b. Bvt. Capt. ALAMANZA DILANGALEN, QMS, shall be responsible for the procurement of food supplies in all the areas occupied by the Moros and other Non-Christian tribes.

c. Bvt. 1st Lieut. VICENTE CEDENO, QMS, shall be responsible for the procurement of food supplies in the areas occupied by all Cebuanos from Libuñgan River going upward, like San Isidro, Catingawan, Upper and Lower Bulanan and other places.

d. Bvt. 2nd Lieut. JESUS YERMO, QMS, shall be responsible for the procurement of food supplies in the areas occupied by the Ilongos from Libuñgan River going upward, like Lower Bulanan and Baliki and areas around Rañgaban.

2. They will, upon receipt of this order, assume their duties as specified above.
