BLACKBURN

Sig Corps USA, operated with Major ALI whose hqs was in ASIGA (70 miles south of Praeger's Hdqs. Blackburn sent intelligence to Maj. Praeger's hqs for transmission to Aust during 1943.

Major ALI

Was in command of KALINGA, LUBUAGAN Sector and was organizing in May 1943. He was captured later in 1943 and killed by Japs.

BOWEN, Lt. William

Was a Sgt in the 43rd Inf (P.S.). He was commissioned thru a radio received by Warner in ISABELLA. He was in charge of CAGAYAN coastal towns. He had his own men (approx. 30 men) and kept the peace. He was captured around May 1943 and killed by Japs.

BRAZELTON, Earl

Was an enlisted man from an AWS outfit. He was a radio operator for Maj. Praeger. He was captured at the same time Praeger was.

CAMP, 1st Lt Francis F.
(P.A.)

// Camp had one Co of 14th Inf and he operated under direct orders of Praeger. He was very active in raiding Jap barracks, trucks, river patrols. He cut communication and burned warehouses. He kidnapped collaborators for questioning. These operations were carried on in western part of CAGAYAN with Hqs in TUAO. He was captured about July 1943, interned in BILIBID and not heard of since. ✓

NEEDHAM, J R Captain

An American miner who was commissioned by Col J.P. Horan, USA. Captured in September.

GORDON PUXMAN

Commissioned by Maj. Praeger in Aug 1943. Captured at BATAAN. Employed as Jap chauffeur and then escaped in MANILA. He joined BARNETT in ABRA and was sent to Praeger with messages. He remained attached to Maj. Praeger from Nov 1942. He was captured while on mission to Manila in March 1943. Escaped and remained in hiding at DAGARA and in Oct 1944 organized his own company and drove the Japs from KABUGAO, APA-YAO Province. He is now a Captain in 11th Inf PA.

Commissioned by radio. He built the radio set from odds and ends for Maj. Praeger in August '42. He took care of set and was later captured with Maj. Praeger and killed Feb 4th 1945, two days before American Liberation.

Was PC commander stationed at KABUGAO. Was in Praegers camp from March 1942 until about July 1943. He was sent on a mission to MANILA and never heard of thereafter.

EM of AWS. He took charge of Jap prisoners. He was captured by Japs April 1943.

American EM worked in radio station from June '43 to Aug '43. Was captured in Aug.

American EM. Captured. Escaped from concentration to join Praeger.

AWS American E.M. Captured. Delivered a letter in Aug '42 from Japs to make Praeger surrender. Joined up & was captured in May '43.

AWS American EM. Brought in 6 Jap prisoners, joined Praeger & was captured May '43.

Aust. miner - commissioned by Col. Moran. Captured in '43.
