EXCOUTIVE CREER NO. 21 BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE PHILIPPINES: The following Executive Order No. 21 by the President of the Philippines is published for the information and guidence of all ocnocraces:

Executive Order No. 21

DECLARATION TO BE OF ACTIVE SERVICE IN THE PHILIPPINE ARM
ALL PERSONS NOW ACTIVELY SERVING IN PROCEEDED VOLITARY
DECESS IN THE PHILIPPINS

ANDREAS, may devilen residing in the Philippines of Filipino, American and other fooding chilomahips, and Officers and Enlisted Nam of the Philippine Save, of the aread forces of the United States and of Allied nations have continued armod resistance against the Imperial Japanese Government since the circh of the y 1942;

MERRIAS, these military forces have contributed in a large measure to the Allied military effort and to the liberation of the Filiphon people from the yeke of the Jepsence invaders.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Government of the Philippines to recognize this allegiance;

HOW, THEREFORE, I, SERGIO OSMEMA, President of the Philippines, by wither of the authority vested in me by the Emergency Fowers Law, Section 22 a and Section 27 of Componenth Act Numbered the notwithstending, do hereby ordain and promulgate the following:

1. All persons, of any nationality or citizenship, who are actively serving in recognized military forces in the Philippines, are hereby considered to be on active service in the Philippine key,

2. The temporary grades of Enlisted Nan, enlisted or promoted in the field by Gomensters of recognised military forces or by their delegated authority, are hereby confirmed.

3. The temporary ranks of all officers, appointed or promoted in the field prior to this date by Commanders of recognized military forces, are hereby confirmed.

4. The date of entry into active service in the Philippine Army will be that joining a recognized military force.

- 5. The effective date of rank for commissioned Officers and Enlisted Men will be the date on which they were appointed or promoted to such rank by the Gommanders of recognized military forces.
- 6. A recognised military force, as used herein, is defined as a force under a commander who has appointed, designated or recognised by the Commander-in-Chief Southwest Facilità Area.

Done at the seat of Government in the Field, this 28th day of October, in the year of our Lord, Mineteen Rundred and Forty-Four, and of the Commonwealth of the Philippines, the Minth.
