1. JLCOM has established distinctive markings for Korean civilian relief supplies effective 1 Mar 51. The adoption of the markings has been coordinated with G-4, HQ, KTAG, and has been promulgated to pertinent JLCOM activities by CG JLCOM, rad BK 80822, 20 Feb 51.
2. CINCCE ISG Z 43363, 12 Mar 51, to DA, advised that JLCOM has adopted the following markings for civilian relief supplies shipped from Japan to Korea effective 1 Mar 51. Markings are: Two diagonally opposite corners of each container painted black with four orange dots one inch in diameter on each black surface corner. CINCCE ISG also suggested that, in the interest of uniformity and rapid identification, all SF and SKO cargo be marked in accordance with the procedure adopted by JLCOM.
3. Rad, DA, DA 25645 dated 16 Mar 51, to CINCCE, states that CINCCE's suggestion cannot be adopted for the following reasons:
  - a. TM 38-474, May 45, Sec XVII, para 87 B, prohibits use of black for corner markings except for Navy in joint operations.

- b. Policy, as shown by TM 38-414, seeks to limit use of color corner markings to identifying shipments of particular Technical Services.
- c. It is considered that great difficulty would be encountered in assuring proper compliance in SUN programs, particularly shipments by foreign donors.
4. Radio, CINCPAC, ZK 45616, 24 Mar 51, informed DA that due to the illiteracy of native labor, shipments of civilian relief supplies should be marked so that each package is readily distinguishable at any angle.
5. Radio, DA 32022, 5 Apr 51, informed CINCPAC of a proposed marking plan for shipments under the civil aid programs for Korea. The radio was passed to JLCOM for information and consideration of the feasibility of the proposed marking plan. Additional time is required to complete this study.
6. This message is an interim reply.
7. Action suspended on Trans Jo #5491 and Trans Jo #4610 (Rad, DA 32022, 5 Apr 51, and DA 25645, 16 Mar 51) pending further study by Trans Sec, GPO, and JLCOM. Suspense date 27 Apr 51.

Reference DEPTAR radio 40884. This message constitutes final report of CINCPAC on suppression of blackmarket activities in Korea. This message in three parts.

Part I. Rigid preventive measures to minimize losses from Army supply channel units and individuals continue to be aggressively enforced. Program includes establishment in each CID of special teams of agents with primary mission of surveillance of US Govt property diversions and recovery of same.

Part II. Cooperation of ROK has finally been obtained and ROK Presidential Order promulgated which makes possession or disposal of UN military supplies or equipment by unauthorized persons an offense. Implementing this directive coordinated raids by ROK National Police assisted by US Army MP and CID began 17 Mar in all principal blackmarket areas in Korea with good results to date. ROK authorities ordered confiscation certain specified items and confiscated military goods are being returned to proper Army supply agencies. This coordinated enforcement program will be a continuing measure to minimize blackmarket activities in Korea.

Part III. Medicinal whiskey and narcotics continue to be rigidly controlled and neither has been found on Korean market.
