Philippine Army Personnel evacuated from the Philippines to Australia aboard the "S.S. MACTAN".

1. The "S.S. MACTAN" was a boat converted into a "Hospital Ship". It was also referred to as the "Geneva Hospital Ship MACTAN" and the "Red Cross Hospital ship S.S. MACTAN". The "S.S. MACTAN" was used to evacuate military patients from the Philippines to Australia during the period of December 1941 thru January 1942.

2. The "S.S. MACTAN" departed from MANILA, Philippines on or about 31 December 1941 and upon arrival in Australia, surviving patients were transferred from the ship to the 113th AUSTRALIAN General Hospital, Concord West, Sydney, Australia on 27 January 1942. Rosters or lists of the patients evacuated are on file in Archives of Records Section and are acceptable proof of USAFFE Service. The rosters or lists also contain names of personnel from the U.S. Army as well as the Commonwealth Philippine Army. It may also be pointed out that the majority of the personnel evacuated on the MACTAN have Medical records

(dated in 1941 and early 1942) which are in themselves proof of USAFRE status.

3. Instructions to Commanding General, Philippine Department from Headquarters, U.S. Army Forces in the Far East, Fort Mills, P.I., dated 2 MARCH 1942, provided that the Men listed on the aforementioned roster should be dropped from the organizational unit records and showed as transferred to U.S. Army Forces in Australia.

4. The Majority of the patients evacuated were from the Sternberg General Hospital, more specifically from an Annex located at the "Philippine Women's College" or the "SANTA SCHOLASTIC ANNEX".

5. The trend of service after arrival at Australia, for Philippine Army personnel, was hospitalization with subsequent enlistment in the Army of the United States.

6. In determining the period of service of the Philippine Army personnel evacuated on the "S.S. MACTAN" the following procedures will

be followed :

a. PRIOR to 8 Dec 41 - 'PRE WAR SERVICE'.

b. FROM 8 DEC 41 to date of death or 26 JAN 42, whichever is the earlier - 'Beleaguered Status'.

c. FROM 27 JAN 42 to enlistment or Commission in the Army of the United States - 'Regular PA Service'.

d. Discharge or Separation from the Regular PA will be determined to be one day prior to enlistment or Commission in the AUS, (Providing there is no documentary evidence to the contrary).

On 7 December 1941, I was a civilian working aboard the "SS Sacton" in the capacity of hostess. The vessel was in Manila Harbor. On 10 December 1941, the "SS Sacton" was transferred into a transport vessel. The boat was traveling from Manila to Saraville, transporting supplies. On 23 December 1941, the vessel was converted into a hospital ship. By 1 January 1942, the conversion was completed and we sailed to Cebu, Philippines. We arrived there on 5 January 1942. We remained here until 9 January 1942, taking on food supplies and fuel. The ship was loaded with about 241 wounded soldiers of which about 60 were Filipinos. The only two known to me were Lt Rafael Yobico, a PA officer, and Sgt Benialisco, a Philippine Scout. Mr William Irving, Red Cross, Padre Alaban and a Colonel Carroll or Garroll (not certain of correct spelling), were in charge of the wounded. On 9 January 1942, we sailed for Sydney, Australia, arriving there on 17 January 1942. The wounded were taken immediately to the General Hospital, Sydney. The ship was anchored at Neutral Bay, Sydney. On 10 May 1942, about 45 Filipinos of whom I was in charge went aboard the "SS Sacton", a Dutch vessel, during the time we were anchored in Neutral Bay. I remained aboard the ship performing the duties of hostess. We sailed between Sydney, Newcastle, Port Moresby and New York transporting supplies for the U.S. Army from 10 May 1942 until 14 August 1942. On 14 August 1942, I was ordered to report to Army Postal Service in Sydney. I reported on 15 August 1942, and was allocated into the Army Transport Service. I remained in training until 15 September 1942, and was assigned to the "SS Argosy Lancer", anchored in Brisbane. I remained aboard this vessel until 21 October 1942. On that date, I was sent back to Sydney, Australia, and remained there a week. During this week, I was again in training with the ATSA. I was then ordered to OHO in Brisbane, Australia. While here I received command training and also was doing clerical work in the office. On 25 December 1942, my name was changed by OHO to Salvador P. Masalong for security reasons. On 27 December 1942, I was transferred to the U.S. submarine "Cochon" with five other men, Major Ramon Hernandez was in charge, and had Lt "Bob" Ray, Lt Rafael Yobico, Lt Juan del Rosario, Sgt Vicente Reyes and the other centers. These names of the men were fictitious. On that date, I had been promoted to W/Sgt by an order issued at OHO. We then proceeded toward Negros Island. There was no particular orders ordering us to that island but the orders were to go to the Philippines. We arrived at Davao Point, southern Negros on 14 January 1943 at 2300 hours. We were intercepted here by the volunteer police which was an organization of civilians. We landed by means of a rubber boat and had about 1800 pounds of supplies sent of them being radio equipment. The following day, we contacted Captain Madaca, a guerrilla leader, and Major Hernandez, Madaca and I proceeded to Cartagina on our way to Canayan, Negros. It took three days to reach Canayan. Our purpose for going here was to contact Col Salvador Abcede, a guerrilla leader. We never contacted him but were informed that we could not remain there by Col Intigana, another guerrilla leader, because the town was often occupied by the Japanese. We did stay overnight and then went back to Cartagina, arriving there on 20 January 1943. Here, we established our radio station in the jungle nearby. It took us three days to build this radio station. I remained until 30 January 1943, procuring food for our party and acted as aide to Major Hernandez. Lt Col Rosario operated the radio station sending messages to OHO concerning Japanese activities. On 30 January 1943, Major Hernandez and I went to the barrio of Manoban. We arrived there on 1 February 1943 and remained here about two weeks locating a suitable place for our radio station and carrying on intelligence work. Here, Col Abcede contacted Major Hernandez and discussed Japanese activities in this vicinity. On about 15 February 1943, we proceeded to Cateban to confer with Col Audico. We arrived at Cateban on 18 February 1943. Being unable to contact Col Audico here, we left the next day and set up at Camp Point. Here a conference was held about the leadership of the Negros guerrilla forces. There was no decision reached during this conference. On 20 February 1943, we went to Anis, Negros, arriving there on 22 February 1943. We remained here until about 28 February 1943. During this period, I was procuring food supplies and the guerrilla leaders from each barrio held conferences to decide who was to be their leader. As yet they reached no decision. On 7 March 1943, we proceeded to Saay, Negros. We arrived there on 10 March 1943, with our spare radio and supplies. We remained here until about 17 March 1943 in hiding against the Japanese patrols. On 17 March 1943, we went back to Manoban, arriving there on 19 March 1943. Here we remained until about 19 April 1943. During this

time I was procuring supplies and helped coding and decoding messages concerning Japanese activities. On 19 April 1943, we moved our radio station to Daug from Cartagina. We also moved our camp from Manobean to Daug arriving there on 21 April 1943. We remained here for two weeks and returned to Manobean about 5 May 1943. We remained in Manobean for three weeks when we received orders from GHQ to return to Australia. During this period we were coding and decoding messages to and from GHQ. About 26 May 1943, we left for Banga, Panay to contact a submarine but did not reach there. We stopped at Cartagina because the Japanese were very active in this vicinity. We remained in hiding here. Major Hernandez received orders from GHQ to choose a leader for the guerrilla forces from the 7th Military District. Col Abades was selected and was confirmed by GHQ. On 2 June 1943, we went back to Manobean arriving on 4 June 1943. We established our Hqs of the 7th Military District. We remained until 25 July 1943. During this time we contacted a submarine and received guns and ammunition. On 25 July 1943, we became suspicious about the Japanese discovering us and proceeded to Mahanayhanay, the inner part of Manobean. I remained here until 28 July 1943, when I went to Golipapa to hide the supplies. I arranged the hiding place in the jungle during the two days I was there. I then went back to Mahanayhanay arriving on 31 July 1943. I remained there overnight and went to Masbato because the Japanese had made a new landing at Lagat. We took our radio and other parts with us. We remained here two days and were again forced to leave on 3 August 1943, because the Japanese had penetrated to this location. We traveled through the jungle to the inner part of Golipapa, arriving on 5 August 1943. Here, we established our Hqs and our radio. It was here that I contracted malaria. The Japanese had discovered the 40,000 rounds of ammunition hidden between Lagat and Masbato. We remained here until 10 November 1943. (On 15 August 1943, Major Edwin P. Andrews contacted us and took command because Major Hernandez had been ordered to return to Australia). On about 1 November 1943, we established the 7th PAAG at our Hqs. On 10 November 1943, we moved our Hqs about eight hours walking distance further into the jungles. We remained here until 5 June 1944. While in this location, we established our radio station, built houses and set up a governing agency among the natives. On 14 January 1944, I was promoted to 5/Sgt per Par 2, S.O. 4, USFIP Hqs, PAAG, 7th Military District. On 6 April 1944, I was promoted to 3d Lt per Par 4, S.O. 9, USFIP, Hqs, PAAG, 7th Military District. On 30 May 1944, I was ordered to go to Asia to find out the Japanese activities. On my way I met the Japanese at Pleinon. I was machine gunned and managed to escape. I returned to camp and warned Major Andrews that the Japanese were coming from the south. On 1 June 1944, a band of 300 Japanese approached near our vicinity and we engaged them in combat. Our party of 14 men killed 16 Japanese during this encounter. On 2 June 1944, we went to our advanced position which we had established previously. On 3 June 1944, almost 700 Japanese approached and we retreated back toward our inner camp at Manobean. We had evacuated our radio station and supplies in May 1944. It was on 3 June 1944, that I saved Col Edwin P. Andrews from being captured by the Japanese. I took him further into the jungles and remained with him until 5 June 1944. Our enlisted men had been instructed to destroy the houses and buildings if the Japanese approached the camp. On 5 June 1944, our camp was destroyed by our men as the Japanese had entered this vicinity. On 7 June 1944, we moved some ten miles further away to Cantaray. Here, we established our camp and radio station. We remained here until 30 August 1944 building up our own area. We were also coding and decoding messages and observing Japanese activities. On that date, we moved our camp to Daug. It took two weeks to move our supplies. I remained at Daug until 21 January 1945. I engaged in the same activities of procuring supplies and acting as aide to Col Andrews. On 27 November 1944, I was ordered by secret orders from GHQ to proceed to Panay to get the Governor of Panay, Tomasico Confesor, and bring him back to our camp at Daug. My journey took 23 days to reach Panay. I remained there one week while the Governor completed his affairs and then we returned to Daug. The journey back took 3 days and we arrived on 2 January 1945. On 24 January 1945, I was ordered to return to the Panay area of GHQ, SWPA. I departed immediately. It took four days to reach destination. I remained there until 5 February 1945, when I departed for Malabon, Leyte, arriving there the same day. I reported to the PAAG and was then assigned to the 1st Repl Bn, 4th Repl Depot, and reported on 7 February 1945.


