Dear Mr. Ocampo:

Reference is made to your letters dated 28 March 1955 and 2 May 1955, and to rosters submitted at various dates, addressed to the Foreign Claims Settlement Commission, Washington 25, D. C., concerning alleged guerrilla service rendered by individuals of different organizations during World War II.

The first requirement for crediting an individual with recognized guerrilla service is that the individual's name must appear on an approved reconstructed roster and/or casualty roster of an organization.

The extension of official recognition to individuals or organizations claiming guerrilla status was a function of the Guerrilla Affairs Division. Under this program, a period of more than three years was allowed for guerrilla units and members of such units to request official recognition. When that organization was deactivated on 30 June 1948, the guerrilla recognition program terminated and the authority to alter, amend or modify previous decisions made, ceased to exist.

Although an individual has rendered valid military service with the Philippine Commonwealth Army, including recognized guerrilla service, in the service of the Armed Forces of the United States, this office cannot determine or certify such service unless a request for same is initiated by the United States Veterans Administration.



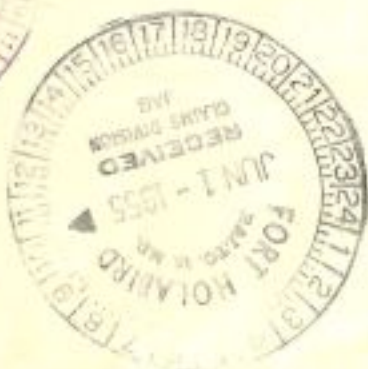

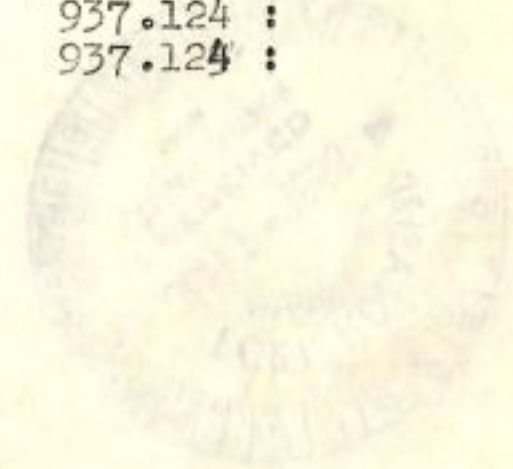
