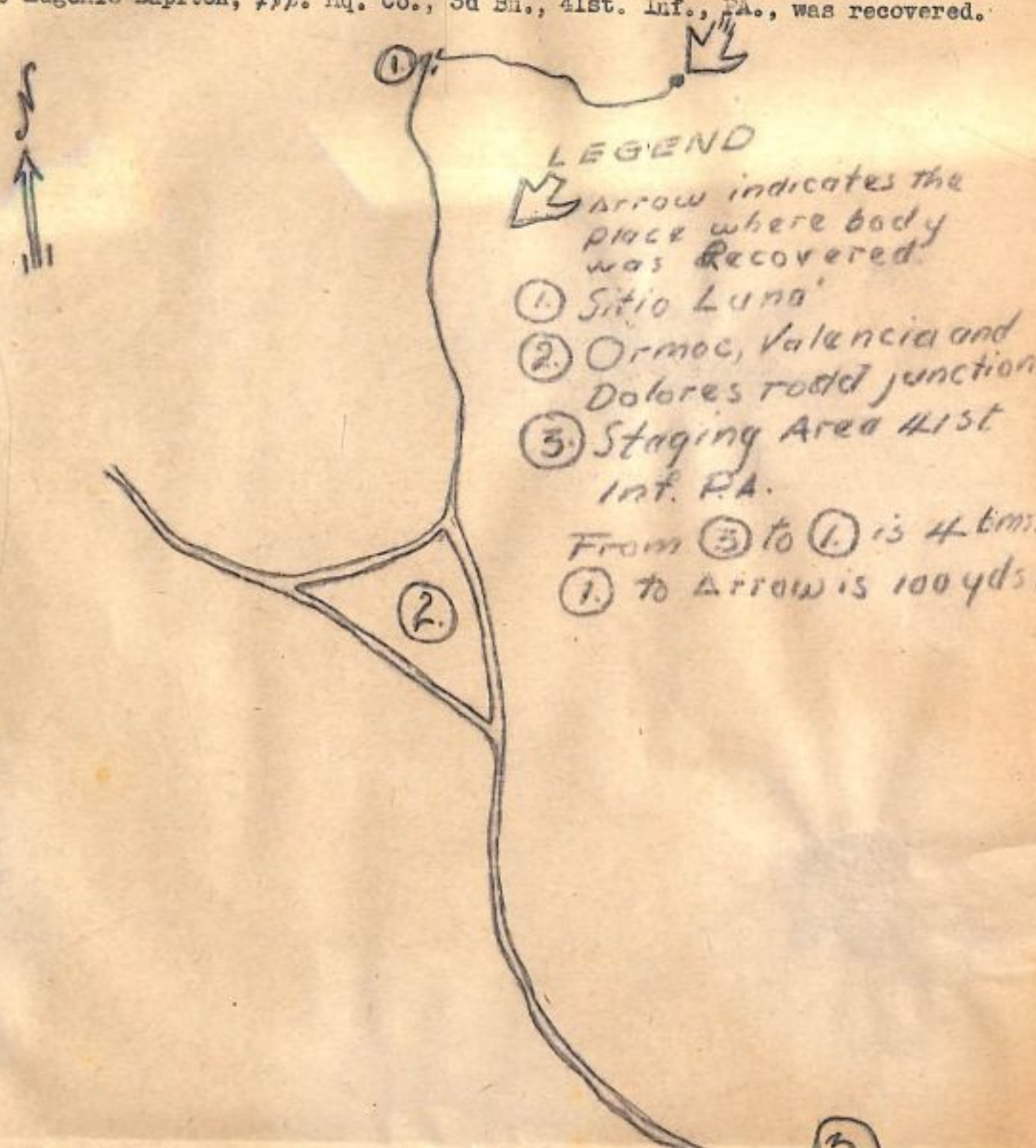

1. The following are the E/M killed or wounded during  
the several encounters this company had against the enemy:

KILLED IN ACTION-

- (1) a. Leopoldo Redobla, Pvt., Inf.
- b. Place: Patag, Burauen, Leyte (place of encounter)
- Date: Aug. 8, 1944
- Time: about 6:00 AM
- c. Place died: Cagbufigilas, Patag, Burauen
- Date: Aug. 9, 1944
- Time: about 12:00 Noon
- d. Part of body wounded: abdomen, left and right hip
- Part of body fatally wounded: abdomen
- e. Attention given: Properly buried in Cagbufigilas, Patag, Burauen. Parents properly informed.
- f. Narration: The 1st and 2nd platoons under Lt. Herendo were engaging the enemy at Patag. 3rd Platoon under Sgt. Besal was left at the bivouac area to guard the supplies and to cook food for those fighting. At past 11:00 AM, Privs. Leopoldo Redobla and Carlos Hoyla brought food to the men in the line. Unluckily however, they were seen by enemy snipers of about 5 Japs and were fixed at. Pvt. Hoyla was hit immediately at the right hip and he ran to call for help. Pvt. Redobla was hit at the abdomen and because he could not run he just drop to the ground and returned fire. The Japs hit him again at the left hip and throw him a grenade, sharpnel of which hit him at the right hip. He continued firing until the Japs retreated and left him alone. He crawled with the help of pointed bamboo sticks until help came to him.

- Date: Sept. 10, 1944
- Time: 4:00 PM
- c. Place died: Masalogo, Pinamopo-an, Capanaganan

- Time: 2:00 AM
- d. Part of body wounded: left inner lap
- Part of body wounded fatally: bullet deflected to abdomen
- e. Attention given: Properly buried and marked

f. Narration: Pvt. Alfante was the BAR man of the 2nd Platoon. He had the best view of the road. During the fight he displayed cool courage and great skill with the BAR. He fought so bravely that he inspired the rest of the boys to fight calmly against the advancing enemy of superior numbers. Incidentally however a stray bullet hit him. He called for his assistant Pvt. Morales who readily came to his aid and with two others Privs. Ordos and Hoyla they slowly withdrew. Pvt. Alfante calmly met death on the way.

a. Lieut. A. Beronio was hit on his forearm by an enemy rifle fire during the encounter at Pinaret, Sibuyan, Villaba on March 25, 1945 when he attempted to grab the MG from Pvt. Sibuyan who was hit and killed instantly.

b. Pvt. Gallill was hit on his left hand during the encounter with the enemy at Pinaret, Sibuyan, Villaba.

c. Pvt. Gallonera was slightly wounded on the lower part of his left shoulder during the encounter at Pinaret, Sibuyan, Villaba.

d. Pvt. Magallana was hit through and through on his abdomen below the waist line when he tried to communicate with the Japs firing at them during the encounter at Pinaret, Sibuyan, Villaba.

1. The following report on casualties of this command and the details of facts pertaining thereto is hereby submitted:

- V ✓ a. Pfc. Manual Rosales who died instantly in action at Deposito, Ormoc, Leyte on 6 January, 1945.  
✓ b. Sgt. Melquiades Evangelista who was wounded in action at Deposito, Ormoc, Leyte, on 6 January, 1945 and died the following day.

(Narrative)

At about 9:30 A. M. on 6 January, 1945, a civilian reported the presence of Japs at upper Deposito, Ormoc, Leyte. A unit of "E" Co., 2nd Bn., 94th Inf. was sent to verify and intercept the enemies operating thereat.

At about a distance of 2 kilometers from the Provincial Road at Deposito, Ormoc, Leyte, the unit of "E" Co. sent there saw a hundred or more Japs. My men fired at them and killed fifteen (15) of them. Sgt. M. Evangelista and Pfc. M. Rosales maneuvered to contact the right flank of our patrol. They were fired at by the Japs. Pfc. Rosales died instantly and Sgt. M. Evangelista was seriously wounded and died today.

My men fired a barrage such that our casualties were taken from the field of battle before my men withdrew. Our casualties were brought to the nearest Medical Station.

More men of "E" Co. were sent in the afternoon to Deposito, Ormoc, Leyte. They encountered the Japs and killed only eight (8) of them because the other Japs fled to the hills.


