CURRENT POLICY CONCERNING CERTIFICATION OF SERVICE  
IN MERITORIOUS CASES OF COMMONWEALTH ARMY VETERANS

Induction and service as a member of the Philippine Commonwealth Army in the service of the United States Armed Forces during World War II is established by official records on file in the United States Army Administration Center, St. Louis, Missouri, or based on supplementary evidence as outlined below.

The requirements to prove that a person is a veteran are the basic claim forms, satisfactory evidence of military service and discharge or separation from the service, and in death cases, proof of death (actual or presumed). If evidence of these facts is not on hand, the claimant must furnish it.

United States Army Forces in the Far East service for members of the Philippine Commonwealth Army or Philippine Constabulary may be established by military or non-military records. The records must be authentic official documents executed by competent authority. The following evidence may be used depending on its accuracy, completeness, reliability, and validity as evaluated and determined by analysis and review: Enlistment Records, National Service Life Insurance Records based on applications made prior to 7 May 1942, casualty records, prisoner of war records and death certificates from prisoner of war camps, other archive data, such as rosters, payrolls, general or special orders, combat narratives, authentic call to active duty orders, and approved reconstructed guerrilla troop rosters, casualty rosters, or individual recognized letters.

When proof of United States Army Forces in the Far East service rests solely on any of the documents mentioned above and entries do not conclusively identify the document as pertaining to the subject of the claim, the documents must be supported by an acceptable affidavit or affidavits of his former comrades or his commanding officer. Secondary evidence cannot be accepted as proof of recognized guerrilla service.

In the absence of affidavits on file the claimant may submit secondary evidence in the form of affidavits to support the alleged military service.

Certifications of service made by United States Army Administration Center to the Veterans Administration are based on application of these policies.

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A STATEMENT FROM THE ARMY AS TO WILL THE ARMY GRANT RECOGNITION  
ON GUERRILLA CASES OR ARE THESE ROLES DEFINITELY CLOSED

The primary requirement for recognition of guerrilla service is the appearance of the person's name on a Reconstructed Initial Troop Roster or Casualty Roster or an Individual Letter of Recognition issued by the Guerrilla Affairs Division, Philippines-Ryukyus Command. Secondary evidence cannot be accepted as proof of recognized guerrilla service.

Some guerrilla units original dates of recognition were later revised to grant members recognition from an earlier date and in some instances extending the period of recognition. The Reconstructed Revised Troop Roster contains the names of these members.

The guerrilla recognition program was terminated when the Guerrilla Affairs Division, Philippines-Ryukyus Command was deactivated on 30 June 1948. Subsequent to that no authority exists to alter, amend, or modify previous decisions.

If a member of the Philippine Commonwealth Army who served in the service of the United States Armed Forces (USAFPE) had no established recognized guerrilla service as claimed, he may be considered to have unrecognized guerrilla service under an immediate commander. Such service is established by authentic guerrilla archive records or an affidavit or certificate of the immediate commander concerned, who is recognized as a guerrilla officer, or who was a commissioned officer of the United States Army, Navy, or Marine Corps.

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## MUSTERING-OUT PAY AND GRATUITY PAY

### Mustering-Out Pay

Public Law 78-225 dated 3 February 1944 - an ACT to provide for mustering-out payments to members of the armed forces, and for other purposes. "Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, that each member of the armed forces who shall have been engaged in active service in the present war, and who is discharged or relieved from active service under honorable conditions on or after 7 December 1941, shall be eligible to receive mustering-out payment.

This Act may be cited as the "Mustering-Out Payment Act of 1944".

The Military Order of the President of the United States dated 26 July 1941 called and ordered all of the organized military forces of the Government of the Commonwealth of the Philippines into the service of the Armed Forces of the United States.

The Philippine Army maintained its own identity and kept its own records during the Japanese Occupation of the Philippines. The fact that they were in the service of the United States Armed Forces and not direct members of the United States Armed Forces, was the basis for their non-entitlement to mustering-out pay.

When official status and service has been properly established for members of the Philippine Commonwealth Army the following statement is used: in responding to requests to mustering-out pay: "Jose Garcia served as a member of the Philippine Commonwealth Army in the service of the United States Armed Forces during World War II in the Philippines".

### Gratuity Pay

AR 35-1370 superseded by AR 37-104 does not authorize the payment of the 6 mos gratuity pay to PA personnel.

There has been no legislation extending or authorizing payment of a death gratuity on account of death of members of the Philippine Army. Determination of applicability of pension laws to Philippine Army personnel and their families rests with the Administrator of Veterans Affairs. (C-1, 21 Mar 45)

APPENDIX-5

MILITARY ORDER

"ORGANIZED MILITARY FORCES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE COMMONWEALTH  
OF THE PHILIPPINES CALLED INTO SERVICE OF THE  
ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES.

"Under and by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution of the United States, by section 2 (a) (12) of the Philippine Independence Act of March 24, 1934 (48 Stat. 457), and by the corresponding provision of the Ordinance appended to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of the Philippines, and as Commander-in-Chief of the Army and Navy of the United States, I hereby call and order into the service of the armed forces of the United States for the period of the existing emergency, and place under the command of a general officer, United States Army, to be designated by the Secretary of War from time to time, all of the organized military forces of the Government of the Commonwealth of the Philippines: Provided, That all naval component thereof shall be placed under the command of the Commandant of the Sixteenth Naval District, United States Navy.

"This Order shall take effect with relation to all units and personnel of the organized military forces of the Government of the Commonwealth of the Philippines, from and after the days and hours, respectively, indicated in orders to be issued from time to time by the general officer, United States Army, designated by the Secretary of War.

SEC. 2. There is hereby authorized to be appropriated, out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, such sums as may be necessary to effectuate the purpose of this Act.

[CHAPTER 9]

AN ACT

To provide for mustering-out payments to members of the armed forces, and for other purposes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled*, That (a) except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, each member of the armed forces who shall have been engaged in active service in the present war, and who is discharged or relieved from active service under honorable conditions on or after December 7, 1941, shall be eligible to receive mustering-out payment.

(b) No mustering-out payment shall be made to—

(1) any member of the armed forces who, at the time of discharge or relief from active service, is receiving base pay at a higher rate than the base pay of the third period as prescribed in section 1 of the Pay Readjustment Act of 1942, as amended;

(2) any member of the armed forces who, at the time of discharge or relief from active service, is transferred or returned to the retired list with retirement pay or to a status in which he receives retirement pay;

(3) any member of the armed forces for any active service performed prior to the date of his discharge or relief from active service on his own initiative to accept employment or, in the case of any member so relieved from active service, for any active service performed prior to the date of his discharge while in such inactive status, unless he has served outside the continental limits of the United States or in Alaska;

(4) any Air Corps Reserve officer who is entitled to receive a lump-sum payment under section 2, as amended (55 Stat. 240), of the Act of June 16, 1936;

(5) any member of the armed forces whose total period of service has been as a student detailed for training under (A) the

(7) any member of the armed forces whose sole service has been as a cadet at the United States Military Academy or the United States Coast Guard Academy, or as a midshipman at the United States Naval Academy, or in a preparatory school after nomination as a principal, alternate, or candidate for admission to any of said Academies; and

(8) any commissioned officer unless he is discharged or relieved from active service within three years after the termination of the present war as proclaimed by the President.

SEC. 2. (a) Mustering-out payment for persons eligible under section 1 shall be in sums as follows:

(1) \$300 for persons who, having performed active service for sixty days or more, have served outside the continental limits of the United States or in Alaska.

(2) \$200 for persons who, having performed active service for sixty days or more, have served no part thereof outside the continental limits of the United States or in Alaska.

(3) \$100 for persons who have performed active service for less than sixty days.

(b) Each person eligible to receive mustering-out payment under subsection (a) (1) shall receive one-third of the stipulated amount at the time of final discharge or ultimate relief from active service; and the remaining amount of such payment shall be paid in two equal installments—one month and two months, respectively, from the date of the original payment. Each person eligible to receive mustering-out payment under subsection (a) (2) shall receive one-half of the stipulated amount at the time of final discharge or ultimate relief from active service; and the remaining amount of such payment shall be paid one month from the date of the original payment. Each person eligible to receive mustering-out payment under subsection (a) (3) shall receive the stipulated amount at the time of such discharge or relief from active service.

SEC. 3. Any member of the armed forces entitled to mustering-out payment who shall have been discharged or relieved from active service under honorable conditions before the effective date of this Act shall, if application therefor is made within two years after the date of enactment of this Act, be paid such mustering-out payment by the War Department or the Navy Department, as the case may be, beginning within one month after application has been received and approved by such department: *Provided*, That no member of the armed forces shall receive mustering-out payment under this Act more than once, and such payment shall accrue and the amount thereof shall be computed as of the time of discharge for the purpose of effecting a permanent separation from the service or of ultimate relief from active service.

SEC. 4. If any member of the armed forces, after his discharge or relief from active service, shall die before receiving any portion of or the full amount of his mustering-out payment, the balance of the amount due him shall be payable, on appropriate application therefor, to his surviving spouse, if any; and if he shall leave no surviv-

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ing spouse, then in equal shares to his child or children, if any; and if he shall leave no surviving spouse or child or children, then in equal shares to his surviving parents, if any: *Provided*, That no payments under this Act shall be made to any other person.

SEC. 5. (a) Mustering-out payments due or to become due under this Act shall not be assignable and any payments made to or on account of a veteran hereunder shall be exempt from taxation, shall be exempt from the claims of creditors, including any claim of the United States, and shall not be subject to attachment, levy, or seizure by or under any legal or equitable process whatever either before or after receipt by the payee.

(b) The Secretary of War and the Secretary of the Navy shall make such regulations not inconsistent with this Act as may be necessary effectively to carry out the provisions thereof, and the decisions of the Secretary of War and the Secretary of the Navy shall be final and not subject to review by any court or other Government official.

SEC. 6. As used in this Act—

(a) The term "member of the armed forces" means any member of the Army or Navy of the United States, the United States Marine Corps, the United States Coast Guard, or any of their respective components, and any member of the Women's Army Auxiliary Corps who was discharged under honorable conditions on account of disability.

(b) The term "spouse" means a lawful wife or husband.

(c) The term "child" includes (1) a legitimate child; (2) a child legally adopted; and (3) a stepchild, if, at the time of death of the member of the armed forces, such stepchild was a member of the deceased's household.

(d) The term "parent" includes father and mother, stepfather and stepmother, and father and mother through adoption.

SEC. 7. Appropriations for the Army and Navy, and the several components thereof, respectively, shall be available for the payments provided by this Act and necessary administrative expenses. There are hereby authorized to be appropriated such additional sums as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act. Amounts expended hereunder shall be included in the annual reports to the Congress by the Departments concerned.

SEC. 8. This Act may be cited as the "Mustering-Out Payment Act of 1944".

JOINT RESOLUTION

Full settlement of pay and allowances accounts of such personnel is a responsibility of the Officer of Special Settlement Accounts (hereinafter abbreviated OSS A), 27 Pine Street, New York 5, New York. Determinations and information pertinent to pay will be sent by Commander-in-Chief, Southwest Pacific Area to that office, and if early return to the United States is not contemplated, shall be accompanied by request to be advised of credits, debits, and balance and an authorization to make payment. (C-1, 21 Mar 45)

2. Allotments and family allowances in effect at time of return of an individual to control will be continued in effect with appropriate deductions from current pay. It is the duty of the Commander under whose jurisdiction the returnee falls to ascertain from OSSA what allotments and allowance (with appropriate deductions) are in effect, to notify the returnee thereof and to afford him opportunity to request any changes desired, except of Class A family allowance, which must continue. Such ascertainment, notification of returnee, and affording opportunity to make changes, may be deferred until arrival in the United States if early return thereto is contemplated. This procedure has application to members of the Philippine Army, only with regard to continuance of their Class N allotments for payments of premiums on National Service Life Insurance, in accordance with radio instructions of 15 December 1944 and subsequent instructions. (C-1, 21 Mar 45).

3. Certificate will be obtained from each returnee other than members of Philippine Army and civilian employees by Commander-in-Chief, Southwest Pacific Area and sent to OSSA, of the date to which last paid prior to absence and rate of pay then in effect, and of any amounts of pay and allowances or advances he may have received during absence from the United States or any agency thereof, from a captor government or from any other source. Amounts paid or credited to prisoners of war by an enemy may not, however, be charged against their account. (C-1, 21 Mar 45)

4. In cases of death or finding of death, except of member of the Philippine Army, claims for arrears of pay and for death gratuity are processed by OSSA which, upon receipt of report thereof, asks the appropriate payee to submit claims. When in the Philippine Scout or other cases payees reside in the Philippines, the Commander-in-Chief, Southwest Pacific Area, will cause claims forms to be executed by the next of kin and beneficiary, after securing data from the War Department if necessary, and will forward same to OSSA. The latter will arrange payment of any death gratuity that is payable and will arrange payment of arrears of pay if and when authorized by the Comptroller General. (C-1; 21 Mar 45)



APPENDIX 2

Laws and Interpretations

1. The Missing Persons Act was originally enacted 7 March 1942. It has been twice amended and in its present form is published complete in War Department Circular 305, 1944.
2. The Attorney General has held that the Missing Persons Act is applicable to members of the Philippine Army ordered into the Armed Forces of the United States in the Philippines.
3. The Missing Persons Act has been held inapplicable to civilian employees of War Department contractors and to civilian employees of the Government of the Commonwealth of the Philippines.
4. There has been a separate appropriation by Congress of funds for payment of expenses incident to service of the organized forces of the Philippine Government as a part of the Armed Forces of the United States in the Philippines. The provisions thereof will be found on page 15 of War Department Bulletin 12, 1944. Payments of accrued pay for periods of absence under the Missing Persons Act are clearly payable from such appropriation, either directly or by reimbursement of other appropriations therefrom. Such payments must, however, under Section 2 of the Missing Persons Act be at the rate of pay and allowances in effect at commencement of absence (on 6 May 1942 in most cases) or at such rate as the individual might become entitled to thereafter. Payments of arrears of pay to heirs or estates are incident to pay of personnel and likewise properly chargeable against the appropriation referred to. (Last sentence added by C-1, 21 Mar 45).
5. There has been no legislation extending or authorizing payment of a death gratuity on account of death of members of the Philippine Army. Determination of applicability of pension laws to Philippine Army personnel and their families rests with the Administrator of Veterans Affairs. (C-1, 21 Mar 45)

I refer to your request for settlement of arrears in pay under the provisions of Public Law 85-217.

A section of this law authorizes claims of former members of the Philippine Scouts to be considered by the head of the department concerned for settlement of pay and allowances not previously received under the Missing Persons Act. The law provided however, that no claim could be approved for payment if the claimant voluntarily participated with or for the Japanese Government, Japanese Nationals or others and performed actions or duties of a military nature hostile to the United States.

PAY AND ALLOWANCES FOR FORMER PHILIPPINE SCOUTS

1. Public Law 85-217, an act "To amend Further and Make Permanent the Missing Persons Act, as Amended," was approved by the President on 29 August 1957. A provision of this law authorizes back pay and allowances for Philippine Scouts who were captured and paroled in the Philippine Islands during World War II, and who did not receive pay and allowances for the period of parole.

2. Military personnel who were members of the Philippine Scouts during World War II and were not paid for the period of parole may submit letter requests for back pay to the Commanding Officer, U. S. Army Records Center, 9700 Page Boulevard, St. Louis 14, Mo. Requests should contain the individual's full name, service number, place and date of birth, present address, and address to which check should be sent.

3. The contents of this circular will be brought to the attention of all personnel who were members of the Philippine Scouts during World War II.

V--MISSING PERSONS ACT AS AMENDED. The following act of Congress (PL 85-217, 85th Cong.) is published for the information and guidance of all concerned:

71 Stat. 491

An act to amend further and make permanent the Missing Persons Act, as amended.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the Missing Persons Act (56 Stat. 143), as amended, is further amended as follows:

(a) Section 1 (a) (3) is amended to read as follows:

"(3) Civilian officers and employees of the departments, exclusive of part time or intermittent employees or native labor casually hired on an hourly or per diem basis, who are citizens or nationals of the United States, or who are aliens who have been admitted to the United States for permanent residence, except that the following categories of civilian officers and employees shall be covered only upon a determination by the head of the department concerned that such status is the proximate result of employment by the department:

"(i) persons who enter any status listed in section 2 of this Act within the continental limits of the United States and

"(ii) persons who enter any status listed in section 2 of this Act who are residents at or in the vicinity of their places of employment in the Territories and possessions or in foreign countries and who were not living there solely as a result of their employment."

(b) Section 2 is amended to read as follows:

"SEC.2 (a) Any person who is in the active service, or is performing full-time training duty, other full-time duty, or inactive duty training and who is officially determined to be absent in a status of missing, missing in action, interned in a foreign country, captured by a hostile force, beleaguered by a hostile force, or besieged by a hostile force shall, for the period he is officially carried or determined to be in any such status, be entitled to receive or to have credited to his account the same basic pay, special pay, incentive pay, basic allowances for quarters, basic allowance for subsistence, and station per diem allowances for not to exceed ninety days, to which he was entitled at the beginning of such period of absence or may become entitled thereafter, except that the pay and allowances for a person who is performing full-time training duty or other full-time duty without pay, or inactive duty training with or without pay, shall be that to which he would have been entitled if he had been performing full-time active duty with pay, and entitlement to pay and allowances shall terminate upon the date of receipt by the department concerned of evidence that the person is dead or upon the date of death prescribed or determined under provisions of section 5 of this Act. Such entitlement to pay and allowances shall not terminate upon the expiration of a term of service during absence and, in case of death during absence, shall not terminate earlier than the dates herein prescribed. There shall be no entitlement to pay and allowances for any period during which such person may be officially determined absent from his post of duty without authority and he shall be indebted to the Govern-

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ment for any payments from amounts credited to his account for such period. Persons performing full-time training duty, or inactive duty training shall be entitled to the benefits of this section only when such persons are officially determined to be absent in a status of missing, missing in action, interned in a foreign country, captured by a hostile force, beleaguered by a hostile force, or besieged by a hostile force as a result of the performance of prescribed duty ordered by competent authority.

✓ "(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, such entitlement to pay and allowances shall not be denied, in the case of any member of the Philippine Scouts who was captured in the Philippine Islands by the enemy during World War II, solely on the ground that such member was paroled and permitted to return to his home and engage in civilian pursuits prior to the termination of the Japanese occupation of such islands. Claims of members of the Philippine Scouts for pay and allowances under this subsection (whether or not such claims have been presented and rejected or disallowed) may, until three years after the date of enactment of this subsection, be presented for consideration or reconsideration and payment under this subsection: Provided, That no claims shall be approved for payment if the claimant voluntarily participated with or for the Japanese Government, Japanese nationals, or others and performed actions or duties of a military nature hostile to the United States: Provided further, That except in the event of legal proceedings, any person except the authorized representative of the American Red Cross, the American Legion, the Disabled American Veterans, and the Veterans of Foreign Wars, and such other organizations as shall be approved by the Secretary of Defense, who shall hereafter, directly or indirectly, solicit, contract for, charge, or receive any fee or compensation for rendering assistance in the preparation, execution or filing of the necessary papers in any application for the pay and allowances authorized by this subsection shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and each and every offense shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment at hard labor for not more than two years, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

"(c) No part of any amount paid on any claim filed pursuant to subsection (b) of this section in excess of 10 per centum of the first \$1,000 so paid on such claim, and 7 per centum of the amount so paid over \$1,000, shall be paid or delivered to or received by any agent or attorney on account of services rendered in connection with any such claim, and the same shall be unlawful, any contract to the contrary notwithstanding. Any person violating the provisions of this subsection shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not exceeding \$10,000 or imprisoned not more than one year, or both."

"(c) Section 9 is amended by redesignating that section as subsection (a) and adding the following new subsection at the end thereof:

"(b) A dependent of any person in active service, as defined by this Act, is a 'person' under this Act for the sole purpose of determining status as provided in sections 5 and 9, and any deter-

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mination under those sections by the head of the department concerned shall be conclusive on all other departments of the Government: Provided, That nothing in this section shall be construed as conferring upon any dependent any right to pay, allowances or other compensation to which not otherwise entitled."

(d) Section 12 is amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 12. The dependents and household and personal effects of any person in active service (without regard to pay grade) who is officially reported as dead, injured, missing for a period of thirty days or more, interned in a foreign country, or captured by a hostile force, may be moved (including packing, crating, drayage, temporary storage, and unpacking of household and personal effect) to the official residence of record for any such person or to the residence of his dependent, next of kin, or other person entitled to receive custody of the effects in accordance with regulations issued by the head of the department concerned; or, upon application by such dependent, next of kin, or other person, or upon the person's application if injured, to such other location as may be determined in advance or subsequently approved by the head of the department concerned or by such person as he may designate. When the head of the department concerned determines that an emergency exists and that such sale would be in the best interests of the Government, he may provide for the disposition of the motor vehicles and other bulky items of such household and personal effects of the person by public or private sale. Prior to any such sale, and if practicable, a reasonable effort shall be made to determine the desires of the interested persons. The net proceeds received from such sale shall be transmitted to the owner or to other persons in accordance with regulations issued by head of the department concerned; but if there be no such persons or if such persons or their addresses are not ascertainable within one year from the date of sale, the net proceeds may be covered into the Treasury as miscellaneous receipts. Claims for net proceeds which are covered into the Treasury under the authority of this section may be filed with the General Accounting Office by the rightful owners, their heirs or next of kin, or their legal representatives at any time prior to the expiration of five years from the date the proceeds are covered into the Treasury; and, if so filed, the General Accounting Office shall allow or disallow the claim. When such claim is allowed it shall be paid from the appropriation for refunding moneys erroneously received and covered. If claims are not filed prior to the expiration of five years from the date the proceeds are covered into the Treasury, they shall be barred from being acted on by the courts or the General Accounting Office. The provisions of this section do not amend or repeal the Federal Tort Claims Act (60 Stat. 842-847), as amended; sections 2575, 2733, 4712, 4713, 6522, 9712, 9713, title 10, United States Code; or section 507, title 14, United States Code. The head of the department concerned is authorized to store the household and personal effect of the person until such time as proper disposition can be made. The cost of such storage and transportation, including packing, crating, drayage, temporary storage, and unpacking of household and personal effect, shall

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be charged against appropriations currently available. In lieu of transportation authorized by this section for dependents, the head of the department concerned may authorize the payment in money or amounts equal to such commercial transportation costs or a monetary allowance in lieu of transportation as authorized by law for the whole or such part of travel for which transportation in kind is not furnished, when such travel shall have been completed. When the person is in an 'injured' status, the movement of dependents or household and personal effect provided for herein may be authorized only in cases where the anticipated period of hospitalization or treatment will be of prolonged duration. No transportation shall be authorized pursuant to this section upon application by dependents unless a reasonable relationship exists between the condition and circumstances of the dependents and the destination to which transportation is requested. Beginning June 25, 1950, and for the purposes of this section only, the terms 'household and personal effects' and 'household effects' may include, in addition to other authorized weight allowances, not to exceed one privately owned motor vehicle, shipment of which at Government expense is authorized in those cases where the vehicle is located outside the continental limits of the United States or in Alaska."

(e) Section 15 is amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 1 This Act, except sections 13, 16, and 17, is effective from September 8, 1939."

SEC. 2. Subsection 2 (b) Missing Persons Act, as added by this Act, is effective from September 8, 1939. All other amendments made by this Act are effective upon the date of enactment of this Act.

1. To keep the controversial subject of the Guerrilla Recognition Program from entering into any determination of status under Public Law 85-217 it is recommended that the word "recognized" (Comment 3, Par 2, 7th line) be deleted from the policy.

2. The guerrilla recognition program did not take place until after the return of the liberation forces to the Philippines in 1945. Some guerrilla leaders did render some type of assistance to the Allied cause; however, since they did not meet criteria established by the Guerrilla Affairs Division, they were not recognized. Any Philippine Scout "planted" in the Japanese EC or similar enemy agency by a guerrilla leader, whether such leader was subsequently accorded recognition or not is believed to be entitled to equal consideration in determining the extent of the assistance furnished. In any case where it can be determined that a Philippine Scout entered into such a hazardous position to aid the allied cause, it is believed mandatory that his actions be acknowledged regardless of whether or not the guerrilla leader that "planted" him was subsequently recognized.

3. Other than the foregoing, the policy as drafted is concurred in.

4. Since so many variations will be encountered in the cases to be considered it will be difficult to answer each request by a "pattern" reply. However, the sample reply attached will cover most claims wherein a straight denial will be appropriate.

1. Reference is made to disposition form to CO, USARCEN, subject as above dated 4 November 1957 and Comment 2 thereto, dated 26 November 1957. This office concurs in the determinations made on the 23 cases forwarded for review by Comment 2 dated 26 November 1957. The twenty three 201 files are being retained in this office pending formulation of a policy on the cases discussed in the paragraph below.

2. It is proposed to adopt the following policy on cases involving former Philippine Scouts who served in the Japanese Bureau of Constabulary, the Manila Defense Corps, and the United Nippon Army:

"If the individual served in any capacity with the Japanese Bureau of Constabulary, the Manila Defense Corps, or the United Nippon Army for more than 6 months, he will be considered to have voluntarily participated in the organization and determined ineligible for PL 85-217 benefits. Exceptions to this policy are those cases where the individual was "planted" in the organization by a recognized guerrilla leader and cases where the individual was not "planted" but did render assistance and furnish information to guerrillas. However, in the latter cases, the time and the extent of the assistance and information furnished will be considered. If the individual delayed cooperation with guerrillas and did not furnish substantial assistance, he will be considered disqualified from obtaining PL 85-217 benefits. An example of such a case is that of Candelario P. Duldulao who did not aid the guerrillas until 21 months after he joined the Constabulary. USARCEN determination in this case is that individual is ineligible for PL 85-217 benefits. This office concurs in the determination in this case."

3. Request comment or concurrence in the proposed policy quoted in paragraph 2.

4. It is anticipated that Japanese Bureau of Constabulary, Manila Defense Corps, and United Nippon Army cases which are determined negative for PL 85-217

2. In reference 1c, TJAG has ruled that members of the Philippine Scouts who served voluntarily in the Japanese Bureau of Constabulary or the Manila Defense Corps are not entitled to Public Law 85-217 benefits. This ruling applies irrespective of the nature of duties performed or the length of time served by the individual in these organizations.

3. In view of the ruling of TJAG, determination of whether a Philippine Scout served in the organizations in question voluntarily or otherwise is of utmost importance. It was the intent of Congress in passing PL 85-217 that the overwhelming majority of the 6,000 Philippine Scouts in question be paid for their time in parole status. Consequently, it is believed that this office must adopt a liberal attitude towards Philippine Scouts who served in the Japanese Bureau of Constabulary and the Manila Defense Corps, and settle doubtful cases in favor of the individual. This belief is shared by representatives of TJAGO.

4. Accordingly, it is proposed to request DCSPER approval of a policy whereby service in the organizations in question would disqualify a claimant for PL 85-217 benefits only if the individual's record contains conclusive evidence that he served voluntarily in one or both of these organizations. Request comment or concurrence in this proposal.

1. No request to DCSPER is considered necessary since sufficient information is available for TAG to act without obtaining the support from DCSPER other than for that which we already have and that a liberal view will be taken.

2. The instructions of the Commander in Chief, Far East Command to the Loyalty Status Board set forth the policy that a member of the Japanese Bureau of Constabulary would be considered disloyal unless proof was submitted to the Loyalty Status Board that he joined to aid the guerrillas, was an active member of the guerrillas during his tour with the Constabulary, or he deserted or obtained a release from the Constabulary after a nominal period of service (3-6 months). In the case of the Manila Defense Corps the policy was that an individual who failed to take advantage of the many opportunities afforded to escape would be considered disloyal.

3a. As a result of this Policy, in most cases the Loyalty Status Board's findings are specific enough so that it will be relatively easy to determine whether the individual voluntarily joined or was forced to join the Constabulary or Manila Defense Corps and whether or not he remained with the organization for such a period that it must be considered that his service was voluntary.

b. The following specific examples of such findings by the Loyalty Status Board, which are supported by the evidence on file in the records are quoted:

(1) "That Private First Class Roque R. Villamos, 6 865 774, was a member of the Manila Defense Corps from September 10, 1942, when he was forced to join the organization, until January 25, 1944, when he escaped from the organization."

(2) "That Private Celestino A. Arenas, 10 300 122, was a member of the Philippine Constabulary, an armed Japanese-controlled organization. That he was forced to join the constabulary and escaped with arms and five prisoners after one month."

(3) "That Private Nemesio A. [redacted] 10 301 613, was a member of the Philippine Constabulary, an armed Japanese-controlled organization. That he did voluntarily join this organization."

(4) "That Pedro F. Abalos, 6 614 100, was a member of the Philippine Constabulary, an armed Japanese-controlled organization. That he did voluntarily join this organization."

4. When cases are found upon which a decision cannot be made they will be forwarded for appropriate action.

## 1. References:

a. Section 2(b), Public Law 85-217 which authorizes pay and allowances for Philippine Scouts who were not paid while paroled in the Philippine Islands during World War II.

b. Conference on Section 2(b), Public Law 85-217 between representatives of TJAG and TAGO, 10 September 1957.

2. Claims for back pay and allowances under PL 85-217 will be certified for payment by this office. It is expected that questions will arise concerning those cases which pertain to Philippine Scouts who voluntarily joined and served in the Japanese Bureau of Constabulary or the Manila Defense Corps, both of which were Japanese controlled organizations. To facilitate determining whether such cases should be approved for payment, it is requested that opinions be given on the following:

a. Does service in the above-named organizations disqualify a Philippine Scout for PL 85-217 benefits?

b. If the answer to a above is negative, would a Philippine Scout be disqualified for pay and allowances for the period he actually served in the above-named organizations?

c. If the Philippine Scout is not disqualified for the period actually served in the above-named organizations, would he be disqualified for bearing arms, whether or not he used them against the United States or for cooperating with the United States?

3. It also is requested that an opinion be given whether a Philippine Scout is entitled to PL 85-217 benefits if he was given a dishonorable discharge from a post World War II period of military service with forfeiture of pay.

4. Background information on the Japanese Bureau of Constabulary and the Manila Defense Corps is being obtained from the U. S. Army Records Center, and will be forwarded to your office when received. In addition, personnel records of Philippine Scouts whose claims for PL 85-217 benefits will raise questions of the nature referred to in paragraphs 2 and 3 above are being obtained from the U.S. Army Records Center. These records will be forwarded to your office as soon as they are received.



1. Assuming, as is stated in Comment No. 1, that the two organizations in question were Japanese controlled organizations, members of the Philippine Scouts who voluntarily performed any actions or duties of a military nature hostile to the United States for such organizations are precluded from receiving benefits under the provisions of Public Law 217, 85th Congress. It is noted that each case must be considered on an individual basis. However, it may be stated generally that if the two mentioned organizations were engaged in actions of a military nature hostile to the United States, its members generally would be likewise engaged regardless of their particular duties. As an example of this, the "supply sergeant" is as engaged in actions or duties of a military nature as is the rifleman on the line.

2. No answers to questions 2b and 2c are necessary in view of paragraph 1.

3. The fact that a Philippine scout has been given a dishonorable discharge with forfeiture of pay from a subsequent enlistment does not preclude receipt of pay under Public Law 217, supra, inasmuch as that act grants entitlement if otherwise qualified without regard to the type of discharge granted (or whether the individual was convicted by a court-martial) in a subsequent enlistment.
