Note:-

1. The first marked ✦ numbered from 1 to 20 are the settlement with their areas (vast) are now under the occupation of our army USFIP of which and where we can establish our factors for the possibility of our new stable government. With these numbers of settlement gained by our present army it shows that we are gaining more or less 96% areas to farm for the support of our both army and civilians.
2. The second marked → are the indication of our mountains which is very applicable to our army and civilian for hideout of where we encourage our soldiers of the soil to cultivate to plant any sorts of shortening crops for without starvation. Only the great problem to solve of how we can stamp out those had forest men roamers (Magahats who are in occupation the mountains of Saldab (2) Kimangkil (4) Amosig (5) and Dinalhagan (6) where are magahats now are living with their firearms and ammunition.
3. The third marked — are the indication of our rivers and brooks which is preparable for our hide out where we can live with some roots crop in case of long range of our world war, but only our problem is to solve out how can we get the firearms of those deserts along Pulangi river with its branches. The one marked 3 — arrow 1, and 2 are the place of deserts, of course they are not harmful to us but they will prejudice the strength of our army by not submitting their firearms and not only of that they blocked out our free movement to go along Pulangi river Pimamacalan brook, Makatang-an brook, Nahiget brook, Bulonay brook and Amosig brook, because in these brooks are the hiding home of Magahats. In Kitanglad mountain along Sawaga and Manopale brooks are not Magahats but our deserts are hiding in the section. The marked 3 ← and 2 are the mountains of Pantadon and Saldak where the civilians are living with many fire arms that would not submit this fire arms too these are along the brooks of Domalaging, Sila-1, Bubonawan and Kiloles Camasa. The people who are living in the mountain of Amosig along the brook of Amosig are the great robbers and have many fire arms too with ammunition. "The settlements above are mixed with its mountains and brooks where are peaceful and Magahats are living now."
4. Inclosing this report the undersigned has a hope that this will
