1. This Project initiated to verify authenticity of extract copy of Par 6, 7 & 8 SO #29, Hqs MP Regt, Visayan Force, USAFIP, dated 8 April 1942, submitted by Tranquilino T. Tabanag.

2. Subject order under study contains twelve (12) names. Twelve (12) files were located. Comparison of organization claimed in the files with the Special Order revealed the following:

Eleven (11) files the organization is compatible.

One (1) file (Deceased claim) Specific organization not shown.

3. Eight (8) individuals claimed promotion during period 1 April 1942 thru 15 April 1942. Two (2) individuals claimed promotion on 19 March 1942 and 28 March 1942 respectively. One (1) individual claims induction as a 3d Lt. on 31 December 1941. One (1) file contains claim by N.O.K. in which individual is alleged to have been a Sgt.

4. Ten (10) files show Lt. Col. H. J. Edmands as promoting officer. One (1) file shows Gen. Zenowitch (Chynoweth) and one (1) file deceased claim shows grade of Sgt.

5. The file of Guillermo N. Monfort contains SO #19, Headquarters, United States Forces in the Philippines, Ft. Mills, P. I., 10 April 1942 certifying his promotion to Captain effective 10 April 1942.

6. Five (5) files show request for confirmation of promotion were disapproved in 1947 and 1948.

7. Six (6) files have been certified to VA. Four (4) as positive, with rank for one individual as Capt., one 3d Lt., and two as Sgts. Two (2) files were certified as negative for military service. Six files have no VA claim.

8. It is noted that Par 6, 7 & 8, SO #29 shows appointments as "Acting" only, and further states that individuals listed therein will wear the uniform and insignia thereof but will not receive the pay and allowance authorized their grade pending the approval of the Commanding General, United States Army Forces in the Philippines, of their regular appointments.

Par 4, SO #19 Headquarters, United States Forces in the Philippines, Fort Mills, P. I., 10 April 1942, shows one Guillermo Monfort, appointed Philippine Army Reserve Force as Captain Infantry Reserve.

No information or evidence of subsequent approval by the Commanding General, United States Forces in the Philippines has been located to validate the commission

A synopsis of the history of the Cebu Military Police Regt (P-405) report of operations of the USAFFE and USFIP, Visayan - Mindanao Force Vol X3 shows the following:

On 15 Dec 41, Lt. Col. H. J. Edmands appointed Military Commander of Cebu City and directed to organize a military police battalion. Thereafter Hq, Hq Co. and Companies "A" thru "K", M. P., Regt were organized as the necessity for additional troops became apparent.

In Jan 42, Col. Scudder was assigned Military Commander of all Army Troops on the Island of Cebu.

4 Mar 42, the Cebu Force was transferred from the Visayan-Mindanao Force to the Visayan Force.

1 Mar 42, Gen. Chynoweth assumed command of the Visayan Force and arrived in Cebu from Panay about the middle of the month.

Acting 2d Lt. Anciano (a soldier formerly of "H" Co, 57th Inf P.S. reenlisted the first day of the war) was assigned command of "H" Company which was formed by dividing "D" Company, one half the men remaining in "D" Company, the other half forming the nucleus of "H" Company. (P-417)

Tuesday 21 April 1942 (P-474)

Early the next morning Lt. Col. Edmands left camp leaving Lt. Anciano, four other officers and about ten enlisted.

9. Discussion

a. All files pertaining to names listed in Special Order have been located.
