Subject: G-2 Report for Sn. Manuel
To: Regimental Commander through the CO 14K.
for consolidation.

The following information has been obtained by the undersigned on Dec. 13-14:

1. No Japanese or PL garrison at Sn. Manuel. The Japanese soldiers from Binolayan, go to Sn. Manuel once or twice a month only. They ride on two trucks. Class A.
2. A platoon of Japanese soldiers from Sn. Nicolas made patrol duty along the banks of Agno River on Dec. 10. They were seen at Sn. Vicente, barrio of Sn. Manuel, at about 10:00 o'clock in the morning. Class B.
3. During the night of Dec. 11/12, the ferry between Tayug and Aguzan had been transporting Japanese soldiers coming from Tayug. Class C.
4. There are two wooden bridges between Binolayan and Sn. Manuel while there is only one wooden bridge between Aguzan and Sn. Manuel. All of these bridges were intact during the guerrilla war in April 1942, but they were repaired when guerrillas surrendered. No telephone or telegraph installations at Sn. Manuel. Class A.
5. The following lists include the municipal officials of Sn. Manuel. The people have no grudge upon them. They are genuine pro-American.
