

A few days ago, Lt. Urias S. Horst of the Claim Service, AFWESPAC, Iloilo, summoned us, the former civilian employees of the office of the Port QM, USAFFE, Iloilo, to his office and told us that he will entertain our claims for unpaid salaries and wages provided we furnish him with a list of employees, giving all necessary information and signed by our foreman, or time-keeper or the man in-charge of our former office.

We told him that there already was such a list in the hands of your office. Last November, 1945, when the RPD Section Processing Team for civilian employees of the USAFFE came to Iloilo, Capt. Vick, who was then the head of the team showed me a list of civilian employees of the Port QM, Iloilo City, then employed up to the landing of the Japanese forces in Panay in 1942. This list was signed by Mr. Monty C. Wain and Major Prudencio Palafox. It was a sort of a payroll form and information sheet regarding the above employees and was prepared by Mr. Wain himself and counter-signed by Maj. Palafox who was, in 1941, our paymaster. Mr. Wain said at the time that he was going to furnish your office several signed copies of this list. ✓

Lt. Horst appointed me to represent the above employees and I am therefore, requesting your office to kindly help us in locating the list above-mentioned and sending it either to me or to Lt. Horst direct. Needless it is to say that we need your help very badly and whatever aid you may give us in this regard will be gratefully appreciated.



That I first became connected with Port Quartermaster on 8th December 1941, as a Peso a year man, to help Col. McLlenan, 26th Cavalry, organize same. That by 1st February 1942, Port Quartermaster was completely organized, and all regular employees including myself were placed on a regular payroll. However, several employees were already on a steady employment basis.

That a list of the regular employees, fifty (52) two in number had previously been submitted, and these were the only regular employees of Port Quartermaster of Iloilo.


That labourers were obtained by contacting the Personnel Section, who in turn, hired labourers by the day. Employment of labourers was a simple matter, since most civilian places were closed and crowds of civilian labourers assembled at our offices, waiting for a job. These labourers were hired on a daily basis, placed on a separate payroll, and paid daily, by Captain Prudencio Palafox, Finance Officer, Port Quartermaster.

That 15th April 1942, was the last day that Port Quartermaster functioned; ceasing on that day because of the Japanese landing in Iloilo.
