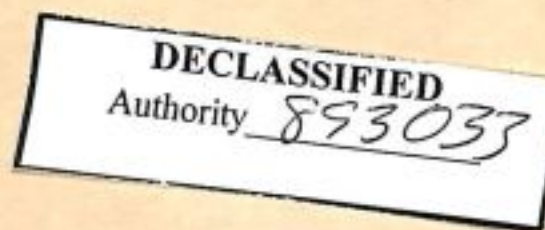

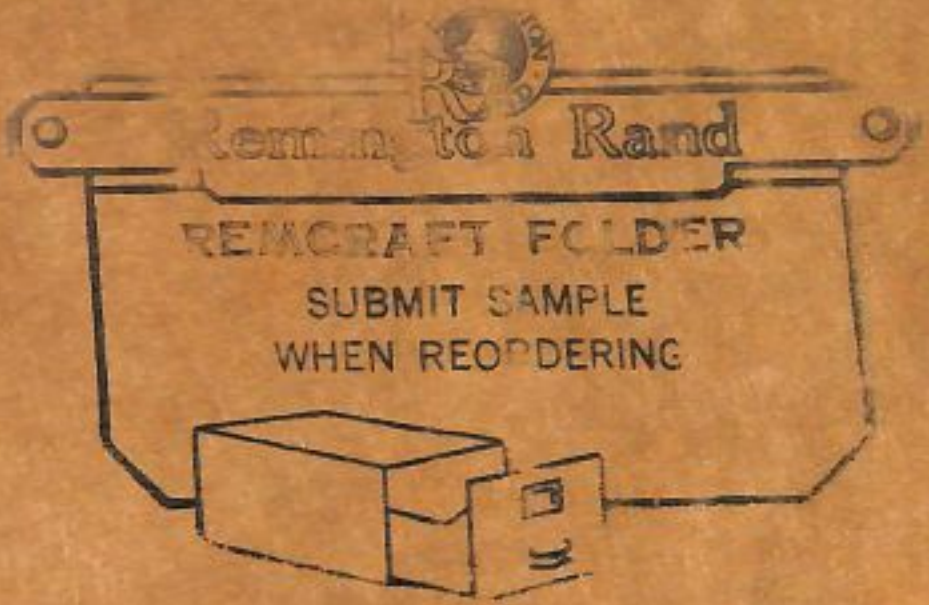

4. a. Recognition as set forth in Paragraph 1, above, is limited to those units listed which served on the islands comprising the Province of Palawan or individual members of those units who were on detached service or special missions to the 6th Military District (Guerrilla).

b. All civilians recruited by or inducted into the Palawan Special Battalion subsequent to 1 October 1943, are considered to have become members of the Philippine Army, serving with the Armed Forces of the United States, with

entitlement to pay subsequent to that date.
