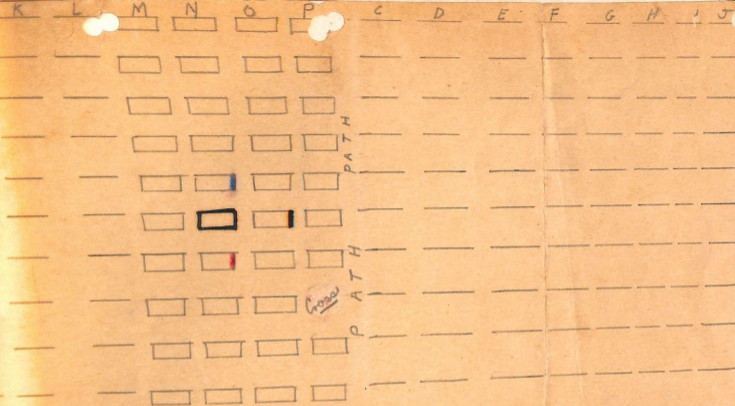

1. The following report in regard to the recovery of records buried in the grave of Pvt David J Hirsch is submitted:

A. A trip to Camp O'Donnell was made by members of the 1st Platoon, 601 QM Co and myself on 27 June for the purpose of locating the grave of Pvt Hirsch. Native laborers were employed to clean the cemetery area and the job lasted for two days. An attempt was made to locate the grave without success.

B. With the aid of a map furnished by AFFAC of the cemetery site a second trip was made but the grave thought to be that of Private Hirsch could not be positively identified since no identification tags were found on any of the ten bodies.

C. Hq AFFAC prepared a list, from their original list of burials in Camp O'Donnell, and a third trip was made. This time the adjoining graves were dug and the following information obtained:

(1) The grave immediately following grave where Hirsch is buried dug up and a dog tag of John Robertson, 36125605 found. This matched with the records AFFAC gave us as having a body buried in Plot N grave 9 row 7. The grave preceding 6 was also dug and a dog tag with the name of Clarence Cota, 19015715, found. This information matched with the records as having a body by that name buried in Plot N row 5 grave 10. The grave adjoining N-6- was also dug and dog tag of Pvt Arthur Heath found matching the records as having a body by that name buried in Plot O Row 6 Grave 10. Attached chart with graves and bodies identified. From the above it was definitely determined that the first grave dug and having no identifiable bodies was that of Pvt David J. Hirsch.

(2) The only item found was a canteen and examination of the same was made. Nothing was found either outside or inside the canteen. No records of any kind were found in the grave.

C. Hq AFFAC prepared a list, from their original list of burials in Camp O'Donnell, and a third trip was made. This time the adjoining graves were dug and the following information obtained:

(1) The grave immediately following grave where Hirsch is buried dug up and a dog tag of John Robertson, 36125605 found. This matched with the records AFFAC gave us as having a body buried in Plot N grave 9 row 7. The grave preceding 6 was also dug and a dog tag with the name of Clarence Gots, 19015715, found. This information matched with the records as having a body by that name buried in Plot N row 5 grave 10. The grave adjoining N-6- was also dug and dog tag of Pvt Arthur Heath found matching the records as having a body by that name buried in Plot O Row 6 Grave 10, Attached chart with graves and bodies identified. From the above it was definitely determined that the first grave dug and having no identifiable bodies was that of Pvt David J. Hirsch.

(2) The only item found was a canteen and examination of the same was made. Nothing was found either outside or inside the canteen. No records of any kind were found in the grave.
