1. This report is submitted on the recommendation of Lt. Churchill, AGD.

2. The following persons died, escaped, or were executed in the camps in which I have been confined as a Prisoner of War. My records in this matter are incomplete, and were frequently reproduced from memory due to seizure of the original by the Japanese, 1938, etc. In many cases I have noted reports received from other Prisoners of War:

Colonel Viner, Inf., Capt Price, FA, and 1st Sgt Chandler were reported to me as ~~being~~ shot by the Japanese during May 1944 because men of their command escaped.

Lt Colonel Doyle, FA, Nixon, Leroy, and Lowry, Smith reported executed in May 1944 at Camp, P.I. after trial by Japanese court for burning of city of Cebu. Lt Colonel Lyster, MG, has further information on this.

Colonel Sam McCallough, CAC, reported to me to have died of natural causes at Bilibid Prison, Manila, P.I. in July 1943.

Lt Colonel H.E.C. Breitung, Lt Colonel Biggs, both RA, and Lt Gilbert, USMC, were reported by the Japanese as executed on Sept. 25, 1944, near Cabanatuan Concentration Camp No. 1. All three of these officers were brutally beaten, tied to a fence over night during a typhoon and were then led off by a Japanese firing squad ~~and~~ out of sight of camp. The Japanese reported that they had been beheaded or shot for attempted escape. Briefly the facts of this case known to me from investigation are as follows: American guards were posted at C.C.C. No. 1 by order of the Japanese and these guards were punished severely if an escaped took place. All men in camp were organized into ten man "blood-groups", with threats that if anyone escaped the other nine would be shot. These three officers, all from Group 1, crawled down an open cover ditch, apparently attempting to follow the ditch through the fence in Group II, which I commanded. An American prisoner from Captain Dale's company urinated on Colonel Biggs in the ditch. Biggs jumped up and attacked the soldier, making such a disturbance that the Japanese guards outside the fence were attracted. Captain Dale arrived and ordered all men involved to American Headquarters. At American Headquarters, Colonel Biggs seized a club and began beating the soldier who had urinated on him, meanwhile yelling so loudly that the Japanese Commander sent Lt Colonel Maj. Say (supposedly Engineer Corps but later reported as an imposter by Lt Colonel Powell of Iloilo). Say turned all three men over to the Japanese.

Lt Fitzgerald died aboard ship and was taken ashore at Cebu, P.I. for burial November 2, 1944.

Warrant Officer Ambrose died and was buried at sea about November 4, 1944.

Colonel J. A. Sullivan, CMC, died at Davao Penal Colony, November 15, 1944.

Major Charles H. Harrison, CWS, attacked a Japanese guard at Davao Penal colony and attempted to escape. He was wounded slightly and was reported by Japanese as having died the morning of May 12, 1944.

Lt Colonel John H. McGee, Inf, RA, jumped overboard from prison-ship in Zamboanga harbor, June 14, 1944.

Lt Donald L. Wills, jumped overboard from prison-ship off west coast of Mindanao, June 15, 1944.
