

TO : The Chief of Staff, 5th Inf. Regiment

1. In behalf of the wife of Lt. JUAN NICERIO, Battalion S-5, 1st Battalion, 5th Inf. Regiment, who was arrested by the Japs Military Police in San Pablo while in a certain mission last week ordered by Major Bluebird, authority is hereby requested to give little support for the family (wife and 5 children) who were in Gabo, near Ramon Calizas' place. The said family of Lt. Nicerio has no any means of livelihood or support from any other persons, except Major Bluebird who has also 17 families who burdened him.
2. It is to be noted that Lt. Juan Nicerio is now in the Japanese Garrison and we cannot tell whether he is still living or not. This is not known by his wife and children. What they understand is that Lt. Nicerio is with General Wincenty in Manila.



AFFIDAVIT

I, JUAN NATIVIDAD, of legal age, married, Filipino, farmer, residing and with postal address at Bay, Laguna, after being duly sworn to on oath in accordance with law, deposes and say;

That, I was the Chief Supply Officer of the 27th Infantry Regiment, 25th Red Lion's Division, President Quezon's Own Guerrillas, with commissioned rank of Major; recognized and processed as 1st Lieutenant;

That, I hereby certify that the 27th Infantry Regiment, 25th Red Lion's Division, POG, thru Lieutenant Colonel Pastor B. Timog, Regimental Commander, myself and my officers and men had commandeered various kinds of commodities from a well-to-do widow of Bay, Laguna, MARIA PELAEZ. All those supplies which were commandeered from her were duly received by our organization, as an acknowledgment of our indebtedness to her. We give assurance of payment for all those supplies commandeered after the liberation of the Philippines by the United States Army;

That, I hereby further certify that the commandeered supplies from Mrs. Maria Palaez were used and consumed by the officers and men of the 25th Red Lion's Infantry Division, POG, and by the officers and men of the 27th Infantry Regiment, POG. None of the commandeered supplies from Mrs. Maria Palaez were returned to the said owner and likewise none of those supplies were used by our officers and men outside of their official duties.

That, up to the present our organization, the Philippine Army and the United States Army have not made any payment to Mrs. Maria Palaez as promised to by us;

That, all the records of accounts of the regiment under my custody were all lost during the flood of August 10, 1947, which occurred in our municipality.

I, PASTOR B. TIMOG, of legal age, married, a Filipino, Public Defender of Laguna, residing and with postal address at Bay, Laguna, after having been duly sworn to in accordance with law, hereby depose and say:

That I hereby certify that I was the original organizer and overall Commander of the "BAY GUERRILLA FORCE" which later on became the 27th Infantry Regiment, 25th Red Lion's Infantry Division, PRESIDENT QUEZON'S OWN GUERRILLAS, after formal attachment on 1st December, 1943;

That the above-mentioned Regiment since its inception and until its demobilization on 10 August, 1945, had been financially independent from that of the PQOG. It had its own Chief Supply Officer and Supply Division under Major JUAN NATIVIDAD. This Chief Supply Officer was directly under my supervision and control;

That the PQOG, more particularly the different units of the 25th Red Lion's Infantry Division, under Lt. Col. PHIL. C. AVANCEÑA, usually requisitioned needed supplies from the 27th Infantry Regiment. That is true because the field of our operation was then the rice granary of production, more so the center of business during the Japanese occupation;

That evidence of the facts that my Regiment supplied the 25th Red Lion's Infantry Division could be verified from the records of the Division concerned which was submitted to the Office of the Claims Service of the United States Army by Captain Bienvenido del Mar sometime last August, 1948;

TO: Lt. Col. FOUR ROSES
Subject: Special Order, Assignment, etc.

1- You are hereby ordered to create a Regiment in the Municipality of Sariaya. This will be a differnt and independent Unit from that which is under the command of Lt. Col. Panzer. Lt. Col. Panzer shall remain the Regimental Commander of the Regiment in Candelaria, and Major Manalo will be Chief of Staff of the Sariaya Regiment. The Regimental Commander of the Sariaya Regiment will be made known in due time, by this HQ.

2- From this date, you are assign as Chief of Staff of the Fifth Inf. Division, with power and authority to issue and promulgate necessary measures, orders and instructions for the smooth running of the said Division.

3- Instruct all Regimental and Battalion Commanders within the 5th Inf. Division to make an accounting of all supplies which they collected and might collect in the near future.

Also, require all Sub-sector Commanders to make a daily record of their activities. This will be necessary when the Landing Forces arrive here, and will constitute part of the records of the Division to be presented and submitted to the proper Officers of the Landing Forces.

4- Organize a smooth running communication line between your HQ and this HQ. Keep always in touch with this HQ by a regular runner or courier.

- 2- The way I see it, this Felix Cortes is up to no good; so for the time being he should be considered an enemy and treated accordingly.
- 3- We want no contact with the Fil-American guerrillas.
- 4- Keep your trigger men on the look-out for a possible chance to give Libuna his just desserts.
- ✓ 5- Just go ahead collecting the necessary wiring and hold same in readiness for definite plans.
- 6- Received the clothes you sent.
- 7- You are doing pretty well with arms confiscation.
- 8- How do you like the idea of being sector commander of San Pablo City?
- 9- Lamb left for Anderson's place, October 9 via the mountains.
- 10- Keep a written record of Jap movements such as the placing of signal flags; the building of fox holes or other defensive measures. Same will be very useful in the future.
- 11- You can decide whatever you deem fit for Atienza's rice. Caballero gave him a pass as per his request for three cavans.

Dear Genl Ross:

1- Received actually \$ 204,000.00 It made us so happy that we celebrated with a real full meal, the first one in almost two weeks. That amount will last us until after New Year, we can also pay all our personal debts. But if you can send us again it will help the campaign considerably.

2- It is very hard to transport rice to this place because it might be confiscated on the way.

3- I feel pretty bad not being able to grant your request for one carbine but I really don't know how I can do so now. The carbines I have brought here have been given to Camp Q of the second corps except one Oceano & Sumas on each. Only chance you have now is if we succeed in getting back the carbine in the possession of the rebel band. I had ordered Oceano to give it to you in case we got it back. You should have made the request before I left.

Anyway here is the order or authorization to confiscate the arms of Nov 110.

4- This courier has been instructed to get as many farms from Camp Q as he can before he leaves for your place. You can get what you need from him. I think Mags who is there now has also plenty with him.

5- The Americans certainly will be here any day now. I ask of you to help me still on in spite of my incapacity; at least for the PQOG.

Merry Christmas, and may God Preserve You.

Informing that I have refer our case to the GHQ regarding your refusal to give us supplies and I was ordered by Brig. Gen. Avanessia to get our necessary supply from you and he is the one all responsible, together with the written order of Lt. Col. Flash quoted dated Jan. 21, 1945, quoted as follows, " (2) You have the order for getting supplies. Get it. If you've shown the order and the supply does not give, try other means to get from them. I'll answer for you!"

To avoid misunderstandings and to promote a good mutual understanding between us all guerillas, it is always advisable to for us to help each other. We are also a member of the 25th Div. and luckily you were assigned as Supply officer while we are doing the Intelligence work. We are to Supply the GHQ all the necessary information regarding Espionage work while you supply us with food. If we can't work because we are starving it will be your fault.

Due to the present conditions we cannot relay all orders thru all proper channels as our Officers are desperad. Self-conscience will tell you that if your comrades needs your help and "if you have the noble and sublime sentiments for the love of your country you will and no doubt" deny him.



Informing you, I have received a verbal order thru our courier from the Gen. to get supplies from you together with the written order of Lt. Col. Flash dated Jan. 21 to present the written Memorandum dated Jan. 9, ordering the G-4 to give us the necessary supplies and get our supplies. I have shown this Order to Lt. Fabix Alvarez and he refused to give supplies on account that you don't know it.

Please be informed that we don't have any food and cig. nor viands for days and our credit are amounting daily. I can't force my boys to work as I have nothing to give them which hinders our work very much. But our Deputy Commander-in-Chief Major Gen. Wentzity demands that our work be intensified as it is only the best way so far we can help our common allies to win this war.

How can we meet this demand when we lack funds, when we have nothing to eat? "A Soldier marches on his stomach". We are then asking for your kindly and timely help which we need very badly. We have plenty of operatives but so far we have under Major Silva, S-2, 27th Inf. Reg. six (6) operatives on active duty in his HQ, and under me I have seven (7) operatives on active duty helping me in compiling reports of all Intelligence reports of the 25th Div. (This include our couriers). You can now determine by yourself the necessary supply we need. We are 15 in all.

Please advise your other supply Officers regarding this matter 'cause if every time we are in badly need of supplies and they can't give for the reason that you don't know it it will be very hard for us. I pretty well know that you will not doubt as to the use of these supplies we are requesting you. If you have an available supply please give us. I am sending a letter to Lt. Col. Eagle regarding this matter.


