

Dear Major Becker:

My certificate reference the Luzon enclosed. I don't know if the information furnished is satisfactory, but as you probably realize all my records were lost, and my memory after four years is not any too reliable.

I would suggest that you contact Captain C.J. Martin of the Cebu Stevedoring Company he can give all the information about ships used by the USA in Cebu. He acted as Port Captain during the first phase of the Philippine Campaign. Captain Martin is thoroughly reliable and his word is as good as gold.

At times when we did not have the funds to pay crews and provision the ships both the Cebu Stevedoring Company and the Steamship companies advanced the necessary cash in order to carry on.

I had planned while in Manila to contact the claims section and give what information I could, but the doctors picked me up as a cancer suspect and had me flown home immediately. Fortunately for me they were wrong.

If there is any other information I can give, please do not hesitate to call.

C E R T I F I C A T E

I certify that the SS "LUZON" the property of the Compania Maritima, was requisitioned for use of the United States Army, as of December 18, 1941. The necessity for the use of this ship was determined by the Commanding General, Visayan-Mindanao Forces. (Major General W.F.Sharpe, USA)

I further certify that no formal agreement was entered into between the United States and the Compania Maritima; it was verbally agreed that the ship would be on a rental basis for such time as the Commanding General Visayan-Mindanao Forces decided necessary.

This ship was bombed, shelled and sunk in Cebu Harbor sometime in January or February 1942.

Some ships crews were paid by the United States Army. I cannot definitely state if this was true in the case of the crew of the SS "LUZON".

Further information can be obtained from Captain C.J.Martin of the Cebu Stevedoring Company who was acting as Port Captain from Dec 8, 1941 to April 10, 1942.

1.- Name of Owner: COMPANIA MARITIMA.

2.-Description of the property of service:

Requisition of the SS LUZON.

3.- The property was taken by, or the service was rendered to,  
United States forces under the following circumstances:

a)-That on December 18, 1941, the U.S. Army requisitioned  
the SS LUZON and used it until January 18, 1942.

b)-The SS LUZON under U. S. Army orders made five trips  
out of and back to Cebu, carrying Army supplies and personnel.

c)On January 18, 1942, the SS LUZON was bombed while docked at  
Cebu preparatory to sailing for Dumaguete. The ship was beached,  
but later abandoned as a complete loss.

d)-During this entire period it was manned and operated  
by officers and crew of the Compania Maritima although it was  
under orders of the U. S. Army.

4.- The value of the ship when taken by the U. S. Army was US \$  
\$250,000.00, and the per diem charter was US \$600.00

a)-There was no agreement as to value or charter rate. The only  
evidence in possession of the Compania Maritima concerning the  
requisitioning of the SS LUZON consists of the following letter  
signed by Lt. Col. J. D. Cook:

- b)- The signed copy of this letter is in the possession of Compania Maritima and will be surrendered upon request.
- 5.- No money or compensation of any type has been received to date by the Compnaia Maritima, or by any of its representatives, either as rental, or as a partial or total settlement for the charter and loss of the S.S. LUZON.
- 6.-The S.S. LUZON was one of the several ships mortgaged to the Philippine National Bank to cover general overdraft and banking facilities at the time it was taken over by the U. S. Army. These overdraft and banking facilities subsequently were paid off and the mortgages cancelled, so that there is now no outstanding lien or mortgage against the S. S. LUZON.
- 7.-After the property was taken as above, it was abandoned on January 18, 1942 (see paragraph 3-C).
- 8.-I swear that the above statements are true to the best of my knowledge and belief, that we are the owner of the above described property, and are legally entitled to receive payment thereof, that the claim is just and valid; and that in consideration of the payment of US \$269,200.00 calculated as follows: \$250,000.00 for the total loss of the U.S. LUZON, and \$19,200.00 for 32 days use, the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, its officers and agents, are HEREBY UNCONDITIONALLY RELEASED from all liability arising out of the above claims.

That Chief Steward TEODULO S. MAGBANUA was last paid by the United States Army Transport Service in Cebu City on February 15, 1942 with a salary of \$75.00 per month and also he received each ration of \$45.00 a month for subsistence allowance.

That Chief Steward TEODULO S. MAGBANUA was not paid for his quarters allowance since he was enlisted into the USAFFE, United States Army Transport Service.

That on February 17, 1942, he was notified again as an enlisted member in the U.S.A.T.S. and he was requested to report into the U.S.A.T.S. for assignment to vessels under the control of this office, U.S.A.T.S. (USAFFE).

I. TEOBULO SANDOVAL MAGBANUA, of legal age, married and residing at Baritan, Malabon, Rizal, hereby states as follows:

1. That before the war and at the time of the declaration of war between the United States and Japan, I was actually the Chief Steward of the S.S. "Luzon" of the Compania Maritima, Manila.

2. That on December 14, 1941, the USAFFE commandeered said ship, together with its captain, officers and crew in Dumaguete under verbal orders which was followed by written order dated December 17, 1941, in Cebu.

3. That we have made trips carrying soldiers and supplies of the Army until January 18, 1942, when our said ship was bombed, machinegunned and sunk by the Japanese planes.

4. That we received our salaries from the United States Army Transport Service corresponding to the period from December 17, 1941 up to February 15, 1942.

5. That a certain American Captain of the United States Army accompanied by the Captain of the Port, Mr. Martin, also an American, signed a paper or document stating that the United States Army shall pay whatever salary is due us, plus an indemnity in case of accident or death, which document was delivered to the Compania Maritima in Cebu, Mr. Rafael Ramos.

6. That on February 17, 1942, I was again notified that I am enlisted member in the United States Army Transport Service and is requested to report to the Headquarters office for assignment to vessels under the control of this Office - U.S.A.T.S.

Remarks: While in Cebu City, our Headquarters of the Visayan and Mindanao forces was invaded by the Japanese forces on April 10, 1942. Effective on this date all Filipino-American forces were dispersed and went to the mountain. I ran to the mountain also to hide and to escape from the Japanese invaders.

After a few months some Americans and Filipinos were captured, some surrendered.


During my stay in the mountain from April 10, 1942 up to July 24, 1942, I never surrendered nor was captured by the enemy. On July 25, 1942, I left Cebu on a sailboat for Manila to see my family. I arrived in Manila on August 15, 1942.

While in Malabon, I used to hide and escape from the enemy, but helping all I can with the guerilla forces. I did not want to surrender or be captured by the Japs.

Not willing to indulge in the purchases and sales of war materials during the Japanese occupation and not willing to accept a Japanese job under the Puppet Republic, I had to sell most of my properties or belongings to the amount of eighteen thousand pesos (₱20,000) to maintain myself and my family during the Japanese occupation up to the coming of the American forces of liberation.

For other information, refer to Capt. Casimiro Blanes of the S/S "Luzon" or to the Compania Maritima, Manila.

WHEREFORE, I hereby set hereunto my signature in order to justify the truth and veracity of all the facts above stated.
