
Pursuant to Section 22 of Commonwealth Act No. 470, otherwise known as the Assessment Law, N O T I C E is hereby given that the Provincial Board of Sulu in its Resolution No. 466, series of 1940, has fixed in accordance with Section 23 of the aforementioned Act, the periods and installment payments of realty taxes in Sulu for the year 1941, as follows:

FIRST INSTALLMENT - 50% of the total yearly tax due may be paid without penalty from January 1 to May 31, 1941.

SECOND INSTALLMENT - 50% of the total yearly tax due may be paid on or before November 30, 1941.

After the expiration of the periods fixed above, 1% penalty will be imposed for each month of delinquency or a fraction thereof but in no case shall the penalty exceed 12%.

Payment may be made either in the office of the municipal or municipal district treasurer where the property is located or in this office or in any other office of the provincial, city or municipal treasurer where the taxpayer resides in the Philippines.


