S i r :

The undersigned, residents of the Municipality of Tagig, Province of Rizal, respectfully submit the following, for your information and consideration:

1. That on or about December 1st, 1944, the Japanese Army with the aid of the local Japanese Military Police concentrated in zonification proceeding all the town people of this municipality, accusing them to be members of the Guerrilla Organization, supporters of same and pro-Americans;
2. That from the date they were concentrated up to the present, their whereabouts are not known neither information of their status has ever been heard;
3. That we, being interested parties, do hereby request that you please help them locate these people and to extend to them every possible assistance for their complete liberation; and
4. That the Japanese Officers, particularly those incharge who directly committed unhuman atrocities, in proceeding such zonification against innocent and peaceful citizen like those we referred to, be investigated and to clarify the whereabouts of the said people, and that proper punishment be meted against them in accordance with the International Laws.
