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HISTORY

OF

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HISTORY OF THE 1ST ALBAY CO PC (Dec 1941 - May 42)

A. The following history of the 1st Albay Co, PC has been deduced from a special study conducted on thirty one (31) 1st Albay Co, PC cases:

At the outbreak of the uer, the let Albay CO, FC was stationed at legan Barraceks, Darage, Albay. CO of the Company was Capt. Demetric J. Camma. Frowincial Inspector was Maj. Frencisco C. Sandico. There is no mention of a Junior Officer of the Company. However, two other officers were attached for duty with the Frowincial Inspector's Ciffice, nearby; Capt Josus Mercado, FC Traffic Officer, and Lt Burgos T. Sayoo, District Med. Inspector, Sch MD FC.

At dawn of 12 Dec 41 enemy battleships were sighted at Legaspi Port. Maj. Sandico ordered Lt Sayoc to contact HPC. Manila and report the presence of the enemy, estimated about 12,000 strong, at Legaspi Port. Lt Sayoc allegedly succeeded in transmitting the message, however, no reply was received. The PA and PC personnel at Regan Barracks combined, then deployed in their camp, ready to resist the enemy. About 0500 hours, 12 Dec 41, however, Provincial Governor Saturnino Benito, on learning the proposed resistance of the military personnel at Regan Barracks, advised Majors Deveras and Sandico, PA and PC senior officers in that area, respectively, that it would be futile for them to fight the enemy because of their (enemy) numerical superiority. The plan to defend the barracks was, therefore abandoned and Maj. Sandico, on his own initiative, ordered his men (PC) to evacuate to the mountains and there wait for reinforcements. Unfortunately, nothing arrived.

The majority of the cases studied allege automatic induction on 17 Dec 41 by witter of radiographic instructions from HFC, Manila. Recent studies conducted on the validity of these alleged instructions (automatic induction of the FC on 17 Dec 41), revealed that there is absolutely no basis for such an alleged induction. (See History of the Hgs Det, Dept of NL FC, for a full explanation of this;)

A few cases allege induction by Haj. Sandico on warlous dates in Dec 41. This could not be possible because Haj. Sandico, himself, alleges induction (like Capt. Gause and Capt. Hereado) on 13 Hay 42 by Haj. Liceric F. Lapus, Frovincial Inspector (FO) of Sorsegon province. Haj. Lapus in turn alleges to have been "personally inducted" by Col. Cornell (UA), CO, Lepte-Smart Frovisional Engl, on or about 30 Har 42.

NOTE: No determination has yet been made on the validity of Lapus' alleged induction. This will be made in a separate study on the

Sorsogon PC, of which he was the Provincial Inspector. Hevertheless, a determination on the validity of Maj. Sandico's induction can be made on the basis of facts now at hand.

Granting that Maj. Lapus' induction on 30 Mer 42 by 0cl Cornell is determined wellaj, the induction he performed for Maj. Sandico, Copt. Canus and Capt. Mercado on 13 May 42 is not wellad because it was done sfer the official surrender of the UMATFS forces. After this surrender (6 May 42) there was no authority to induct personnel.

let Lt Eurges T. Sayoe, one of the 2 officers on duty with the Frovil. Impector's Cffice when the laps landed in Legarit, alleges to have foined the Sorsogon FC which was under Maj. Liceria Lapus, on or about 1 Feb 42. He further alleges to have been "inducted into the UKAFFE in Gathelogan, Samar on March 29, 1942 by Maj. Antonio Lamar".

NOTE: Maj Lanzar alleges to have been inducted on 30 Dec Al and subsequently assigned 5-4 Leyte Provisional kept and then Ex-O Semar-Leyte Sector under Maj. J. Geusing and Col. T. M. Cornell, respectively.

It is therefore possible that Lt. Sayoc may have acquired USAFFE status in view of this alleged induction.

Sirteen of these cases allege to have been either dishended or separated on various dates during the period Dec '/l to Apr '/2. However, Capt. Camua, in affidavite found in several of these cases, attests that these same people were with him "all the time" in the sountains of Albay and that they became the First Alay Co Guerrille on 22 Hay 22. - B. A thorough search of all available archives for 1st Albay Co PC has been made at Mecords Branch and at Project "J". This revealed that:
 - There are no records of the Company at Archives Section, Records Branch;
 - Some members of the Company appear in some PC records which are dated prior to 8 Dec 41, at Archives Section;

 The "Alphabetical Casualty Listing of Officers and Enlisted Fersonnel who were in the Fhilippine Island Area as of 7 Dec 41," at Project "J" shows one Lt Col. Theodore M. Cornell, 0-7279, Hgs. Fhilippine Department.

Maj. Lapus, who attests to have inducted Maj. Sandico, was allegedly inducted by one Col T. M. Cornell, (USA) CO, Samar-Leyte Frovisional Regt.

- "Leyte Provisional Regiment," found in the Historical Files at Records Branch, mentions one Col Cornell as CO of the Leyte Provisional Regt.
- "Triumph in the Fhilippines" Vol I, p. 45, relates, that "on December 12, Gen. Homma landed a batellion of the 16th Division's 33d Regiment at Legaspi, in southern Luzon". This unit was known as the Kimura Detachment.
- C. From the above facts and findings the following conclusions have been drawn:
 - The 1st Albay Co PC was stationed at Regan Barracks, (now Camp Cerro Gordo) Daraga, Albay at the outbreak of the war.
 - 2. OO of the Company was Capt. Demetric J. Canua. No mention of a Jo is made in any of the cases studied. There were 3 officers in the Provincial Inspector's Office, namely: Hai, Francisco G. Sandico, Frowincial Inspector, Capt. Jeous Mercado, PG Traffic Officer, and Lt Eurgos T. Sayoe, District Hedical Inspector, 5th LB, FG.
 - On 12 Dec 41, the Imperial Japanese Forces effected the landing of the Kimura Detachment at Legaspi, Albay.
 - All plans of resisting the enemy contemplated by the military personnel at Regan Barracks were abandoned due to enemy superiority.
 - Maj. Sandico, having failed to secure instructions from HFG, Manile, on his own accord, ordered the FG personnel to evacuate to the mountains and there wait for reinforcements.
 - The unit evacuated to the mountains of Albay and was later disbanded during the period Dec 41-Apr 42.
 - The unit was not inducted into the USAFFE on 17 Dec 41, hence, is not a bonsfide USAFFE unit.

- The induction of Maj. Sandico, Capt Camua and Capt Mercado, allegedly done by Maj. Lapus was not a walld USAFFS induction, since it was performed after 6 May 42, the official termination of organized USAFFS resistence.
- In view of the preceding paragraph, the USAFFE inductions allegedly performed by Maj. Sandico for members of the lst Albay Co during the beleaguered period were not valid.
- 10. Hembers of the unit who sliege induction into other bonafide USAFFE units before 6 May 42, may be accorded positive USAFFE status if evidence acceptable under Sec III, Vets Br Adjudication Folicy as changed by Sec 1, Branch Hemorandum #3, dtd 3 Feb 50, is presented.

- I, DEMETRIO J CAUMA, Major Infantry, PA, 01380, married of legal age, residing at postal address <u>Provest Marshal. NFO.</u> Tarlac after having been duly sworn according to law, depose and say:
- That I was the Company Commander of 1st Albay Co FC, Legaspi, Albay on 12 December 1941, during the invasion of the Japanese Forces of Legaspi, Albay;
- That upon order of Major now Lt Col F. Sandico, Provincial Inspector, PG, Legaspi, Albay, I took my unit of 48 EM to the mountqins of Daraga, Albay in the morning of 12 December 1941, due to the Japs invasion of about 12,000 strong;
- 3. That it was futile to fight the Japa at that time because of their big number, hence the order of my Provincial Inspector to withdraw to the mountains to wait for reinforcement;
- A. That Opl Bulogic Talaran, PA, 212413, formerly a PTc of 1st Albay Oo PC under my command, is a regular soldier and was induced into the URAFFE by Ceneral G. B. FRANCISCO, Chief of the Philippine Cometabulary on or about 19 December 1941, and he was among those who was with me in the scuntains of Daraga, Albay.

- 1. In the morning of 12 Dec. 14 the Sepanese arm, numbering around 12,000 made a surprised landing in the town of Legangl, Albey. - 2. At about 5500 hours in the sorring of 12 Dec. '41 Gov. SATURINO BULITO of Alby came to see us and inquired as to our planes [84]. Semideo explained to him that we were ready to meet the enemy, the Governor them said, "Gentlemen, I am not your appearior, I am only the Chafe Zewentive of the Frowlines, but to save the province from unnecessary destriction I servise you many need to which [84]. As the days passed on without any sign of the American Forces we strengthen our camp in the barrio of Burchburocan in the town of Liggo, province of Albay.
- 3. Towards the end of the month of February 4.2, Mayor Wirgilio Sempillo of Cas, Albays econganied by Atty. Casimiro came to my comp and saked if they could organize a Gwerrilla Force and Join was as the propertion sounded good I told them to go sheaf. About 5 Mar. 4.2 we gathered around 150 cityllian volumbers and formed them the NULLESS of our unit. Since that date I have been inducting volumbers who cloned was.
- 4. About the end of merch '42 Gol. Sendion, Maj. Samma, it. Zabat and myself proceeded to Jubn., prospage merriving at the same per Gol. Lapsus shout 1 key '42 and them on 15 key '42 Col. Lapsus inducted us free the URAFFE per instructions of Col. General who was then the sector communic of Experimental sector, we returned to our camp in Albay in 22 May '42. Since our contact with Col. Larvus we continued induction volunteers and twin them.

By Figgery and Foultry Project helped me greatly in my days of privations; my wife used to make Sausages and other preserves to make the pork last long.

When I received my salary for the month of April, May and June 1945 my wife went around and started some of our bills.
