It is the opinion of this command that requirements for recreational facilities on Okinawa can not logically be compared with ZI requirements since commercial facilities to relieve the condition do not exist on the island. In view of the extremely limited military facilities available, the military population, and the direct effect recreational activities have on the general welfare, morale and resulting efficiency of personnel, a special effort is necessary to provide minimum facilities. The construction program as submitted is considered the absolute minimum welfare requirement. Present status of the FEC Central Welfare Fund precludes financing the cost of construction from this fund. Presently, exchange profits are being utilized to liquidate loan obligations with the Army and AF Exchange Service. In view of the above circumstances, request reconsideration with a view that either non-appropriated funds in the amount of \$1,430,600 be made available to the FEC Central Welfare Fund, or that the Bureau of the Budget provide for the immediate release of appropriated funds to accomplish the construction of the facilities so urgently needed.

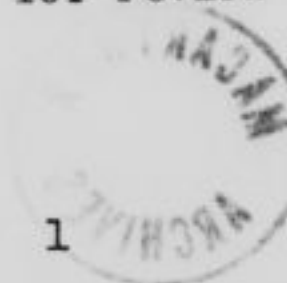
