SUBJECT: Intelligence Report
TO: CO, 1st Separate Ln, CP JAB
In the Field

1. Latest reports from our Secret Operatives in the Field says that tunnels are under construction in Passanao, one of which starts from the hillsides near the former residences of Fiscal Evangelista that is about 100 m on the left side of the road going up to Passanao. Powerful searchlights are also installed in that place.

2. The work in the landing field was stopped to avoid people from knowing the secrets now placed in it. Anti-aircraft emplacements and hangars are nearing completion. Present strength of the Japanese in the City are numbered to 300 strong only, excluding the BCo. Two mg of the .50 caliber are now placed in the left and right side of Luna Street, just after the crossing of Jeweller Street, facing the Sta. Cruz Direction. Cannons of various calibers are now planted along the sea coast from Passanao to Caliguan, facing the sea. They could be easily seen from above as they are covered with high angles. It was also reported that anti-aircraft is mounted in trucks arrived recently in the City.

3. Chief of City with approximately 20 of his men mostly negroes and veterans are actively patrolling the western sea coast in a large dump, armed with 2 machine guns. Yesterday morning, they were reported to have seen at Passanao and are expected to patrol as far as Caliguan and V. Hall.

4. In the City, the Japanese began constructing all sorts of traps and defenses that may be found in the streets for axis. They are then brought to Passanao for deposit in the tunnels that they have constructed there. Also deposited in those tunnels are their war supplies. They have also constructed another water system so that if the Passanao water supply to the City is disrupted, they are sure of another water supply.

5. The former BCo stationed in Marikina are now relieved by another group headed by Juaning Jordan, since the latter did not arrive yet personally in Marikina. However, it is expected that within a week, Juan Jordan will be in Marikina with his family to stay there. The garage of the ground floor of the previous municipal building in Marikina is now used as ammunition dump together with other supplies. Chief will be seen to Caliguan and will be leaving sooner or later. Interpreter Senaka was sent back to Marikina again. The patrols does not enter anymore inside like what they used to do before. They are now aware of the presence of our boys when they expected them to jump on them because they patrolled the interior.

6. Senaka learned that our Army has prohibited the civilians of the area territory to work in the landing field. So with the collection and bringing of foodstuffs to enemy territory. This information was given to him by civilian. The work in the proposed new bridge at Marikina was also suspended for lack of laborers.

7. The following are reported again to be actively working for the enemy: Pedro Solera, Corp Bernard, connected with the Bernales Family of Bolong, Vicente Novidad and Vicente Lumbraze.

8. Present strength of the Marikina attachment, 30 Japs and 13 BCo.







SILENT-READING EXERCISES

To Division Superintendents:

1. *Silent-Reading Exercises*, Book One, for Grades III and IV, which this Office has prepared for classroom use, is now being printed in booklet form. It is believed that these exercises will adequately serve the purpose of providing teachers with materials adapted to the needs and abilities of their classes because they have a background familiar to Filipino children and are provided grade-location equivalents based on their actual achievements.

2. A *Manual of Directions*, in mimeographed form, explaining how to use the silent-reading exercises will be provided. Teachers should read the manual through and study the directions carefully before using the exercises.

3. The booklets of silent-reading exercises and the *Manual of Directions* will be sold at cost to the field. The estimated price of the booklet is ₱0.20 (twenty centavos) per copy. A copy of the manual will be sent free of charge for every 50 copies of the booklet ordered. Requisitions payable from municipal or provincial funds may now be forwarded to this Office.

4. Books Two and Three of the *Silent-Reading Exercises* are still in preparation and will probably be completed during the school year 1936-37.
