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HISTORY OF THE 2D NEGROS OCCIDENTAL CO FC

(Dec 1941 - May 1942)

- A. The following history of the 2d Negroes Occidental Co FC has been deduced from a special study conducted on seventy-three (73) 2d Negroes Occidental CO FC cases:

At the outbreak of the war, the 2d Negroes Occidental Co FC under then 1st Lt Primo C. Manuel, CO, was stationed at Isabela, Negroes Occidental. JO of the Company was 2d Lt Salvador Z. Carbonell. Some members of this Company were attached to the Provincial Hqs Det FC and to the West Elementary School Det at Bacolod City before 27 Dec 41.

The majority of the cases studied allege induction into the USAFFE on or about 27 Dec 41 at either Bacolod or Isabela, Negroes Occidental. Several inducting Officers have been mentioned; among them are: Capt. Sam C. Jones, Capt Richard F. Hill, Capt Richard Jones, Capt Crisanto Vidamo and Capt Primo C. Manuel. The majority of those who allege induction at Bacolod mention Capt Sam C. Jones as inducting officer. However, an authentic induction paper dated 27 Dec 41 at Archives Sec, Records Branch, shows that the inducting officer of the FC personnel stationed at Bacolod City on 27 Dec 41, was Capt Richard I. Hill. (Project "J" records show that correct middle initial is F.) This official document definitely proves that Capt Richard F. Hill officiated the induction ceremony of FC personnel at Bacolod City on 27 Dec 41. It is believed that these cases erroneously gave Capt Sam C. Jones' name as inducting officer because he performed many inductions in that province at about that time. However, official records show that he inducted only volunteers and reservists.

Those who allege induction at Isabela mention Capt Crisanto Vidamo and Capt Sam C. Jones as inducting Officers. CO, JO and a majority of these cases state that Capt Vidamo inducted the whole company "in behalf of Col. Hilsman." Capt Vidamo was inducted into the USAFFE on 21 Dec 41 as a Captain. Being a USAFFE officer he was in a position to make inductions.

Before the general reorganization of the Negroes Forces in early Jan 42, (See page 1, Hist of Negroes Or FC) Provincial Commander Negroes Occidental FC was Maj Eduardo R. Montilla with station at Bacolod City. Following this reorganization, Maj Montilla took command of the whole Constabulary forces in Negroes Island (See affidavit of Maj L. Balolong dtd 14 May 45, Hist of Neg Or FC) and joined Col Hilsman at the latter's Hqs in La

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Granja, Neg Occ. Maj Roman Alejandro who was then the Provincial Inspector, became Actg Provincial Commander with headquarters at Bacolod City, in Maj Montilla's absence.

After this reorganization members of the 2d Neg Occ Co FC stationed at Isabela were attached to the 74th Inf Regt, 72d Provisional Div on or about Feb or Mar 42. The company was split into two detachments. One detachment under CO Primo C. Manuel was attached to the 1st Bn, 74th Inf Regt whose Bn CO was Maj Francisco Gomez. JO of the company, Salvador Z. Carbonell took charge of the other detachment which was attached to the 2nd Bn whose Bn CO was Capt Salvador Abcede. It is believed that these two Bns were bivouacked in 2 different places because of the difference in place of disbandment and surrender alleged by their corresponding FC members. Members attached to the 1st Bn show Hda Mercedes, La Castellana, Neg Occ as their last place of operation while those attached to the 2d Bn show Isabela, Neg Occ.

On or about 11 May 42, Maj Gen Sharp, CO Visayan-Mindanao Forces, issued a directive for the surrender of the USAFFE forces in Negros Island. Col Hilsman took no action on this order until 21 May 42 when the enemy forces landed at Banago wharf near Bacolod City. On this latter date he (Col Hilsman) issued orders for the surrender of the USAFFE forces under him. However, only a few unit commanders complied with these orders. Maj Gomez, CO, 1st Bn, 74th Inf gave his men the choice between surrender and disbandment. Lt Manuel, FC Det Commander and a few of his men surrendered with his Bn CO at Hda Mercedes, La Castellana, Neg Occ on or about 27 May 42. The rest disbanded on the same date. Capt Abcede, CO, 2d Bn, 74th Inf, after reaching an agreement with other officers of the 2d Bn, decided not to surrender despite orders from higher headquarters. He ordered his men to disband on or about 27 May 42 at Isabela, Neg Occ.

Members of the Company who were attached to the West Elementary School Det claim the same activities as those members attached to the 74th Inf Regt. It is therefore presumed that they rejoined the main bulk of the Company at Isabela and La Castellana during the period between their induction and disbandment or surrender. They remained with the FC detachments attached to the 74th Inf until their disbandment on or about 27 May 42.

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On the other hand, members of the Company who were attached to the Provincial Hqs Det remained at Bacolod City until the landing of the enemy on or about 21 May 42. (This detachment served as a USAFFE outpost). Some of them surrendered then and there; others fled, and a few remained with the unit until its final disbandment a few days later. No definite date nor place could be made for this disbandment because these personnel state various dates and places. However, it is safe to presume that the dissolution of the unit occurred during the period 22 May 42 to 27 May 42.

B. A thorough search of all available archives for 2d Negroes Occidental Co FC has been made at Archives Sec, Records Branch and at Project "J". The following have been found:

1. Original payrolls for the months Jan 42 thru Mar 42, at Archives Sec;
2. Photostat copy of an induction paper dtd 27 Dec 41 signed by Capt Richard I. Hill, at Archives Sec;
3. Photostat copies of extracts of SO #4, 6 and 8 dtd 10 Jan 42, 17 Jan 42 and 1 Feb 42 respectively, issued by FC Hqs, Dept of Visayas, Cebu City, showing promotions of 2d Neg Occ FC personnel, at Archives Sec;
4. Photostat copies of original vouchers (USAFFE) dtd Jan, Feb and Mar 42, signed by Maj E. R. Montilla, at Archives Sec;
5. Project "J" records indicate that the following were US Army Officers in the Phil during the war:

- (1) Sam C. Jones - 1st Lt - O-377039 -  
Co H, 45th Inf
- (2) Richard I. Jones - Lt Col - O-292839 -  
57th Inf
- (3) Richard F. Hill - Capt - O-20745 -  
Co F, 57th Inf.

Lt Sam C. Jones is the alleged inducting officer of many of the cases studied.

Lt Col R. I. Jones is the alleged inducting officer of 3 of these cases.

Capt R. F. Hill is the inducting officer of the FC personnel at Bacolod City.

C. From the above facts and findings the following conclusions have been drawn:

1. The 2d Neg Occ Co FC under CO, Lt Primo C. Manual and JO Lt Salvador Z. Carbonell, was stationed at Isabela, Neg Occ at the outbreak of the war.

2. Some members of the Company were attached to the Provincial Hq Det, PC and West Elementary School Det at Bacolod City before 27 Dec 41.
3. Members of the Company stationed at Isabela were inducted on or about 27 Dec 41 at that place by Capt Crisanto Vidamo.
4. Members who were at Bacolod City were inducted by Capt Richard F. Hill, USA on 27 Dec 41.
5. The 2d Neg Occ Co PC became an element of the Negros Forces which was later redesignated the 72d Provisional Div, USAFFE.
6. On or about Feb or Mar 42, the Company was split into 2 detachments and attached to the 1st and 2d Bns, 74th Inf Regt. Lt Primo C. Manuel took charge of the detachment attached to the 1st Bn and Lt Salvador Z. Carbonell of the detachment attached to the 2d Bn.
7. A few members of the detachment attached to the 1st Bn, 74th Inf surrendered with their CO at Hda Mercedes, La Castellana on or about 27 May 42. The rest disbanded on the same date.
8. The detachment attached to the 2d Bn disbanded at Isabela on or about 27 May 42. Not one of its personnel surrendered.
9. Members of the Company on detached service with the Prov'l Hq stayed in Bacolod City until 21 May 42. Some surrendered to the enemy at that place, on that date; others escaped, while a few remained with the unit until its disbandment between the period 22 May 42 to 27 May 42.
10. Members of the Company inducted with the West Elementary School Det, rejoined their mother unit and were subsequently attached to either the 1st or 2d Bns, 74th Inf. Thenceforth, they underwent the same activities as those of members of the 74th Inf.
11. The 2d Neg Occ Co PC was a bonafide USAFFE unit for the period 27 Dec 41 to 27 May 42 as proven by USAFFE payrolls and vouchers dtd Jan 42 thru Apr 42.

I, EDUARDO R. MONTILLA, of legal age, married, Filipino, Lieutenant Colonel, Infantry, Philippine Army and District Commander, 7th Military District, with Office at Bacolod City, Negros Occidental, after having been duly sworn to according to law, hereby depose and say:

- 1) That I was the Provincial Inspector, Philippine Constabulary, Negros Occidental with Office at Bacolod City, before the last war and until surrender in May, 1942;
- 2) That Capt. Primo C. Manuel, Inf(PC), was the Commanding Officer of the 2nd Negros Occidental Company, Philippine Constabulary, stationed at Isabela, Negros Occidental, under me as such Provincial Inspector, about a year before the last war and until surrender in May, 1942;
- 3) That Capt Primo C. Manuel and all the members of his Company were inducted at Isabela, Negros Occidental by the late Capt. C. F. Vidano on 27 December 1942 into the USAFFE, for and in behalf of Col. Hilsman, CO, Negros Island Sector, USAFFE, to which the whole Philippine Constabulary units in Negros were then attached.
- 4) That Capt Primo C. Manuel was among those Reserve Officers then in active service under me whose tour of active duty was extended for the duration of the last war and six (6) months thereafter, as contained in radiographic instructions received from the Chief of the Philippine Constabulary, Manila sometime in the latter part of December 1942. However, all our records were lost as a result of the last war.

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## C E R T I F I C A T E

I, Roman Alejandro, 60 years old, Married,

 residing at Buan, Batangas, hereby declare that I understand my rights under the Constitution and Laws of the Philippines; that I also understand that my statements will be used to prove material facts in support of a claim for veterans benefits from the United States Government, and that I make these statements voluntarily and freely:

That, during December 1941 I was Provincial Inspector, Philippine Constabulary, Negros Occidental, and also acting Provincial Commander of the PC with headquarters at Bacolod, Negros Occidental, in the absence of Lt. Colonel Eduardo R. Montilla, the Provincial Commander, who was at La Granja, Negros Occidental with Col. Hillsman, U. S. Army Commander of Negros Island.

That, I was inducted into the USAFFE on 20 December 1941, by Major Jones, Infantry, U. S. Army.

That, at the time of my induction Major Jones had come to the headquarters of the P C at Bacolod, and along with me, all of the members of the PC there at the headquarters at Bacolod including both officers and men were inducted in a mass induction by Major Jones on 20 December 1941. I recall that there were about eight present who were inducted.

That, I remember BARTOLOME ROXAS DIONISIO to have been assigned to the PC at Negros Occidental, and with the special assignment as Traffic Inspector of the Public Works.

That, I can not remember definitely if BARTOLOME ROXAS DIONISIO was with me at Bacolod at the time of the mass induction. DIONISIO performed his office duties from our Bacolod headquarters, but his duties carried him throughout the Province. I do remember that it was the order for all personnel of the P C to be inducted into the USAFFE, and I remember that it was the ~~desire~~ desire of all the personnel to be inducted, and I know that if DIONISIO had been at the headquarters on 20 December 1941 that he would have been inducted.

That we continued to perform our duties in the PC, and that I often saw DIONISIO during that time. I last saw DIONISIO sometime in May 1942 before the Japanese landed at Bacolod on 21 May 1942.

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I hereby certify that I (have read) (~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~) all of the foregoing statements; that they are made by me as true and correct with full knowledge of the fact that severe penalties involving fines and imprisonment are prescribed by Act No. 2567, Philippine Legislature, Enacted February 3, 1916 and still in force and effect (Article IV, Philippine Constitution and Art. 366 Revised Penal Code).

I, FRANCISCO GOMEZ, of legal age, married, Filipino, Major, Infantry, Army of the Philippines, with official address as and now Deputy Zone Commander, Northern Luzon Zone, Military Police Command (PA) with station at Bamban, Tarlac, Philippines, after having been sworn in accordance with law and after having been apprised of my rights against compulsory self-incrimination made provided by and under AW 24(PA) and of the provisions of AN 97(PA), do hereby depose and sayeth:

1) That I was the Intelligence Officer (AC of S, G-2), Negros Sector under Col. Roger Hilsman, Visayan Force, USAFFE from the outbreak of World II until 9 March 1942 and was assigned as Battalion Commander and CO, 4th Sub-Sector (comprising the area between Bago River and Binalbagan River, North and South, respectively, Kanlaon Volcano, westward to the seacoast of Negros Occidental Province for the period 10 March 1942 until 29 May 1942 when the remnants of my command and I surrendered;

2) That as such Intelligence Officer and Battalion and 4th Sub-Sector Commander under Col. Hilsman, Negros Sector, Visayan Force, USAFFE, I have personal knowledge of the facts that Capt PRIMO C. MANUEL, CO, 2nd Negros Occidental Company, Philippine Constabulary, which unit was attached to Negros Sector from the outbreak of the war and to my Sub-Sector from 10 March, 1942 as my Bn Hq Security and forward echelon and Intelligence Unit to the seacoast, was promoted to the rank of TEMPORARY CAPTAIN, Philippine Constabulary (PC) with Capt VICENTE GEROSO, QMS (then Sup O and Quartermaster O, Negros Sector) on 3 April 1942 when Capt. Manuel and Geroso took the oath of office as such Captain, per attached true copy of radiographic message received from Gen. Wainwright through Gen. Chynoweth and Col. Hilsman; that Capt. PRIMO C. MANUEL received his pay and quarters allowance as such Captain from me for the period April 3-30, 1942 and May 1-31, 1942, which I got from Maj. Romeo A. Intengan, FS, then Finance Officer, Negros Sector; and that our file copies of the payrolls together with the records of his promotion aforementioned were lost as a result of the conditions of war.

FURTHER DEPOSEMENT SAYETH NONE.

That he was promoted to Sergeant on or about 1 April, 1942 and was last paid to include May, 1942. He was an enlisted man of 2nd Neg Occ Co(PC) during my incumbency as CO thereof from January, 1941 to 28 May, 1942 when the company was disbanded.

That he was commissioned 1st Lieutenant, Inf. effective 3 December, 1942 by Lt Col Salvador Abcede, CO, 7th Military District(Guerrilla) per Par 2, General Orders No. 7, Hq, 7MD, 22 January '43. He joined the Guerrilla unit as Sergeant, 9 August 1942 under Maj. Felimon Cortez, 2nd Division, 7MD and since then until date he was processed, 17 June '45, he had served the 7th Military District under various capacities.

That I was taken up with the 72nd Division since 24 April 1943 and served it under various capacities until 14 June, 1945 when I was processed at Bacolod City.

That I personally know Lt-Col SALVADOR ABCEDE O-1520 Inf presently Commanding Officer, 53d Inf (PA).

✓ That Lt-Col SALVADOR ABCEDE O-1520 Inf, then a Major commanding the defunct 2d Bn, 74th Inf, on a night of May 1942 before the disbandment of said unit, called a conference of all his officers, I one of them, at Camangcamang, Isabela, Negros Occidental. In this conference all the officers, except one, expressed desire not to surrender. The Lt-Col then instructed us to wait for his order to disband. On May 22, 1942, I and other officers, received the order to disband with further instructions to keep intact all arms and ammunitions and abide for better times to organize a guerrilla unit. In the months of June and July 1942, the Lt-Col contacted us giving out secretly a general plan for a guerrilla movement. August 13, 1942 was set the D-Day, but on August 3, 1942, my men of "G" Co stationed at Buenavista, Himamaylan, Negros Occidental, struck against a convoy of Japanese trucks. The order to strike and ambush the enemy anywhere and anytime was issued then by the Lt-Colonel. That fateful day, 3 August 1942, started the movement and the Lt-Col with loyal officers began the task of organizing and solidifying the different groups that made plain by actions their willingness to resist. Out of these groups, came the 72d Division, the 7th Military District Guerrilla Force under the command of Lt-Col SALVADOR ABCEDE and was the commanding officer till this guerrilla unit was dissolved by activation and designated 53d Infantry (PA).
