Description of property or services: Eighteen (18) trucks or bussed of different make and model together with equipments therefor, used in the conveyance and carriage of passengers and of goods, wares and merchandise along the routes applied for and authorized by the Public Service Commission, and which is more particularly described in the affidavit marked as Appendix " " .

3. The property was taken by, or the service was rendered to, United States forces under the following circumstances: The property (all the trucks) were commandeered by the United States Army Forces in the Far East between 8 December and 28 December 1941. The persons who commandeered the trucks said that they needed the trucks. Some of them were commandeered in different places in Manila while the others were commandeered in the garage of the Corporation.

4. The value of the property when taken, or services rendered, was ₱ 56,700.00 which was not agreed to. A receipt signed by _____ dated _____, was issued.

5. The total of all money or compensation of any type received by me to date either as rental or as a partial or total settlement for the above, amounts to ₱ none.

6. All liens or mortgages outstanding against the above property when taken over as above were held by nobody.

7. After the above property was taken, it was used or disposed of as follows: The trucks were used by the United States Army. They were used in transporting Army personnel and/or war materials to and from different places in Luzon. All the trucks were never returned and up to the present time has not been recovered by the Corporation.

8. No claim for the property taken or services rendered has been filed with any other government agency.

9. I swear that the above statements are true to the best of my knowledge and belief, that I am the owner of the above described property, subject to the liens above stated, and am legally entitled to receive payment therefor, that the claim is just valid, and that IN CONSIDERATION of payment of ₱ 56,700.00, the United States of America, its officers and agents, are HEREBY UNCONDITIONALLY RELEASED from all further liability arising out of the above claim.
