HISTORY OF THE 1ST NEGROS OCCIDENTAL CO FC

(Dec 1941 - May 1942)

- A. The following history of the 1st Negros Occidental Co FC has been deduced from a special study conducted on eighty-six (86) 1st Negros Occidental Co FC cases:

At the outbreak of the war, the 1st Negros Occidental Co FC, under Maj Pullong Arpa (then Capt), CO, was stationed at Cadiz, Negros Occidental. Junior Officer of the Company was Lt Froilan M. Maglaya. Before 27 Dec 41 some members of the Company were assigned to the Provincial Hqs FC and the West Elementary School Det, both stationed at Bacolod City.

All the cases studied, except those on detached service with the Provincial Hqs and West Elementary School Det, allege induction at Cadiz on various dates during the period 15 Dec 41 - 9 Jan 42. The majority of these Cadiz inductees mention Capt Sam C. Jones as their inducting officer; about seven (7) mention Capt R. Hill; one mentions Capt C. F. Heily; a couple mention Maj Arpa, and one, Maj Montilla. Authentic induction papers of the 1st Negros Occidental Co FC at Cadiz, on file at Archives Section, Records Branch (photostat copies attached), however, show that the FC personnel at Cadiz were inducted by 2 different officers on 2 different dates. The first and bigger group was inducted on 30 Dec 41 by Capt Richard F. Hill and the second group of eight (8) was inducted on 2 Jan 42 by Capt Pullong Arpa. These official documents conclusively prove that Capt Hill & Capt Arpa officiated the induction ceremonies of FC personnel at Cadiz on 30 Dec 41 and 2 Jan 42, respectively. Capt Arpa appears in the earlier list, hence he had authority to perform the induction made on 2 Jan 42.

Capt Sam C. Jones has been erroneously mentioned as the inducting officer of the majority of the cases studied because he performed many inductions in that province at about that time. Official records, however, show that he inducted only volunteers and reservists.

Members of the Company on detached service with the Provincial Hqs Det and the West Elementary School Det at Bacolod City, also mention Capt Sam C. Jones as their inducting officer on various dates during the period 17 Dec 41 - 27 Dec 41. However, an official induction paper

of the FC at Bacolod City on file at Archives Sec, Records Branch, shows that FC personnel at this place were inducted on 27 Dec 41 by Capt. Richard I. Hill (Project "J" records show that correct middle initial is F).

After the general reorganization of the Negros Forces in early '42, (See Histories of 1st Negros Oriental FC and 2d Negros Occidental FC companies and Chapter II, History of the Negros Force) members of the company were attached to Companies K, L and M, 3d Bn, 74th Inf Regt, 72d Provisional Div under Bn CO, Maj Ernesto Mata.

Again, "immediately after the fall of Bataan," the Negros Force was reorganized in order to effect a new defense plan. Under this plan, the Negros Force (or the 72d Provisional Div) was divided into 5 units and Negros island was geographically divided into 5 sub-sectors. Each sub-sector was to be garrisoned by a corresponding unit of the Negros Force. What was originally the 3d Bn, 74th Inf Regt under Maj Mata was assigned to garrison "the 1st Sub-Sector comprising the towns of Murcia, Talisay, Silay, Manapla, Victorias, Saravia and the City of Bacolod." In view of this new set-up, the FC members attached to the three companies of the 3d Bn, 74th Inf Regt were distributed among the detachments stationed at the above-mentioned towns. Hence, the various allegations on date and place of surrender or disbandment of these FC personnel.

On or about 21 May 42, the enemy forces landed at Banago wharf. On this date Col Hilsman, CO of the USAFFE forces in Negros island issued the order to surrender. This order was made on authority of earlier instructions to surrender received from Maj Gen Sharp, CO Visayan-Mindanao Forces. As in the case of the other units under his (Col Hilsman's) command, very few unit commanders complied with the order. Of the 86 cases studied, only 20 allege to have surrendered. The majority of those who surrendered claim to have done so on or about 22 May 42 at Fabrica, Negros Occidental. Capt Pullong Arpa and Lt Froilan M. Maglaya, CO and JO, respectively, of the 1st Negros Occidental FC at the outbreak of the war, surrendered. The Bn CO, 3d Bn, 74th Inf Regt, Maj Ernesto Mata and his company commanders to whom members of the 1st Negros Occidental Co FC were attached, did not surrender. The 3 members who were originally attached

to and inducted with the Provincial Hqs, surrendered at Fabrica on 22 May 42.

No definite date nor place of disbandment for the rest of the members could be made because they were stationed at the different towns of the 1st Sub-Sector. Hence, they could not have had a uniform record of activities. However, based on known historical facts obtaining in Negros at that time, it is safe to presume that the dissolution of these units occurred during the period 22 May 42 to 28 May 42, at the aforesaid towns.

B. A thorough search of all available archives for the 1st Negros Occidental Co FC has been made at Archives Sec, Records Branch and at Project "J". The following have been found:

1. Original payrolls for the months Jan 42 thru May 42, at Archives Sec;
2. Photostat copies of certificates of induction by Capt Richard F. Hill at Bacolod City dtd 27 Dec 41 and at Cadiz dtd 30 Dec 41, at Archives Sec;
3. Photostat copy of a certificate of induction by Capt Pullong Arpa at Cadiz, Negros Occidental dtd 2 Jan 42, at Archives Sec;
4. Photostat copies of extracts of SO #4, 6 & 8 dtd 10 Jan 42, 17 Jan 42 and 1 Feb 42, respectively, issued by FC Hqs, Dept of Visayas, Cebu City, showing promotions of 1st Negros Occidental Co FC personnel, at Archives Sec;
5. Project "J" records indicate that the following were U.S. Army officers in the Philippines during the Japanese invasion:

- (1) Sam C. Jones - 1st Lt - O-377039 -
Co H, 45th Inf.
- (2) Richard F. Hill - Capt - O-20745 -
Co F, 57th Inf.
- (3) Charles F. Healy - Capt - O-314708 -
Hqs 2d Bn, 45th Inf.

Sam C. Jones is the alleged inducting officer of the majority of the cases studied.
Richard F. Hill is the alleged inducting officer of 7 of these cases. He is the correct inducting officer of the majority of the cases.
Charles F. Healy is the alleged inducting officer of one of the cases.

C. From the above facts and findings the following conclusions have been drawn:

1. The 1st Negros Occidental Co FC under CO Capt Pullong Arpa and JO Lt Froilan M. Maglays, was stationed at Cadiz, Negros Occidental at the outbreak of the war.
2. Some members of the company were on detached service with the Provincial Hqs Det and West Elementary School Det at Bacolod City before 27 Dec 41.
3. All the members stationed at Cadiz, except eight (those inducted on 2 Jan 42 by Capt Arpa), were inducted on 30 Dec 41 by Capt Richard F. Hill, at that place.
4. Eight (8) members (exceptions in the preceding paragraph) were inducted on 2 Jan 42 by company CO Pullong Arpa at Cadiz.
5. Those members stationed at Bacolod City attached to the Provincial Hqs and West Elementary School Det were inducted on 27 Dec 41 by Capt Richard F. Hill, in that place.
6. On or about Mar 42, after the general reorganization of the Negros Force, the company was attached to the 3d Bn, 74th Inf Regt, 72d Provisional Div under Bn CO, Maj Ernesto Mata.
7. Immediately after the fall of Bataan another reorganization took place. Negros was divided into 5 sub-sectors. What was originally the 3d Bn, 74th Inf Regt was assigned to garrison the 1st Sub-Sector comprising the towns of Murcia, Talisay, Silay, Manapla, Victorias, Saravia and Bacolod City. Members of the 1st Negros Occidental Co FC who were attached to the 3d Bn, 74th Inf Regt, together with non-FC members of that Bn, were distributed among these towns.
8. Only 20 out of 86 cases studied, surrendered at Fabrica on or about 22 May 42. Among those who surrendered were Capt Arpa and Lt Maglays, CO and JO, respectively, of the company at the outbreak of the war. The rest disbanded during the period 22 May 42 - 28 May 42 at the towns where they were last stationed.
9. The 1st Negros Occidental Co FC was a bonafide USAFFE unit for the period 27 Dec 41 to 28 May 42 as proven by authentic certificates of induction and by USAFFE payrolls dtd Jan 42 thru May 42.



2. That Corp ALEJANDRE L. LOJA was enlisted in the 1st Co. Philippine Constabulary, Cadiz, Negros Occidental, and was inducted to the USAFFE on 27 December '41 by Capt SAM C. JONES, CO, 74th Inf Regt (USAFFE).
3. That the 1st Company (PC) was attached to 3rd Bn, 74th Infantry under the command of Major ENESTO S. MATA;
4. That on 24 May '42 his Unit was disbanded at Alegria, Murcia, Negros Occidental;
5. That after disbandment or surrender Corp ALEJANDRE L.
