Memorandum for Records:

Brig. Gen. Clifford Blummel loaned to the Casualty Branch a list of officers of the 45th Inf. P5 and the 43rd Inf. PG with notes as to their status and their fate. A photostatic copy of the list is attached. He explained that prior to 8 Dec 1941 three battalions of the 45th were at Fort McKinley and that the remaining battalion was detached and that two companies thereof were at Camp John Hay and two companies at Petit Barracks, Zamboanga. The regiment was reorganized and this detached battalion became the 43rd Inf. At prisoner of war camp in Mukden, Gen. Blummel got together all officers who had served with all four battalions of the 45th (which includes the 43rd) and jointly they prepared the attached list. Gen. Blummel stated that "D" means dead, "K" means killed, "MH" means medal of honor, "Z" means Zamboanga, etc.

Memorandum for Record:

Brig. Gen. Clifford Blumel loaned to the Casualty Branch a list of officers of the 45th Inf. PS and the 43rd Inf. PS with notes as to their status and their fate. A photostatic copy of the list is attached. He explained that prior to 8 Dec 1941 three battalions of the 45th were at Fort McKinley and that the remaining battalion was detached and that two companies thereof were at Camp John Hay and two companies at Pettit Barracks, Zamboanga. The Regiment was reorganized and this detached battalion became the 43rd Inf. At prisoner of war camp in Mukden, Gen. Blumel got together all officers who had served with all four battalions of the 45th (which includes the 43rd) and jointly they prepared the attached list. Gen. Blumel stated that "D" means dead, "K" means killed, "MH" means medal of honor, "Z" means Zamboanga, etc.

2. This investigation was initiated in view of a request received from Battle Monuments Unit, WW II PRS, for determination of correct grade at time of death, plus the fact that discrepancies were noted on the official records.

3. DISCUSSION: The latest available pay record of Company C, 45th Infantry (PS) is for December 1941, which shows that subject was paid as a Private First Class, Specialist Sixth Class. Paragraph 2 of copy of Special Order No. 10, Headquarters, 45th Infantry (PS), In the Field, dated 4 February 1942, found in subject's 201 file, recommending that Jorge L. Bacay, 10 303 924, of Company C, be promoted to Corporal, *vise* Oliveros, Killed in Action, would indicate that subject was previously promoted to the grade of Corporal. Inasmuch as the aforementioned order was not signed, a search was made of archive files in an effort to obtain a signed copy, however, no record was found. The records of several men listed on the order were obtained and, of these, a copy of Special Order No. 10, bearing the typed notation: "Certified True Copy: J. G. Lovrien, 1st Lt, CAC", was found in the 201 file of Eduardo N. Fernandez, 10 301 441; also, information showing that he was promoted to Corporal based on this order. It was noted that the records of Tobias Olan, 6 866 249; Eusebio Castro, R-3 293 299 and Bartolome Magallan, 6 736 350, contain information showing that they held the grade of Corporal prior to 4 February 1942. Although, the only individual, of the records obtained, who was given a promotion on the basis of the order was Fernandez, it appears that the order was not available in other cases. Based on the information outlined above, it is believed that copy of Special Order No. 10, Headquarters, 45th Infantry (PS) dated 4 February 1942 should be accepted as authentic. While the date of promotion of subject cannot be determined from available evidence, it is concluded that he held the grade of Corporal at the time of his death.

The AGO Form 0728 dated 20 March 1942 showing subject's grade as Private First Class was issued based on information received by Radio from the Philippine Islands AG 704.1 (3-17-42) EB 07604-10. It appears that interested agencies were notified of subject's death showing his grade as Private First Class. No record has been found to show that a DA AGO Form 52-1 was ever issued in this case; however, since the interested Government agencies were notified as to his death, a Corrected Report of Death should now be furnished such agencies.
