In view of the scarcity of rice in this locality to support our men in the field, I have the honor to request authority to contract and requests from the District Presidents and Leaders, Arifao, Nva. Viz., to give field supports in the form of rice to be covered by field receipts, duplicated to be forwarded to that Headquarters for examination and verification. That collections shall be deposited and disposed at the discretion of that higher headquarters.

That my EXTRACT, per my application submitted to that headquarters thru your 1120 be favorably considered to give me full authority to sign receipts for the UFIIP.

That should this be favorably considered, a copy of my authority and extract be furnished to the Officers and men covering that sector to avoid annoyance during my campaign in that sector for relief.
