Given 4 pts of blood. - Post op water conductive surface. - No return of chest of abdomen before surgery. - Rt. Pa. Adm 9060. Shows patient immediately post op. - Rt. Pa. Adm 9060.

29 Oct - Course steadily down hill. - appeared to have peritonitis. - Pt expired @ 0135

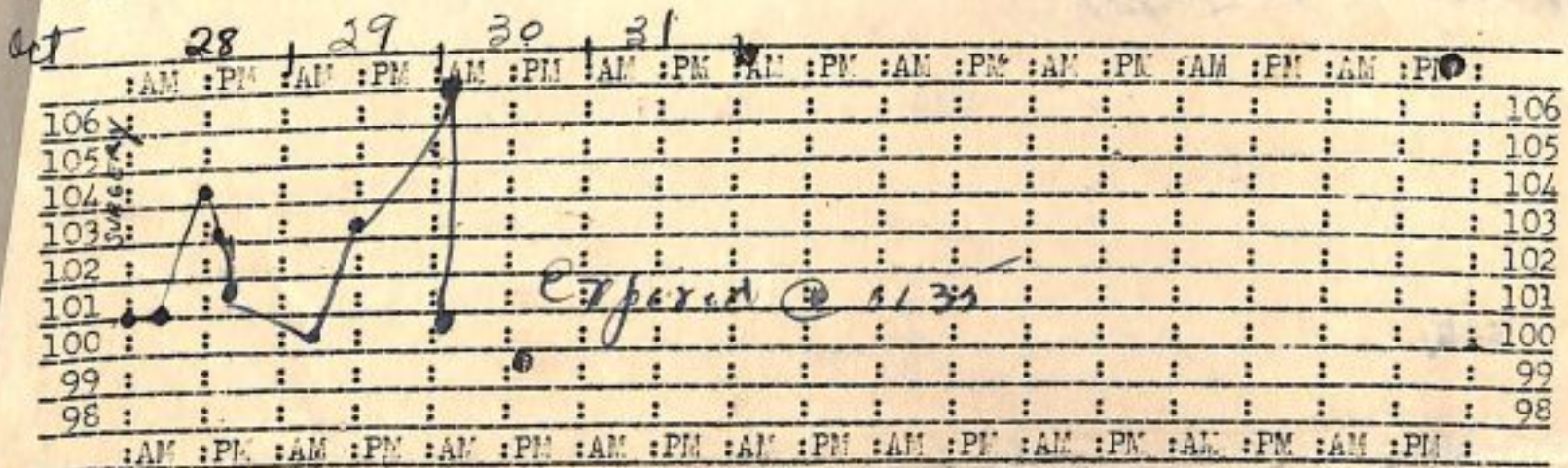
