1. Reporting that out of the Officers and E/M sent to the Regimental Hq for reinforcement as called for, four (4) of them - two officers and two E/M died within this month and many others are still sick. Such sickness caused their death was encountered at Bacoled during the time they were detailed as out-post guards and then fought against the enemies at Esperanza and Lisagna during the second attack of the Japanese Imperial Forces last March, 1944, took place.

2. The casualties are as follows:

- (a) Pvt. Naitomama Gunto, "I" Co., died just few days after their arrival with companions from the coastal area.
- (b) Pvt. Diwan Bengcarawan, "I" Co. died 17 April 1944
- (c) Lt. Pandas Gemaga, CO, "I" Co. 3rd Bn. died 23 April 1944
- (d) Lt. Moti Macarimbang, Bn adjutant & S-1 died 26 April 1944

Reporting that out of the Officers and E/M sent to the Regimental Hq for reinforcement as called for, four (4) of them - two officers and two E/M died within this month and many others are still sick. Such sickness caused their death was encountered at Bacoled during the time they were detailed as out-post guards and then fought against the enemies at Esperanza and Liagna during the second attack of the Japanese Imperial Forces last March, 1944, took place.

2. The casualties are as follows:

- (a) Pvt. Maitomana Gunto, "I" Co., died just few days after their arrival with companions from the coastal area.
- (b) Pvt. Diwan Bengcarawan, "I" Co. died 17 April 1944
- (c) Lt. Pandas Gomaga, CO, "I" Co., 3rd Bn. died 23 April 1944
- (d) Lt. Moti Macarimbang, Bn adjutant & S-1 died 26 April 1944
