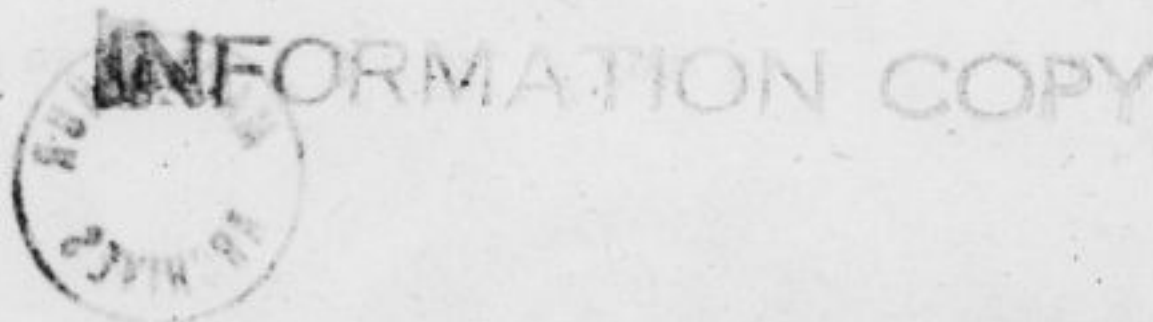
