EXECUTIVE CRDER NO. 24

REORGANIZING THE LIMISTRIES, SUREAUS, OFFICES, AGENCIES AND INSTRUMENTALITIES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES.

Pursuant to the powers vested in me by Act No. 10 to offect changes in the different ministries, bureaus, offices, agencies, and instrumentalities of the Government, including government-owned or controlled corporations, and to create new ones or abeliah those existing, I, JOSE P. LAUREN, President of the Republic of the Philippines, do hereby order -

SECTION 1. Ministries. There shall be nine Ministries in the Government of the Republic of the Philippines, to with the Ministry of Foreign Afrairs, the Ministry of Home Affairs, The Ministry of Finance, the Ministry of Home Affairs, The Ministry of Fanner, the Ministry of Agriculture and Ratural Resources, the Ministry of Education, the Ministry and the Ministry of Health, Labor, and Public Wolfare. Each Limistry shall be under the direct control of its corresponding Ministry of State. In addition to the Ministries hersin enumerated, there shall be an Office of the Fresident under the direct control of the Recentive Secretary, who shall have the rank of Ministry of State. Rach Ministry shall, subject to the supervision and control of the President, and under the executive authority of the Minister concerned, be responsible for the proper and offective performance of the Tunctions and activities of the Government falling within its jurisdiction as the same are now or may horser the secretary has desired.

President.— The Office of the President shall have executive supervision over the Executive Bureau, the General Auditing Office, the Bureau of Civil Service, including the Bearda of Examiners, the Bureau of Information, and the Bureau of Printing.

SEC. 3. Bureaus and Offices under the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs shall have executive superficion over the Bureau of General Affairs, the Bureau or Political Affairs, the Bureau of International Trade Relations, the Fress and International Cultural Relations Bureau, and the Embassis, Legations, and Consulates of the Republic of the Philipphnes in foreign countries.

Hom Affairs. The Ministry of Home Affairs shall have concurred supervision over the administration of provinces, runnicipalities, chartered cities and other local political subditions, the Philippine Constabulary, the Bureau of Roligious Affairs, and the Board of Roview.

Ministry of Finance under the Ministry of Finance. The Ministry of Finance shall have exceptive supervision over the Bureau of the Badget and Accounts, the Bureau of Customs and Internal Revenue, the Bureau of the Treasury, the Bureau of Guádas and Investments, the Public Employees Life Insurance Bureau, and the Fhilippine Charity Sweepstakes Bureau.

Justice - The Linistry of Justice shall have executive supervision over the Oode Committee, the Court of Appeals, the Courts of First Instance, the Burcau of Public Preservation the Burcau of Friests, the Burcau of Friest Public States of the Provincial and City Sheriffe, the Municipal Courts, and the Justice of the Peace Courts.

SEC. 7. Burcaus under the Ministry of Arriculture and Natural Resources.— The Ministry of Arriculture and Natural Resources shall have executive supervision over the Burcau of Flant Industry, the Burcau of Lands, the Burcau of Forestry, the Sureau of Flantice, the Burcau of Solonce, and the Burcau of Mines.

Education - The Ministry of Education shall have executive supervision over the Beau of Public Instruction, the University of the Philappines, the Surcau of Private Education, who Burcau of Physical Education, was Estional Library, the Institute of National Language, and the Burcau of Oriental Culture.

SEC. 9. Bureaus under the Ministry of Public Works and Burmann actions. The Ministry of Public Works and Communications shall have executive supervision over the Bureau of Public Works, the Bureau of Communications, the Bureau of Public Service, the Weather, Geodetic and Hydrographic Bureau, and the Metropolitan Waterworks Bureau.

Economic Affairs. The Ministry of Economic Affairs shell have exocutive supervision over the Bureau of Commorce and Industries, the Food Administration, the Bureau of the Commorce and Industries, the Food Administration, the Bureau of the Commorce and Statistics, and the various government-owned or controlled corporations, and also over purchases of equipment and supplies for the various offices, officials, and branches of the Government and other persons entitled to make purchases through the Government.

SEC. 11. Bureaus and Offices under the Ministry of Health, Labor, and Fublic Wolfare.— The Ministry of Health, Labor, and Fublic Wolfare, shall have executive supervision over the Bureau of Health, the Bureau of Labor, the Bureau of Public Wolfare, and the Fnilippine General Heaptal.

SEC. 12. Powers, Punctions and Duties of Ministries, and Duties of Ministries of Ministries of Section I hereof, with the exception of the Ministry of Section I hereof, with the exception of the Ministry of Section I hereof, with the exception of the Ministry of Ministry and Public Wolfare, shall continue to examine the Powers and perform the functions and duties vested in them by existing laws and regulations except as the same may be modified or enlarged by the provisions of this Order. The Ministry of Home Affairs and the Ministry of Agriculture and Natural Resources shall exercise the powers and perform the functions and duties of the former Inistry of the Interior and the Ministry of Agriculture and Commerce, respectively, cropt as also medified or enlarged in this Order.

SEC. 13. Powers, Functions, and Duties of the Ministry of Economic Affairs.— The Ministry of Economic Affairs, the Ministry of Economic Affairs shall be charged with the prediction and development of the national economy; the full account of the conomic opinions of the national economic policies and activities of the different governmental outsides, agencies and instrumentalities; and with such other functions and duties as may hereafter be entrusted to it by law.

SEC. 14. Fowers, Functions and Duties of the Ministry of Hoalth, Lebor, and Public Wolfare. The Ministry of Health, Labor, and Public Wolfare. The Ministry of Health, Labor, and Public Wolfare shall be charged with the protection of the health of the people, the maintenance of sanitary conditions, the propor enforcement of the laws relative to health, sanitation and social services and over all matters concerning labor or labor in its relative to encorning labor or labor in its relation to capital and those relative to the welfare of laborers in this country and abroad, as well as the proper enforcement of the laws relative to labor and capital in the Philippines.

SEC. 15. Powers. Functions and Duties of Burcaus and Offices. The Burcaus and Offices councerated in the next procedure sections, with the exception of those originally created by this Order and except as herein modified or enlarged, shall continue to except as herein modified or other functions and duties vested in them by existing laws and regulations.

The Bureau of International Trade Relations shall exercise the powers and perform the functions and duties of the former Bureau of Recommic Affairs in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

cultural relations; and generally, of the dissemination abroad of representative intellectual and cultural works of the Philippines and the improvement and broadening of the scope of the cultural relations of the Philippines with other countries. It shall prepare and distribute publications of the Einistry of Foreign Affairs and disseminate information concerning them.

The Bureau of Political Affairs shall enforce and administor the laws relating to the irrigration of aliens into the Philippines and shall exercise the powers and perforn the functions and duties of the Alien Registration and Legalization Division of the former Ministry of the Interjor.

The Philippine Constabulary and the Bureau of Labor and duties of the former Bureau of the Constabulary and the former Bureau of Amployment, respectively.

The Board of Review shall enforce and administer the law on consorship of moving, pictures, shall censor stage shows and similar entertainments, and shall exercise and perform such other functions and duties as may hereafter be outrusted to it by law.

The Bureau of the Budget and Accounts shall exercises the powers and perform the functions and duties of the former Budget and Auditing Office insofar as they pertain or relate to the preparation of the budget and any proposal of supplementary, special of deficiency appropriations; to the investigation, revisiot, exemination, assembly, coordination and reduction or increase of the estimates of the various ministries, bureaue, offices and dependencies of the government; to the release of funds and the expenditure of appropriations and allocanes; and dependencies of the companion of the former of the Budget and Accounts of the Corement. The Eureur of the Budget and Accounts shall also have technical supervision over accounting matters in all corporations established and organized in accordance with the lews of the Republic of the Philippines wherein the Government of the said Republic of any of its branches owns the majority of the stock or shares.

The Bureau of Credits and Investments shall exercise the powers and perform the functions and duties of the former Bureau of Financing.

The Bureau of Public Prosecution shall exercise the powers and perform the functions and duties of the former

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Bureau of Justice and shall, in addition, have executive supervision over the offices of the provincial and city

The Bureau of Property Registration shall exercise the powers and perform the functions and duties of the former Genoral Land Registration Office and the existing Judicial Land Titles Division in the Ministry of Justice.

The Burcau of Fisheries shall exercise the powers and perform the functions and duties of the former Burcau of Forestry and Fishery insofer as they portain or relate to the protection, nanogement, and development of ell national and municipal fisheries and research to the first state of the first

The Bureau of Oriental Culture shall have immediate charge of the work portaining to the propuration, adoption or approval of text books for use in all the schools. It shall undertake researches, studies and investigations on Oriental culture and coordinate and make available the results thereor, and disscainate and propagate the same.

The Weather, Goodetic and Hydrographic Durous shall exercise the powers and perform the functions and duties of the former Weether Bureau and the Goodetic and Hydrographic Section in the Hinistry of Public Works and Communications.

The Public Employees Life Insurance Bureau, the Philippine Charity Sweepstakes Bureau, and the Kerropolitan Water-works Bureau shall exceed to powers and perform the functions and duties of the former Public Employees Life Insurance, the Philippine Charity Sweepstakes Office, and the Mctropolitan Waterworks Office, respectively.

Office: - All bureaus and offices under the different Min-Tatrics shall each have one director or chief and as many assistant directors or assistant chiefs as the appropriation acts may provide.

SEC. 17. Ministorial Authority to Create, Suppress, or Reduce Activities and Transfer Services, with the can sponding Forsonnal and Appropriation. For the purposs of offecting simplicity ari economy and promoting efficiency in the service, the proper Minister State is hereby underrised,

subject to the approval of the President, to suppress or reduced any activity under his ininistry, transfer any activity to another, add a new activity to any divirted on the case in the control of the divirient of another, add a new activity to any divirted on the case in the control of the different bureaus and active of a Himistry. He is, likewise, hereby authorized; actives of a Himistry. He is, likewise, hereby authorized; and just the same approval, to transfer, reduce, abolish, increase or create any time of appropriation for salaries and awages in order to only into effect the recognization herein awages in order to only into effect the recognization herein authorized. Provided, That the not result of such transfers, reductions, abolitions, thereases or creation of new items shall not exceed the total of the corresponding appropriations affected as awaherized in the 1944 Appropriation Act.

SEC. 18. Implied Ministerial Feater and Datigs. - Whomever a specific power, authority, duty function, or activity is entrusted to a chief of bureau, office, division or service, the same shall be understood as also conferred upon the proper Minister of State who shall have authority to act directly in pursuance thereof; or to review, modify or revoke any decision or action of said chief of bureau, office, division or sorrice.

Suc. 19. Reversion of Userpended Fund Balances of Burcaus and offices. The unexpended balances of funds or appropriations pertaining to burcaus, offices, divisions or activities abolished or otherwise terminated in accordance with the provisions of this Order shall revort to the unappropriated surplus of the National Government and all the equipment, natorials, records and other proporties pertaining to said burcaus, offices, divisions, or activities shall be disposed of as may be directed by the President.

SEC. 20. Transfor of Unexpended Balances of Bureaus and Offices. The unexpensed balances of indee or appropriations and the personnel, equirent, materials, records and other properties pertaining to bureau, offices, divisions or activities transferred to a Ministry, Fureau or office, in accordance with the previsions of this order, shall be merged with the funds or appropriations, personnel, equirment, materials, records, and other proporties pertaining to the Ministry, bureau, office or division concerned, to be used for the small purpose for which they were crisinally intended. The transfer of personnel, funds or appropriations, equipment, materials, records and other proporties herein authorized shall be made by the Ministers of State censering and the Amitter General.

SEC. 21. Vacancies and New Appointments .- All officers

positions are abolished or who hay be separated from the service as a consequence of the reorganization provided in this Order shall be entitled to such gratuity as may be fixed by appropriate legislation on the basis of the actual salary received and under such torus and conditions as may be fixed by law. They shall not loss their civil service oligibility for a period of ten years from the date of their separation from the service, and in ease an either not provided the services of additional personnel, preference in the appointment shall by given to them.

SEO. 23. Effectivity. Explanation of the proclamation concerning reopening of factories:

A proclamation was issued on February 5, 1942 to reopen the closed factories in Greater Manila City.

Almost all factories in Greater Manila City being closed, it is causing shortage of daily commodities and unemployment of laborers. The proclamation is simed to meet this situation and all factories are urged to resume their business as soon as possible.

It is the intention of the Japanese authorities hereto put neceseary control over them and let them contribute to the execution mg of fighting and to the production of necessary goods as well as to promote the welfare of the citizens in the city.
