There they knocked out the American Far Rastern Air Force with almost the same dewastating effect they dealt the U. S. Facific Fleet 5,000 miles amey.

The 26th Cavalry, boshed out of Fort Stotsenburg, moved into the nearby mountains, prepared to strike at the first enemy beach landing wherever it might come. On December 9, Nichols Field, another key army air base at Manila was boshed almost to destruction. The Japa apparently hoped to catch that part of the FFAF which had gone there for refuge.
