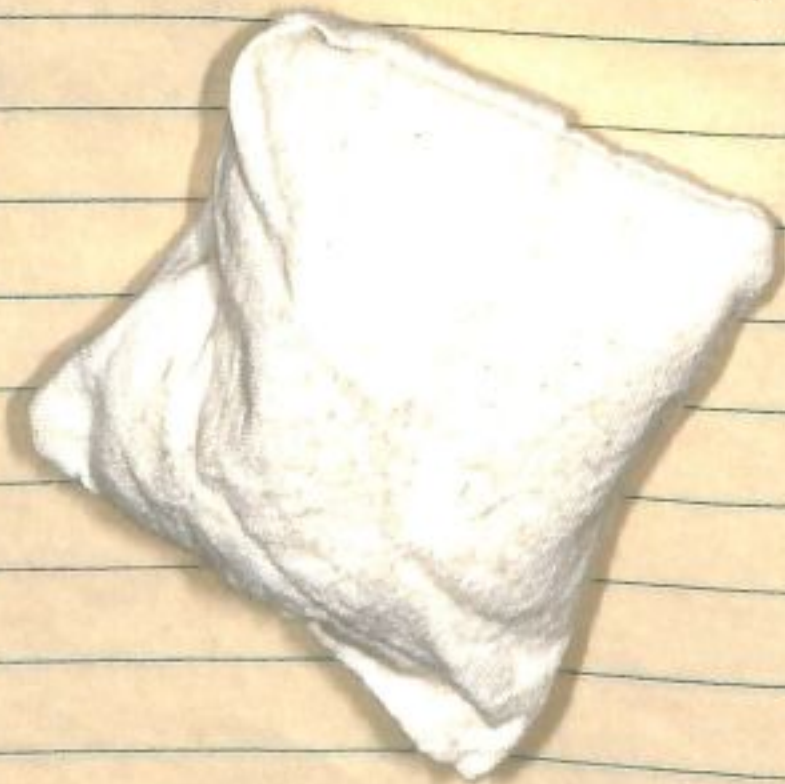

Major Thomas P. Bell, 021392, Infantry, a liberated prisoner of war of the Japanese who has been evacuated to the United States, was interviewed by First Lieutenant William R. Burchell of this office on 12 April 1945 concerning casualties in the Philippine Islands and he submitted a notebook labelled "Death Register" and a roster of the 31st Infantry (statement, roster and notebook filed in Status Review and Determination Section), which states as follows:

The original and the other copy were buried. Major Bell stated that the original notebook was carefully compiled from information received from members of the regiment contacted by Major Hurt and Mr. Brown at Camp O'Donnell and Cabanatuan. He further stated that death entries were not made unless the informant asserted he had seen the body or the grave. Those who died prior to 1 June 1942 died at Camp O'Donnell; those who died after that date

died at Cabanatuan.

2. The seventeen page roster of the 31st Infantry was prepared by Mr. Charles D. Brown. The asterisks appearing opposite some of the names indicate that these individuals are dead. This roster likewise was transferred to Major Bell by Mr. Brown for safekeeping and to be returned to Mr. Brown at the end of the war.

3. The one page partial roster of the 31st Infantry was compiled by an unknown person from sources of information which likewise are unknown.

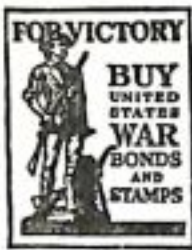



CASUALTY REPORT FROM REPATRIATE

Source: Sgt. Abraham RICHSTEIN, 11007737, 10 Crowell St., Dorchester, Mass., entered the Army in August 1940 and was a member of I Co., 31st Infantry Regiment, at the time of the capitulation on Bataan. He was a prisoner of war of the Japanese from the Bataan surrender until 4 February 1945 when he was released from Bilibid Prison, Manila, P.I. During nearly 3 years of imprisonment in the Philippines he was at Camp O'Donnell; Prison Camp No. 1 Cabanatuan; Fort William McKinley Camp No. 22 and finally Bilibid Prison, Manila.

Interviewed in connection with War Crimes, Source disclosed that he had a printed roster of the personnel of the 31st Infantry Regiment dated prior to Pearl Harbor. He was asked to go through the names in the roster and state what information he had of those officers and men with whom he had had acquaintance and who, to his knowledge, had not been released. In compliance Source gave the following information, dated February 1945: (Ranks as listed may not be correct in every case but are estimated as of the time of the fall of Bataan. In addition, Source listed from memory a few names of individuals of his acquaintance who were not members of the 31st Infantry Regiment.)

(NOTE: Source confessed ignorance of War Department policy with regard to disclosing to parents who had come to seek information from him facts relative to the deaths of their sons. Source stated that one parent who came to him had received information from the War Department his son was missing in action. This man was so insistent, Source stated, that he tell him the truth, that he gave him first hand details of his son's death. Other repatriates who have been interviewed have also expressed concern about the matter of informing inquiring parents and wives of the deaths of their sons or husbands.)
